

# Assembly Instructions


**Caution : You must read this before you proceed .**

## Care & Maintenance

- ⊘  Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊘  Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊘  Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊘  Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.








## ROCKING CHAIR




Caution: This Rocking Chair is NOT a TOY.



- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-

# Assembly Steps


## Overview



**FRONT FACING**


This Rocking Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Rocking Chair parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

## Step 1:



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.


## Step 2:



With assistance from your adult partner, attach the Left Leg Panel (A) to the Seat Panel (C) using Bolts (1), Bolts (3), Screws (5), Nut (6) and Allen Wrench (7) as shown in picture above.

**DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.**


### **Step 3:**



With assistance from your adult partner, attach the Backrest Panel (D) to the Left Leg Panel (A) using Bolts (②) and Allen Wrench (⑦) as shown in picture above.

**DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.**


### **Step 4:**



With assistance from your adult partner, attach the Backrest Support Bar (E) to the Left Leg Panel (A) using Screws (④) and Allen Wrench (⑦) as shown in picture above.


**DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.**

## Step 5:



With assistance from your adult partner, attach the Right Leg Panel (B) to assembled part in Step 4 using Bolts (①), Bolts (②), Bolts (③), Screws (④), Screws (⑤), Nut (⑥) and Allen Wrench (⑦) as shown in picture above.  
**DO NOT fully tighten the Bolts.**

## Step 6:



Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Gently and gracefully, sit onto the Rocking Chair.

This will help to align all the parts at all joint areas.


Then get off the Rocking Chair and proceed to tighten the Bolts and Screws in a sequential manner.

When tightening the Bolts, Screws, please tighten sequentially.

**DO NOT tighten any Bolts, Screws fully and then move on towards the next one.**

If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts, Screws and execute this same process.

## Step 7:



Put Seat Cushion (G) onto the Seat Panel ( C )

Tie the magic tapes of Seat Cushion (G) to the slat of Seat Panel ( C )

Put Back Cushion (F) onto the Seat Panel ( C )

Your Rocking Chair is ready for use.

**This Rocking Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.**
