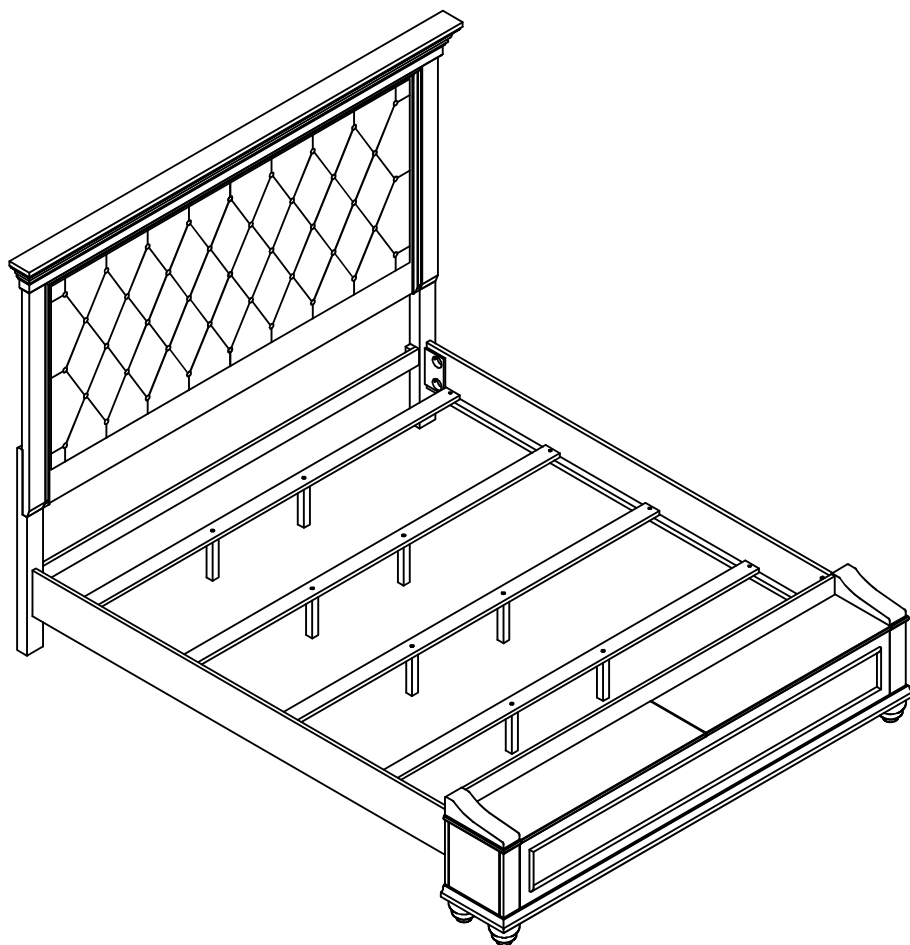

ALWAYS have at least two people to help with transporting and assembling the product to avoid potential injury and/or damage.



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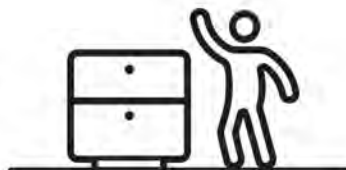
Sufficient Space

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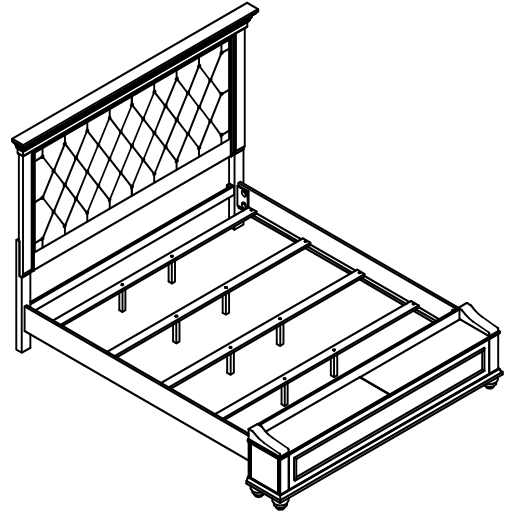

thereafter.

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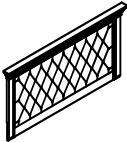
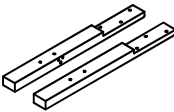
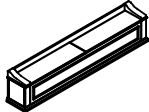
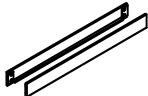

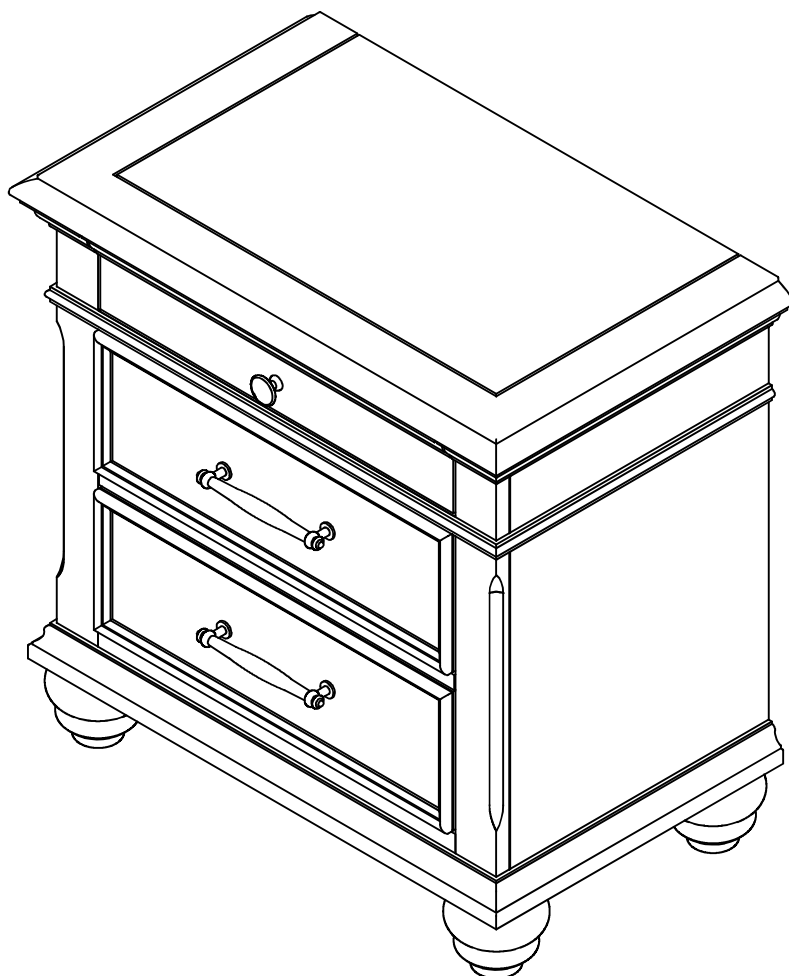


MAINTENANCE
