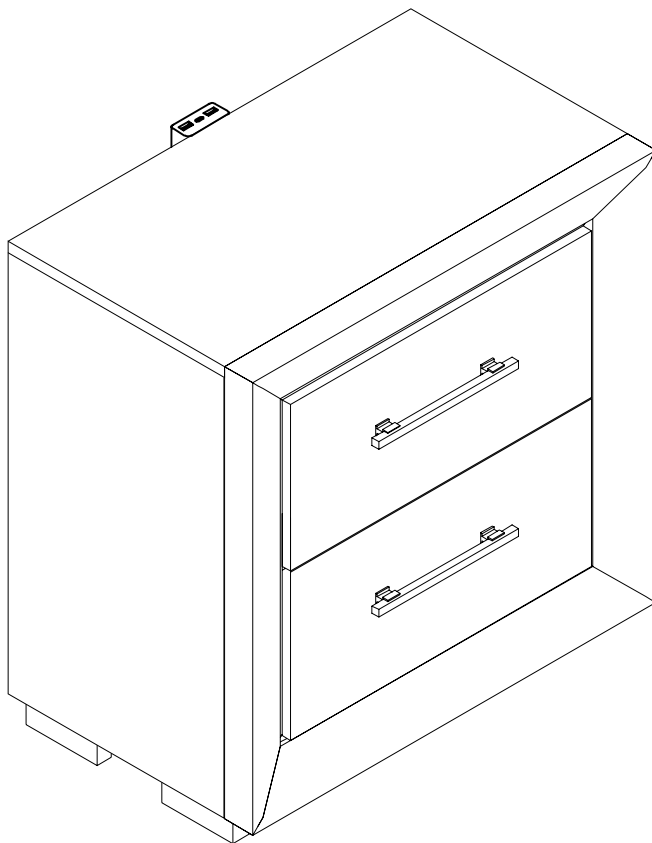


MAINTENANCE
