**Step 2. Console backrest is stored in plastic bag at the bottom of the console. Please take out for assembly.**





**Step 3. Align the female brackets at the backrest onto the male brackets at the seat, insert and push to the end, make sure the brackets are secured in position.**

**Step 4. Insert the LSF ear to the LSF backrest and make sure it is secured in position.**






6	BASS	"Bass adjustment, two stalls, shift bass output to 50% or 100%"
7	▶▶	Touch to skip to the next track.
