

Care & Maintenance

- 🚫  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- 🚫  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- 🚫  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- 🚫  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- 🚫  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- 🚫  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.


Keep your child / children at bay during the assembly process.



Before Beginning Assembly:





- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-
- Save all packaging until finished-



FRONT FACING


This Table has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Table, the above picture is to assemble is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions here below to familiarise the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.


Step 2



Place Table Top (N) on a clear, non-marring surface as shown above picture.
Attach Support Bar (O) into the Table Top (N) by using Screws (10) and Allen Wrench (11).

Do not fully tighten the Screws.

Step 3




Inserting Dowels on Legs into Housings on Table Top (N).

Attach the First Legs (P) and Second Leg (Q) into the Table Top (N) by using Bolts (⑧) and Allen Wrench (⑪)

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.


Step 4



Attach the First Legs (P) and Second Leg (Q) into Support Bar (O) by using Bolts (⑧), Sleeve Nuts (⑨) and Allen Wrenches (⑪).

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.

Step 5



Stand the Table up, with assistance from your adult partner.

Exert pressure floorwards, onto the Table with both your hands.

This pressure will help the Legs and Table Top reach full alignment status.

Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface.

If no wobbles are found proceed to tighten the Screws in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.

When tightening the Bolts, please tighten sequentially.

Do not tighten any Bolts fully and then move on towards the next one.

If there are still wobbles, loosen the Screws and execute the same above process.

Your Table is ready for use.

This Table can only be used on the flat, level surface.
