






This Shelf has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Shelf parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.




Unpack and place the all Part on a clean, non-marring surface.

Step 2



Attach the Shelf Panel (A) to Front Legs (B) using Bolts (①) + Spring washer (②) + Flat washer (③) and Allen Wrench (④) as shown above picture.



Please note that the end of the shelf Leg with the plastic base nail must always face downward.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.





Foot Nail always bottom



Attach the Shelf Panel (A) to Back Middle Legs (B) and Back Side Legs (C) using Bolts (1) + Spring washer (2) + Flat washer (3) and Allen Wrench (4) as shown above picture.

Please note that the end of the shelf Leg with the plastic base nail must always face downward. **Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**



Turn the Shelf right side up.

Place the Shelf on a **LEVEL SURFACE**.

Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Don't push too hard, shake on the bed.

This would help to align all the parts at all the joint areas.

CAUTION 1: When tightening these screws, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any screw fully and then towards the next one.

This would cause the frame to warp.

If there is still wobbles, loosen the screws and execute this same process.

DO NOT tighten any screw fully and then towards the next one.

WARNING!! IF SHELF IS NOT STABLE , IT COULD LEAD TO DAMAGING THE PRODUCT.

Ensure all screws are fully locked into position.



Shelf Restraint Device Installation Instructions:





Serious or fatal crushing injuries can occur from tipping furniture.
To help prevent tip-over: **ALWAYS** secure this furniture to the wall using Shelf Restraint Device.
See product instructions for more ways to help prevent furniture tip-over.




To secure Shelf against the wall, attach 2pcs Metal Brackets (6.2) to the wall and 2pcs on the Bookcase.
Then use Shelf Restraint Straps (6.5) to connect the Metal Brackets (6.2) on the wall and the Shelf

Step 4:



Turn the Shelf outwards, as shown above.
Then fix the L-shaped Metal Brackets (6.2) to the back of the Shelf with
Screws (6.4) and Screwdriver (5)

Step 7:



Next, insert the Plastic anchors (6.1) into the pre-drilled holes in the wall. Then fasten the L bracket (6.2) to the wall with the Long screws (6.3) using a screwdriver (5)

Find the location of the screw holes on the wall.

You can mark these points in two ways as below:



1) Move the Shelf back to the wall. Mark two points the same height as the Bookcase on the wall.

Note: The Metal Brackets need to be secured to solid, load bearing surface. Please use a Stud Finder(not supplied) if needed to locate the Wall Frame.

2) Measure the height from the floor to the Metal Brackets (6.2) on the Shelf with ruler/measuring tape and mark on the wall to keep them accurate and same height.

(Caution: The Shelf Restraint Strap (6.5) between the product and Metal brackets (6.2) on the wall should be within 3.5")

Wall



Move the Shelf back against wall.

Pull the Restraint Straps (6.5) through the Metal Brackets (6.2) on the wall and on the Shelf one by one, and lock the Restraint Straps (6.5) tightly, as shown above.

The Shelf Restraint Device is installed and your Shelf is ready for use.
