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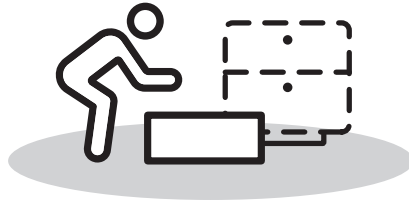
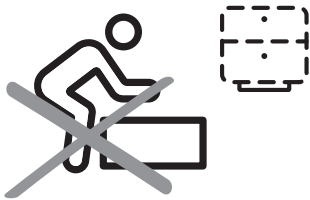
PRE ASSEMBLY INTRODUCTION

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



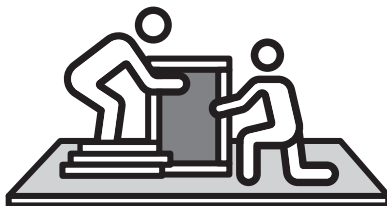

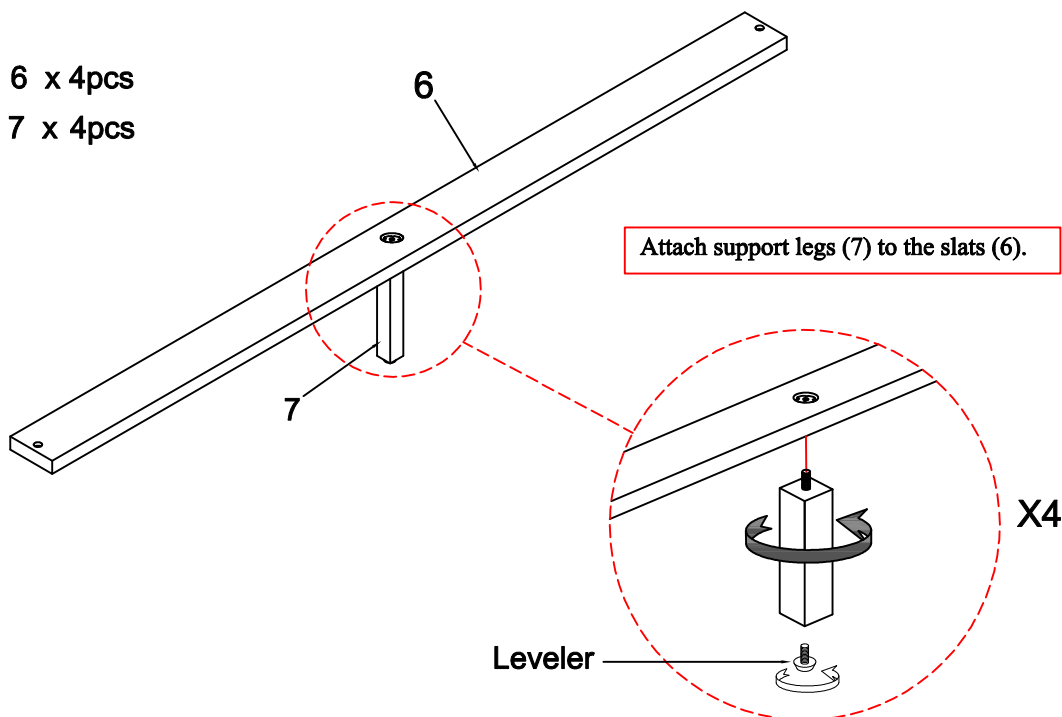


Attach threaded studs (G) to the headboard and footboard, then align side rails (5) to the threaded studs (G). Secure by using nuts (I) with washers (H).

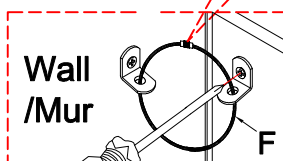
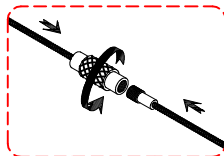


Align leg (2) to the nightstand (1), then secure by using bolts (B) with washers (C,D).



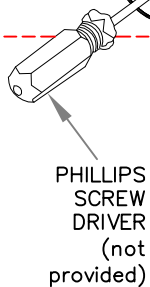
