
**Caution : You must read this before you proceed**

## Care & Maintenance

- ⊘  ● Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  ● Prolonged exposure to rain may cause rusting which can stain floors.
- ⊘  ● Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  ● Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  ● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊘  ● Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊘  ● Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  ● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊘  ● Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  ● Keep away from sources of ignition.
- ✓  ● Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.








Caution: This Single Chair is NOT a TOY.


- Read instructions, cover to cover.

- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet.




- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam ).



- Save all packaging until finished.






## Assembly Preparation

### Overview




This Single chair has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Single chair ,the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions here below to familiarise the parts and steps before assembly.

### Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface




## Step 2



With assistance from your adult partner, place the Backrest Panel (A) onto a clean, non marring surface attach the Seat Panel (B) to Backrest Panel (A) by using Bolts (①), with Allen Wrench (③) as shown above.

**DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.**


## Step 3



Twist and Adjust height for balance    Adjust low for balance  
Adjust Pre-installed Levelers height for balance

With assistance from your adult partner, turn the chair right side up.

## Step 4



With assistance from your adult partners, turn the Bench back to normal flat ground. Place the Seat Cushion (C) & Square Back Cushion (D) and Back Cushion (E) onto the Bench as shown above.

Tie the magic tape straps of Seat Cushion (C)

Place the Single Chair on a LEVEL surface.

Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Gently and gracefully, sit onto the Single Chair. This pressure will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.

Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface. If no wobbles are found, proceed to tighten the Bolts in a sequential manner, until evenly secured.

Adjust the Levelers until the Bench is level with the ground.

To adjust the Levelers, get assistance from an adult partner to lift/lean and hold the Single Chair while you are working.
