Care & Maintenance

- 🚫 
 - Not for commercial use. For residential use only.

- ✓ 
 - Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.

- 🚫 
 - Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.

- 🚫 
 - Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.

- 🚫 
 - Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.

- 🚫 
 - Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.

- 🚫 
 - Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.

- 🚫 
 - Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.


- 🚫

 - Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- ✓



Assembly Preparation

Before Beginning Assembly:



- Read instructions, cover to cover-



- Have 2 adults on hand for assembly-



- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-


Assembly Steps

Overview




This chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all the parts and hardware on a clean, non-marring surface.


Step 2



Slotte the latches on the Left Arm(C) into the latches on the Left Leg(E) as shown in above picture.


Repeat same step to attach the Right Arm(D) to Right Leg(F).

Step 3



Screw the Full Tooth Screw(①) into the mounting position on the top of the Back Leg(G). Tighten the screws.

Step 4




Align the mounting position on the Left Arm(C) and Right Arm(D) to the Full Tooth Screw(①) on the Back Leg(G).

Attach Left Arm(C) and Right Arm(D) to the Full Tooth Screw(①) on the Back Leg(G) using Nut(②), Crescent Nut(③) with Nut Wrench(④).

Do not fully tighten the nuts.

Step 5




5.1)Screw the Full Tooth Screw(①) into the mounting position of the Back Leg(G) by hand.

5.2)Attach the Full Tooth Screw(①) and Wood Plug(⑨) to the mounting position of the Left Leg(E) and Right Leg(F) by hand, as shown above picture.

Fully tighten the screws.

Note: Do not over tighten the screws.

Step 6




Align the mounting position on the Seat Pad(B) to the Full Tooth Screw(①) and Wood Plug(⑨) which were pre-installed on the Legs(E+F+G).

Attach Seat Pad(B) to Full Tooth Screw(①) on the Legs(E+F+G) using Nut(②), Crescent Nut(③) with Nut Wrench(④).

Do not fully tighten the nuts.


Step 7



Attach Back(A) to the mounting positions of the Left Arm(C) and Right Arm(D) using Bolt(⑤), Spring Washer(⑥) and Washer(⑦) with Allen Wrench(⑧).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 8



Check for stability and then tighten all the remaining bolts.

DO NOT fully tighten a bolt in one go and then move on to the next.


Rather, in a sequential manner, gradually tighten each bolt until all bolts are evenly secured.

This methodology will ensure maximum evenness once all bolts are fully tightened.

Your Chair is ready for use.

This Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.

Step 9



Attach Cap(10) to the mounting position on the Left Arm(C) and Right Arm(D).

Note: The use of Caps(10) are OPTIONAL and are mainly useful to make the chair looks nicer.
