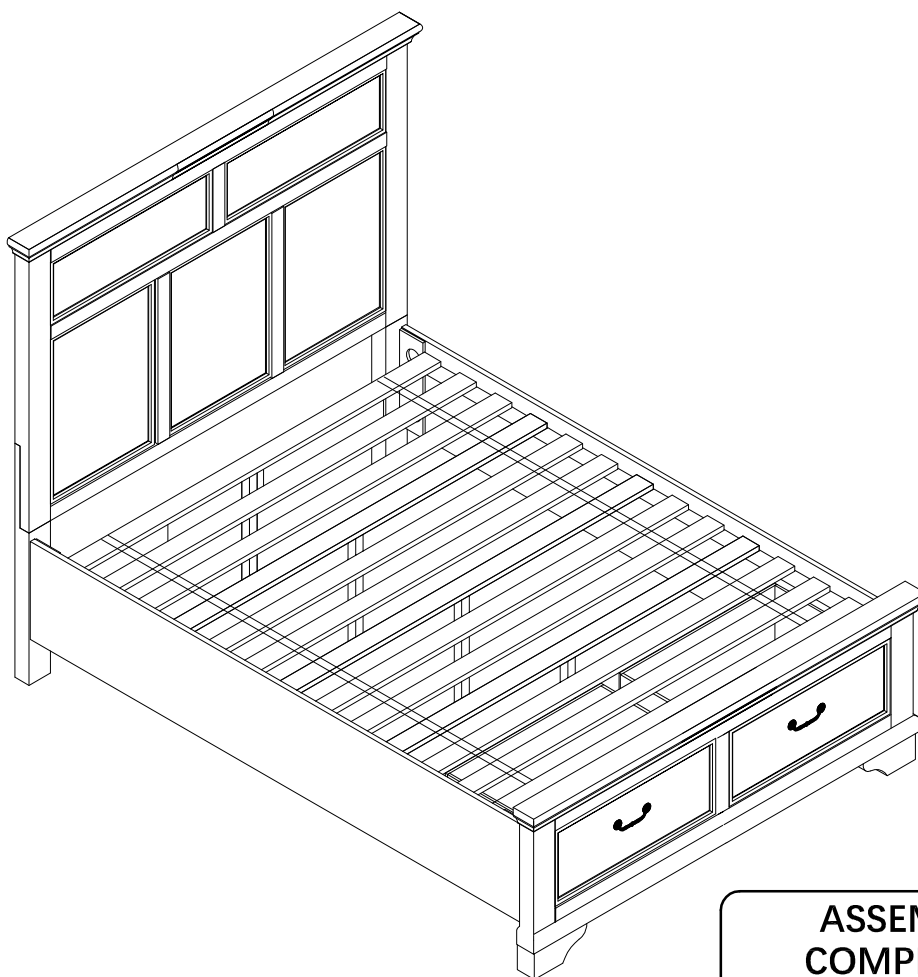
Screw the Bolt (H) into HB & FB.
