


	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.



- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-

Overview




↖ FRONT FACING

This cabinet has multiple parts and may require up to some 15 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the cabinet parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on clean, non - marring surface.



Place the Top Fame (A) upside down as show above.

Attach the Leg Fame (B) to the bottom of Top Fame (A) by using Bolts (①), Spring Washer (②), Flat Washer (③) with Allen Wrench (④)

At this step, fully tighten the Bolt.


Remove the handle inside the doors

Attach the handle to the outside of the door

Stand the cabinet on it right side up.
Sliding the doors to open it and remove the Handle inside the doors and attach them to the mounting position on the outside of doors with Screwdriver (Not provided).

Step 3




Exert pressure floorwards onto the Cabinet with both your hands.
This pressure will help the Legs and Cabinet Top reach full alignment status. Check for wobbles on a LEVEL surface.
If no wobbles are found proceed to tighten the Bolts and screws in a sequential manner until evenly secured.
Your Cabinet is ready for use.
This Cabinet can only be used on the flat, level surface.





4.1: Find the location of the screw holes on the wall. Move the cabinet back to the wall. Mark one points the same height as the cabinet on the wall.

NOTE: The metal Brackets need to be secured to solid, load bearing surface. Please use a Stud Finder (not provided) if needed to locate the Wall Frame.

Insert the Plastic Anchors (5.1) into the wall and attach Metal Brackets (5.2) to Plastic Anchors (5.1) using long screw (5.3) with Screwdriver.

4.2: Attach the Metal Brackets (5.2) to the Cabinet using the short screw (5.4) with Screwdriver.

4.3: Thread the Strap (5.5) through the 2pcs Metal Brackets (5.2) to secure the Cabinet to the wall.

CAUTION: Restraint Strap (5.5) between the product and Metal Brackets (5.2) on the wall should be within 3.5"
