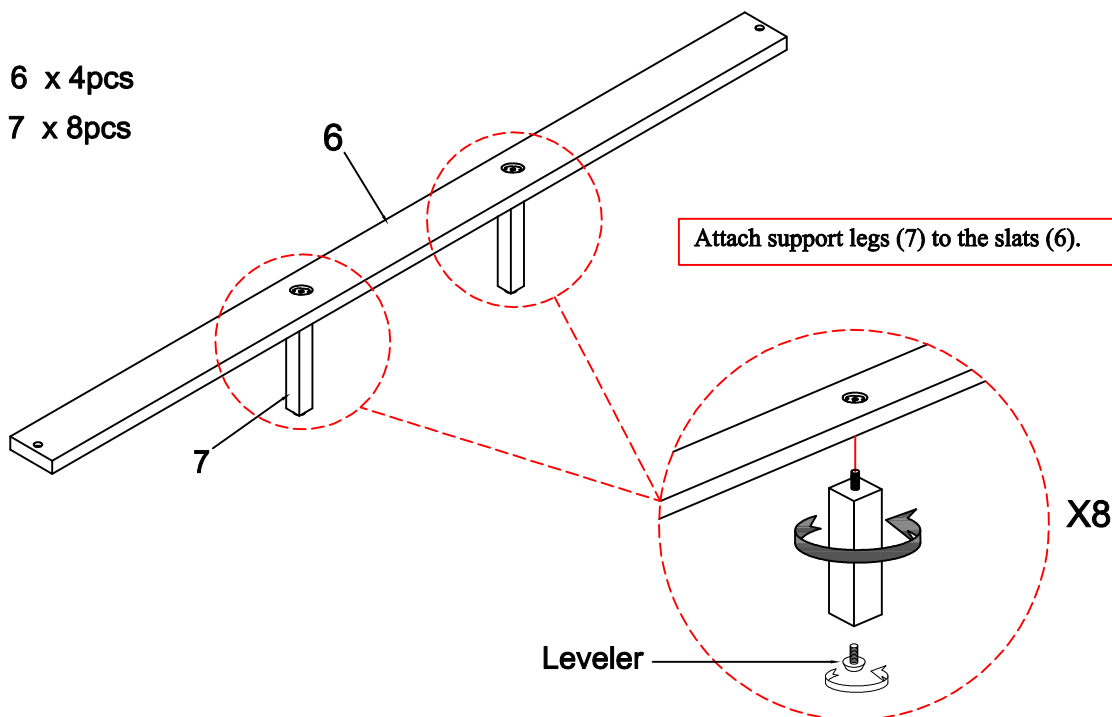


Attach threaded studs (G) to the headboard and footboard, then align side rails (5) to the threaded studs (G). Secure by using nuts (I) with washers (H).
