

# Assembly Instructions

**Caution: You must read these Assembly Instructions before you proceed**

## Care & Maintenance



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor product minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.




- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint- free cloth.








## BENCH 3 SEATER




**Caution:** This Bench 3 Seater is NOT a TOY.

# Assembly Steps


## Overview



**FRONT FACING**


This Bench 3 Seater has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Bench 3 Seater, the above picture to assemble to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions here below to familiarise the parts and steps before assembly.

## Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

## Step 2




Place the Left Arm Panel (A) upright as shown in the picture above onto a clean, soft surface to avoid any scratches or damage to the product.

2. Attach Left Arm Panel (A) to the Backrest Panel (C) and Seat Panel (D) using Screw (2) with Allen Wrench (6).

**Do not fully tighten the Screw.**

## Step 3




With assistance from your adult partner(s), attach the Right Arm Panel (B) to the assembled parts in Step 2:

3. Attach Right Arm Panel (B) to the Backrest Panel (C) and Seat Panel (D) using Screw (2) with Allen Wrench (6).


**Do not fully tighten the Screw.**

## Step 4




4. Attach Backrest Panel (C) and Seat Panel (D) using Bolt (3) and Sleeve Nut (4) with Allen Wrench (6).  
**Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**

## Step 5




5. With the help of a friend, tilt the Bench 3 Seater to a 45-degree angle Support Support Leg (E) and Seat Panel (D) using screws (1) with Allen Wrench (6).  
**Do not fully tighten the Screw.**

## Step 6



6. Attach the Button (5) into the Bench 3 Seater as shown in picture above.


## Step 7



7. Place Seat Cushion (F) and Back Cushion (G) onto the Bench 3 Seater and affix the magic tape straps around the Bench 3 Seater as shown above.

**This Bench 3 Seater can only be used on a flat, level surface.**

## Step 8



Inspect the Bench 3 Seater and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Then EXERT pressure, floorwards onto the Bench 3 Seater with both hand

This pressure will help align all parts at all joints.

In a sequential manner, tighten all Bolts and Screws at all joints.

**Adjust the Levellers until the Bench 3 Seater is level with the ground.**

**To adjust the Levellers, get assistance from an adult partner to lift/lean and hold the Bench 3 Seater while you are working.**

**CAUTION :** When tightening these screws and bolts, tighten sequentially.

**DO NOT** tighten any screw or bolt fully and then move towards the next one. This could cause the frame to warp.

**WARNING!! IF THE BENCH 3 SEATER IS NOT STABLE , IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.**
