Assembly Steps

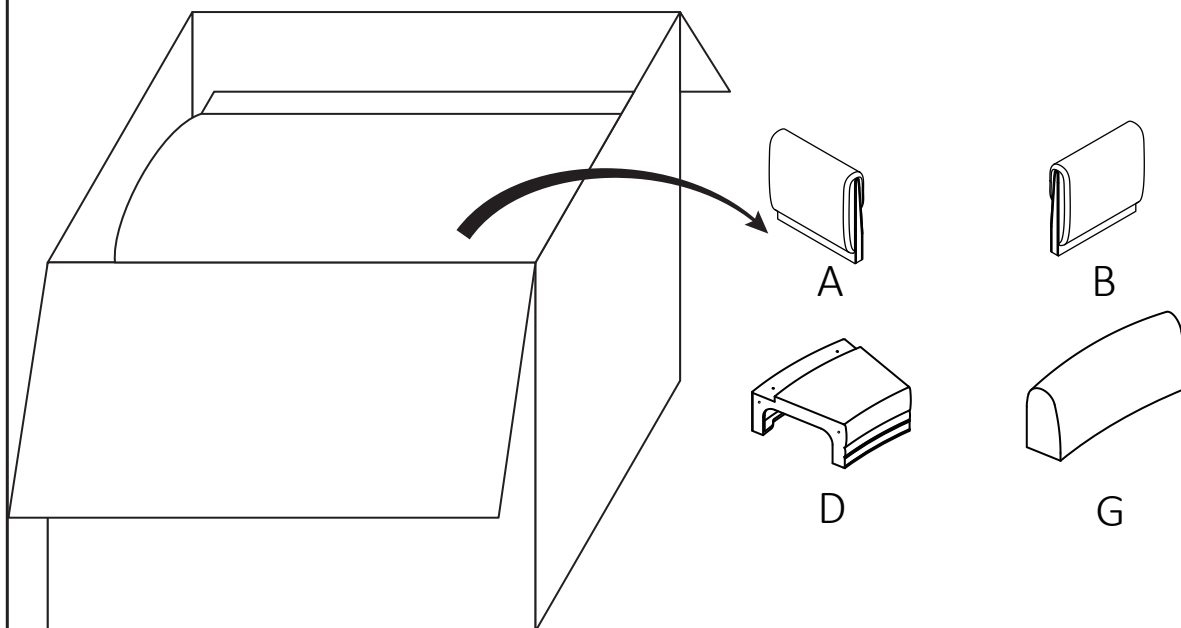
Overview



This sofa has multiple parts and may require up to 45 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the 3 Seater Sofa parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions herebelow to familiarise the parts and steps before assembly.

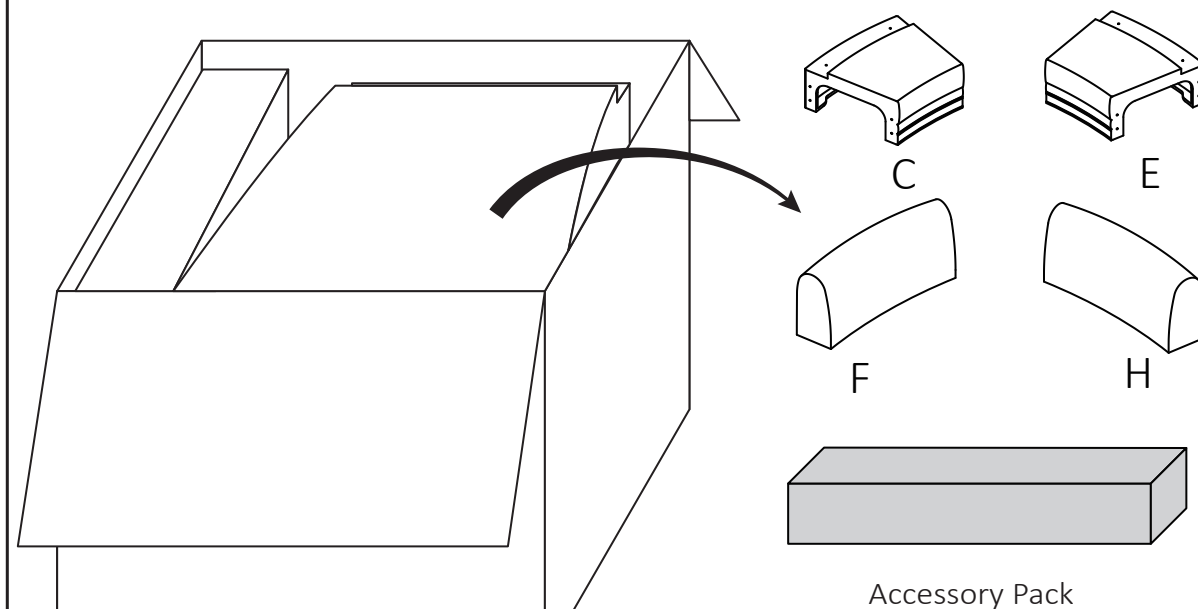
Note: It is recommended that you have an adult partner to assist during the entire assembly process.

Step 1



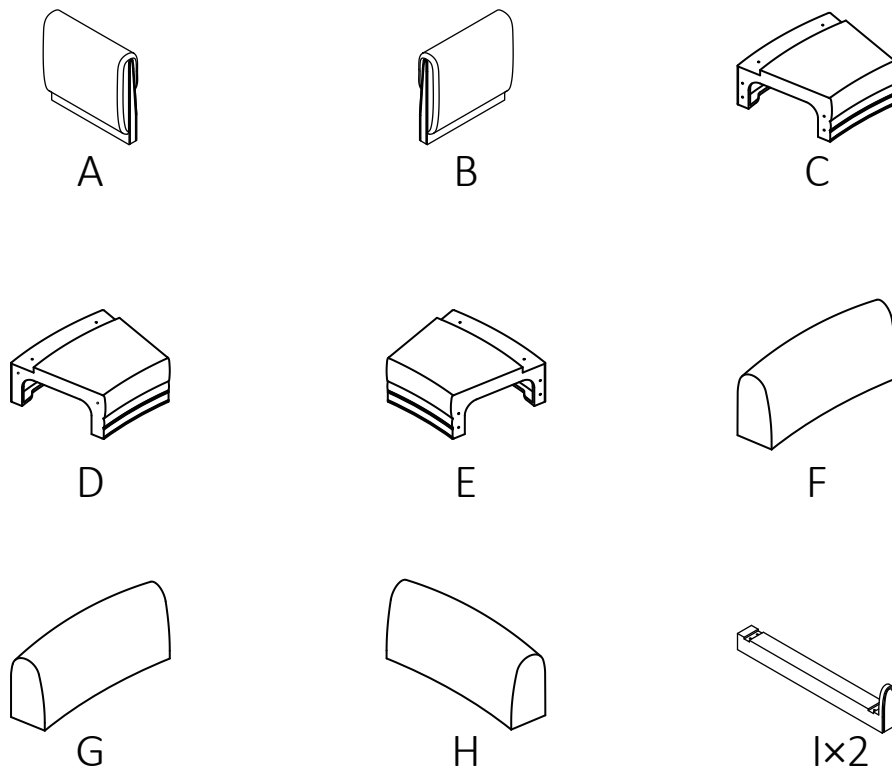
Take out the Left Armrest(A) , Right Armrest(B) , Middle Sofa Base (D) and Middle Backrest(G) from the Carton"2-1",place them on a clean,non-marring surface.

Step 2



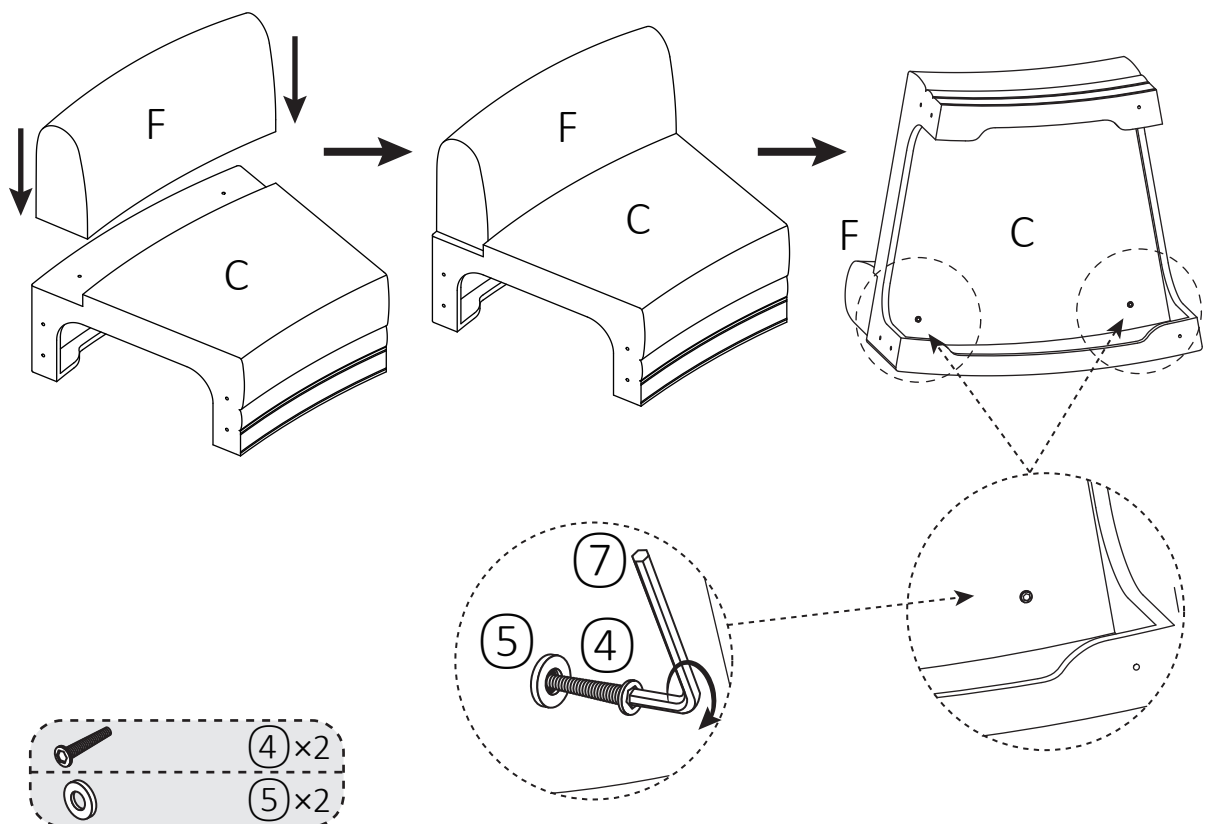
Take out the Left Sofa Base (C), Right Sofa Base (E), Left Backrest(F),Right Backrest(H) and Accessory Pack from the Carton"2-2" , cut open the Accessory Pack to take out the Sofa Leg (I),Connector(①) ,Screws (②),Long Screws(③),Long Screws (④) ,Washer(⑤),Allen Wrench(⑥) , Allen Wrench(⑦) ,Hex Nut (⑧) and Small Wrench (⑨) place them on a clean,non-marring surface.

Step 3



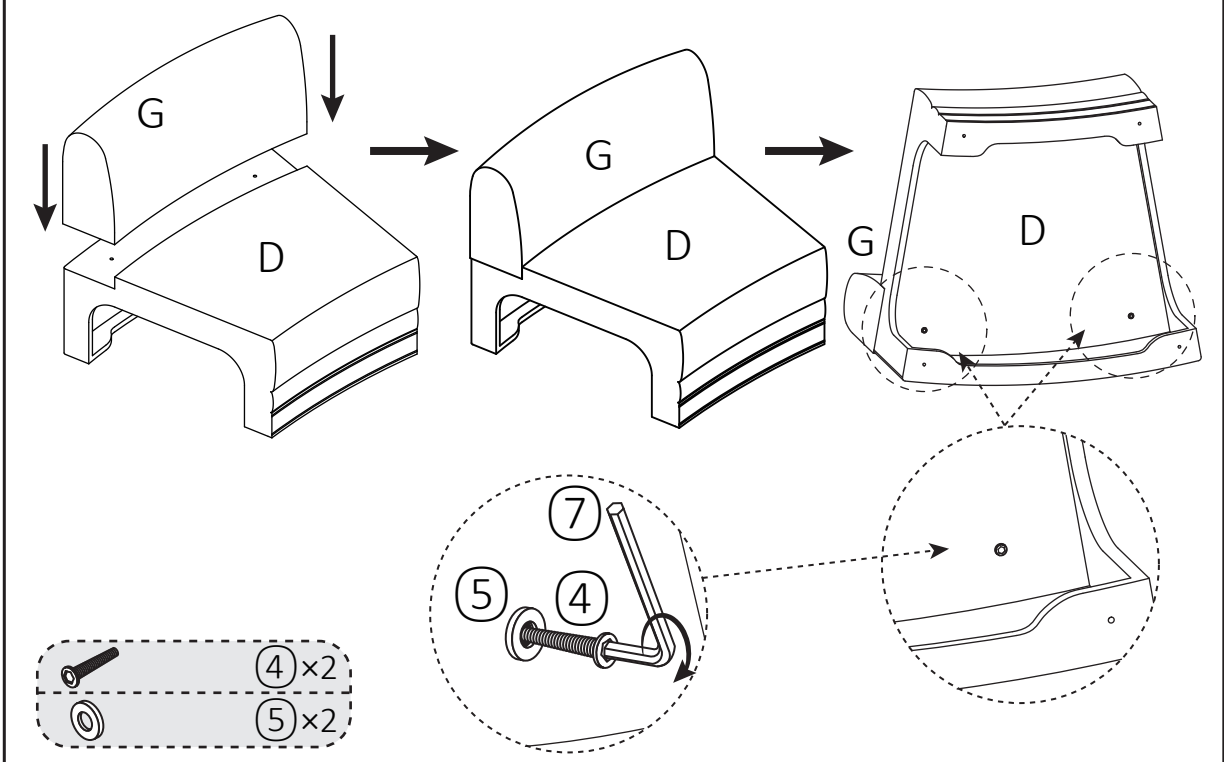
Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 4



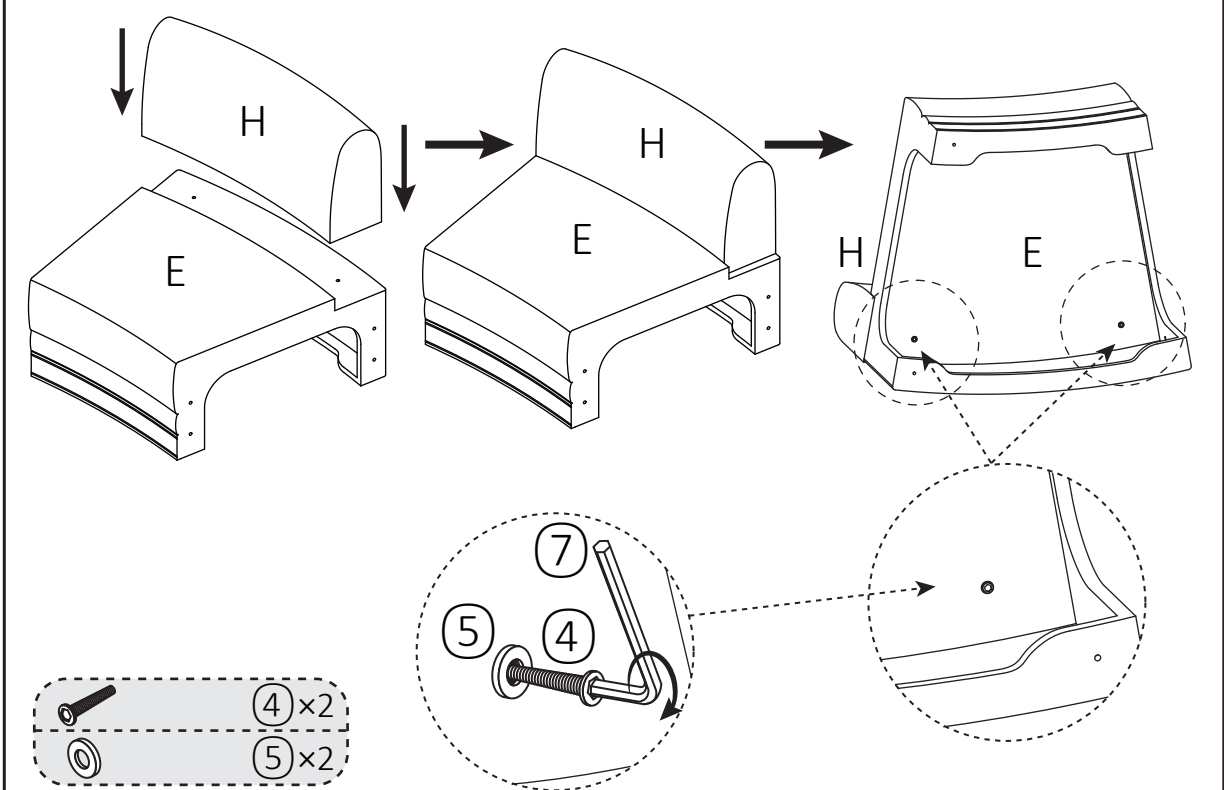
Place the Left Backrest (F) onto the Left Sofa Base (C) as shown in the diagram. Hold both parts in position, then flip the Left Sofa Base (C) so its bottom faces forward. Align the screw holes on both parts, and then assemble them together using the Long Screws (④) and Washers (⑤).

Step 5



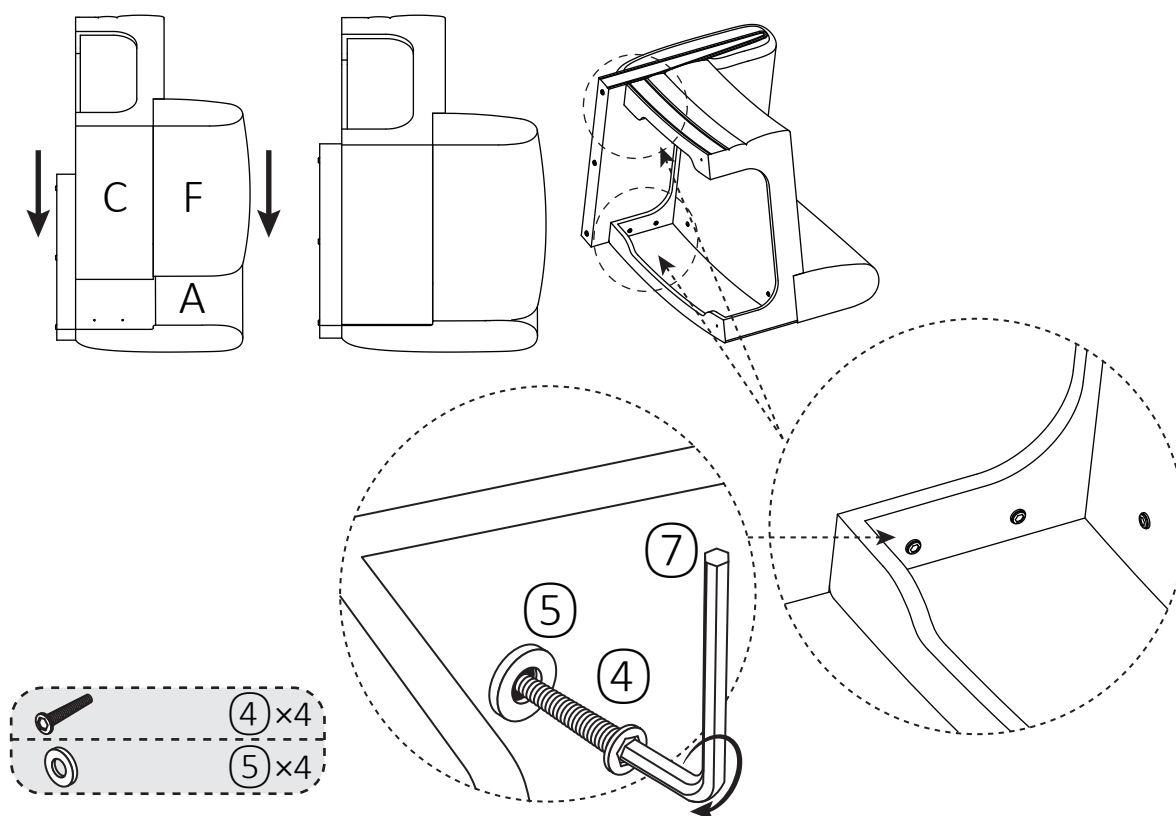
Place the Middle Backrest (G) onto the Middle Sofa Base (D) as shown in the diagram. Hold both parts in position, then flip the Middle Sofa Base (D) so its bottom faces forward. Align the screw holes on both parts, and then assemble them together using the Long Screws (④) and Washers (⑤).

Step 6



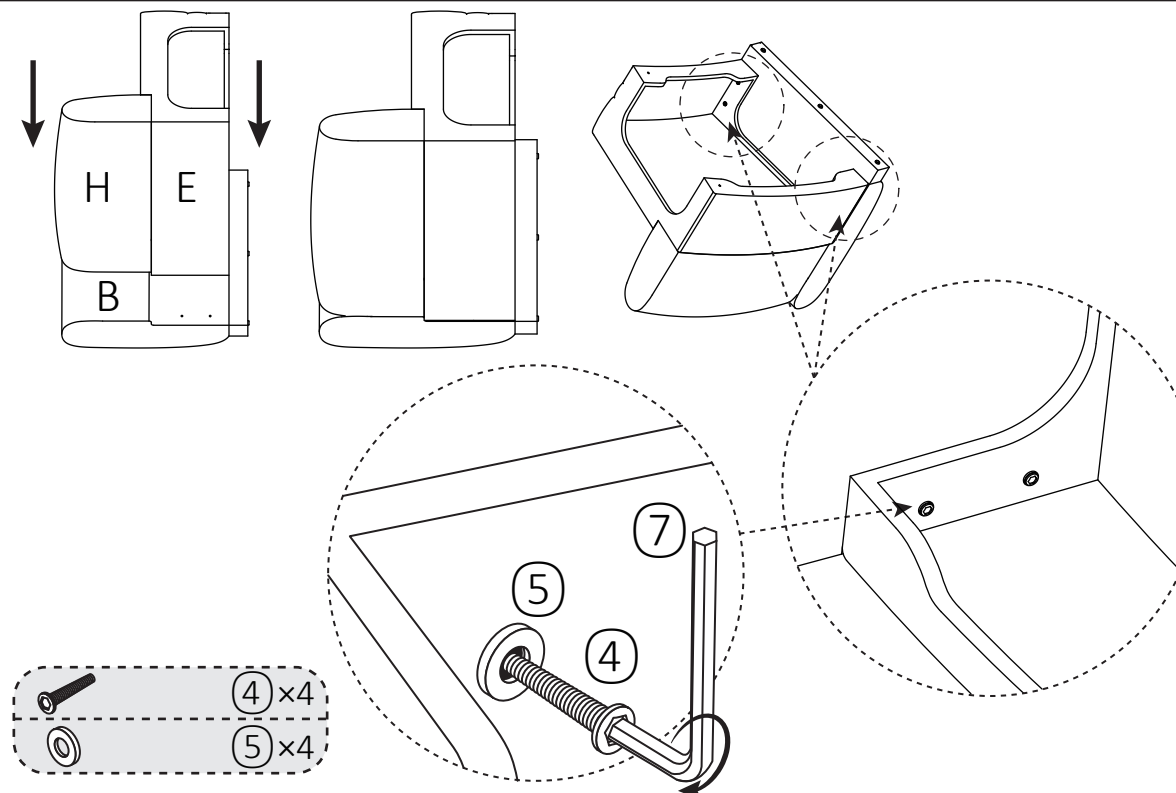
Place the Right Backrest (H) onto the Right Sofa Base (E) as shown in the diagram. Hold both parts in position, then flip the Right Sofa Base (E) so its bottom faces forward. Align the screw holes on both parts, and then assemble them together using the Long Screws (④) and Washers (⑤).

Step 7



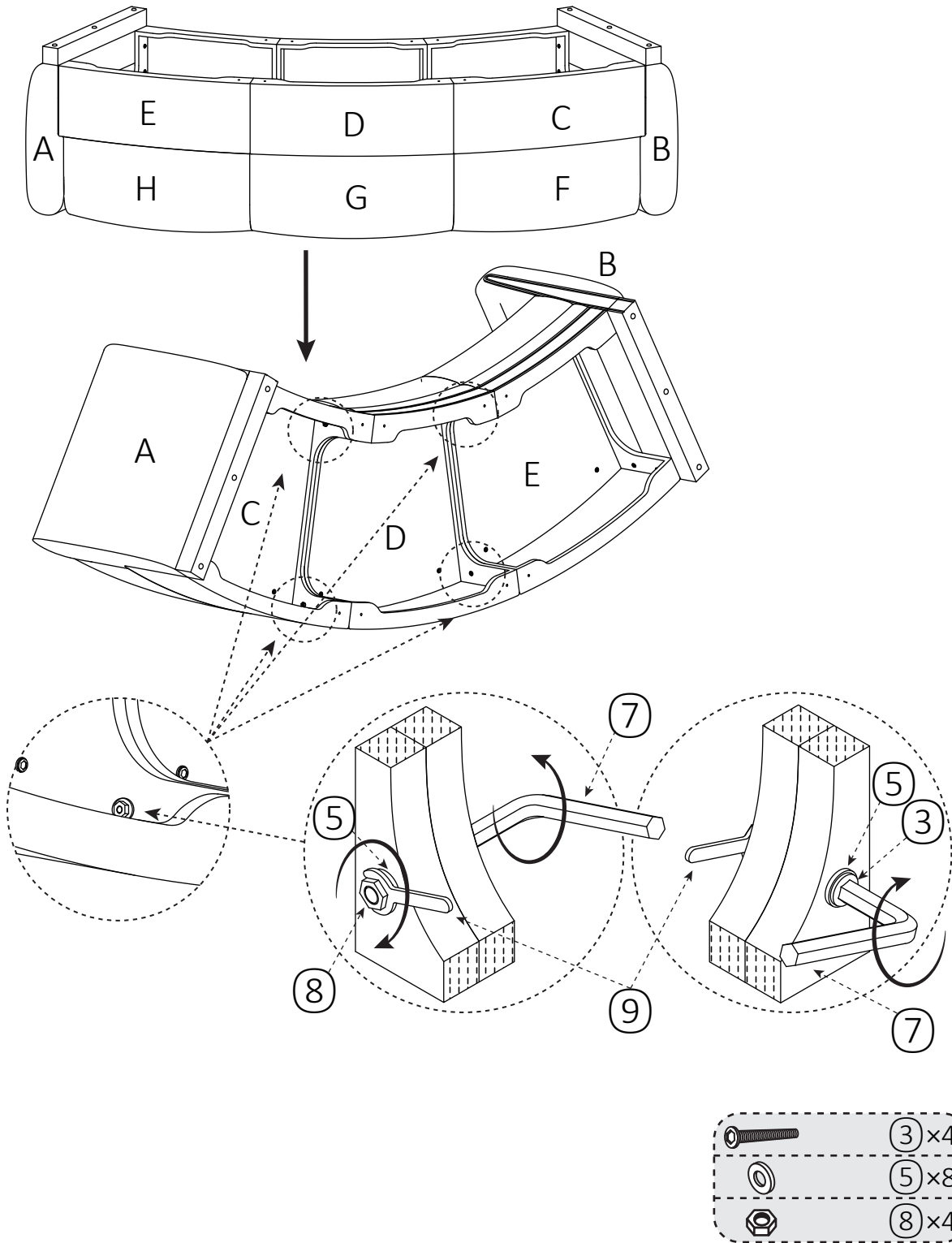
Place the Left Armrest (A) with its inner side facing upward on the cushion, then position the semi-finished product composed of the Left Backrest (F) and Left Sofa Base (C) on top of it. Assemble the two parts together using the Long Screws (4) and Washers (5).

Step 8



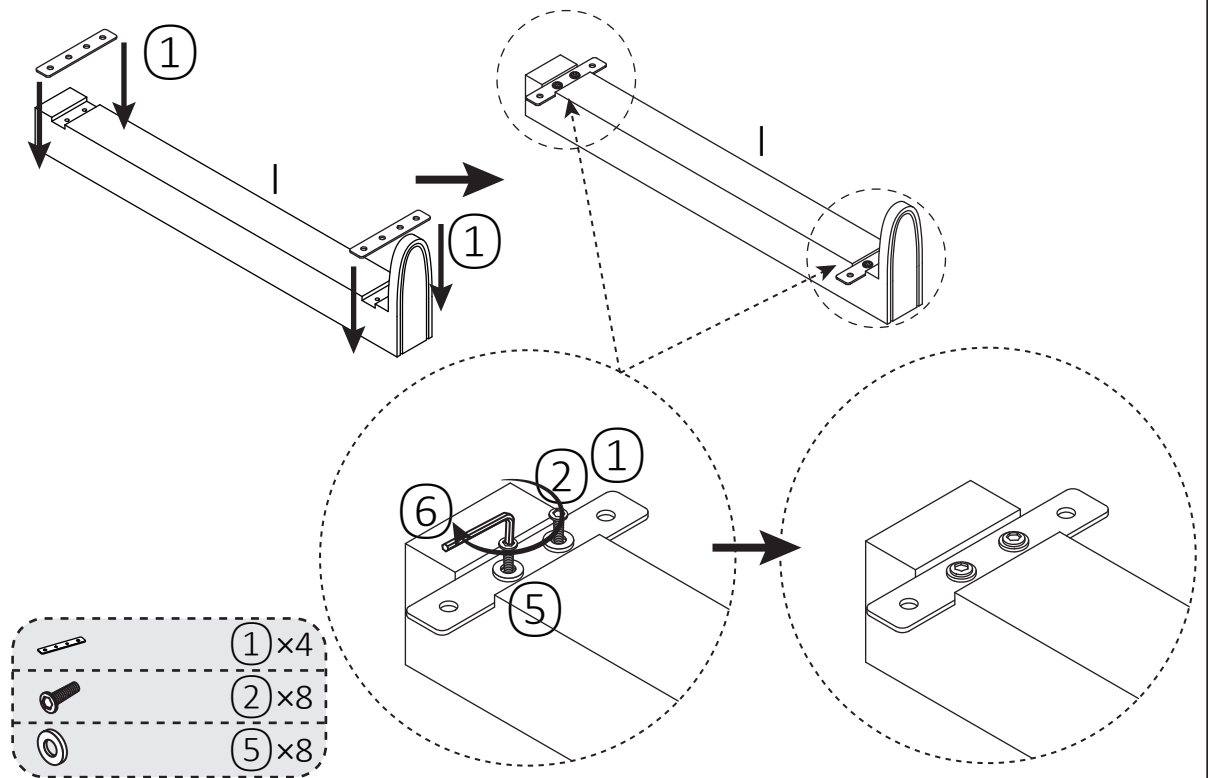
Place the Right Armrest (B) with its inner side facing upward on the cushion, then position the semi-finished product composed of the Right Backrest (H) and Right Sofa Base (E) on top of it. Assemble the two parts together using the Long Screws (4) and Washers (5).

Step 9



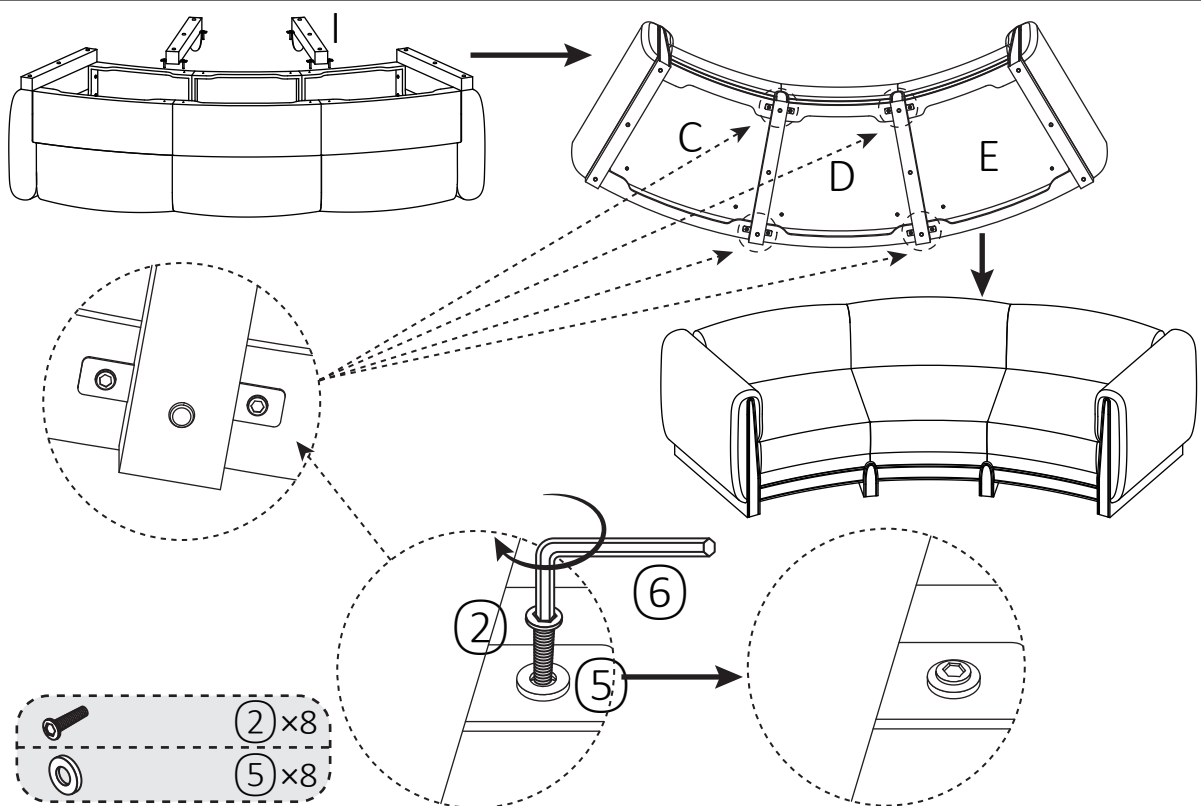
Place the three semi-assembled units from the previous steps upside down on the cushion. Then, bring them together so their bottom, front, and rear edges are aligned. Ensure the internal screw holes are aligned, then connect them using Long Screws ((3)), Washers ((5)), and Hex Nuts ((8)) (note that Washers ((5)) are used on both sides). Install them as shown in the diagram. During installation, keep the Small Wrench ((9)) stationary and turn the Allen Wrench ((7)) clockwise, or turn both in opposite directions until they can't be turned any further. After completing the connection, do not stand the product upright; leave it for use in subsequent steps.

Step 10



Place the Sofa Leg (l) flat on the cushion, then position the Connector (①) into its groove. Align the screw holes and assemble the two together using the Screws (②) and Washer (⑤) for the next step.

Step 11



Position the assembled component from the last step on top of them as shown in the diagram. Align the screw holes and secure all three semi-assembled units together using the Screws (②), Washers (⑤), and Sofa Leg (l). Finally, stand the finished product upright to complete the assembly.

Questions & Answers about Proposition 65

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
