

# Assembly Instructions


**CAUTION: You must read these Assembly Instructions before you proceed.**

## Care & Maintenance

- ⊘  ● Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  ● Prolonged exposure to rain may cause rusting which can stain floors.
- ⊘  ● Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  ● Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  ● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊘  ● Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊘  ● Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  ● To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊘  ● Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  ● Keep away from sources of ignition.
- ✓  ● Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.







# Loveseat





**CAUTION:** This Loveseat is NOT a TOY



## Assembly Preparation

Before Beginning Assembly:



- Read instructions, cover to cover.



- Have 2 adults on hand for assembly.



- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet.




- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam).



- Save all packaging until finished.


## Assembly Steps

### Overview




This Loveseat has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Loveseat parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

### Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.


### Step 2



With assistance from your adult partner: Attach the Left Leg Panel (A) and the Right Leg Panel (B) to the Backrest Panel (C) using Screws ①, Screws ② and the Allen Wrench ④ as shown above.

**Do not fully tighten the Screws.**


### Step 3



With assistance from your adult partner: Attach the the assembled parts from Step 2 to the Support Panel (D) using Bolts ③ and the Allen Wrench ④ as shown above.


**Do not fully tighten the Bolts.**

#### Step 4



Attach the Seat Panel (E) to the assembled parts from Step 3 using the Screw (2) and the Allen Wrench (4) as shown above as shown above.  
**Do not fully tighten the Screws.**

#### Step 5



With assistance from your adult partners, turn the Loveseat up. EXERT pressure, floorwards onto the Loveseat with both hands. This pressure will help the Loveseat reach full alignment at all joints. Check for wobbles.

In a sequential manner, gradually tighten all Bolts, Screws at all joints until evenly secured. Inspect Loveseat and make sure all part are adequately connect.


**CAUTION: When tightening the Bolts, Screws tighten sequentially. DO NOT tighten any Bolts, Screws fully and then move towards the next one. This could cause the frame to warp.**

**If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts, Screws and execute the same above process.**

**With assistance from your adult partners, adjust the Levelers to the desired height to avoid wobbles.**

**If the Loveseat is not stable, it could lead to damage to the product.**

## Step 6



Place the Seat Cushion (F) onto the Loveseat and affix the magic tape straps around the Loveseat as shown above.

Then place the Back Cushion (G) onto the Loveseat.

**Your Loveseat is ready to be used.**

**This Loveseat can only be used on a flat, level surface.**

## **Questions & Answers about Proposition 65**

- What is Proposition 65?

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. These chemicals can be in the products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. By requiring that this information be provided, Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

Proposition 65 also prohibits California businesses from knowingly discharging significant amounts of listed chemicals into sources of drinking water.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987.

- What types of chemicals are on the Proposition 65 list?

The list contains a wide range of naturally occurring and synthetic chemicals that include additives or ingredients in pesticides, common household products, food, drugs, dyes, or solvents. Listed chemicals may also be used in manufacturing and construction, or they may be byproducts of chemical processes, such as motor vehicle exhaust.

- What does a warning mean?

If a warning is placed on a product label or posted or distributed at a workplace, a business, or in rental housing, the business issuing the warning is aware or believes that it is exposing individuals to one or more listed chemicals.

By law, a warning must be given for listed chemicals unless the exposure is low enough to pose no significant risk of cancer or is significantly below levels observed to cause birth defects or other reproductive harm.
