




Care & Maintenance




- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.




- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor product minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.




- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.




- Keep away from sources of ignition.






CAUTION: This **Chair** is NOT a TOY

Overview:




This **Chair** has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the **Chair** parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1:



Unpack and place all the parts on a clean, non-marring surface.


Step 2:



Fix the Seat Panel (D) and Middle Support Bar (E) with Left Armrest (A) by using 4pcs Screws (1) by Allen Wrench (3).

DO NOT fully tighten the bolts.


Step 3:



Fix the Right Armrest (B) to the **Assembled parts in Step 2** by using 4pcs Screws (1) by Allen Wrench (3).


DO NOT fully tighten the bolts.

Step 4:



Insert Backrest (C) to the **Assembled parts in Step 3**, then secure by using 6pcs Bolts (②) by Allen Wrench (③) as shown above.
DO NOT fully tighten the screws.


Step 5:



Step 5.1: Place the Seat Cushion (F) on the Seat Panel (D)


Step 5.2: Tighten by affix the Magic Tape Straps as shown above.

Step 6:



With the help of your adult partner, Turn over Chair to right-side up, put the Back Cushion (G) into Chair

Step 7:



Adjust high for balance

Adjust low for balance

Adjust Pre-installed Levellers height for balance

Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Gently and gracefully, sit onto the all Chair. This will help to align all the parts at all joint areas. Then get off the Chair and in a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Screws at all joints until evenly connected.

If there are still wobbles, loosen the Screws and execute this same process.

WARNING!! IF CHAIR IS NOT STABLE, IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.

Your Chair is ready for use.

This Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.
