
CAUTION: You must read these Assembly Instructions before you proceed.

Care & Maintenance

- ⊘  • Not for commercial use. For residential use only.
- ⊘  • Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.
- ⊘  • Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
- ⊘  • Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- ⊘  • Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- ✓  • To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- ⊘  • Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
- ✓  • Keep away from sources of ignition.
- ✓  • Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint- free cloth.








BAR CHAIR






CAUTION: This Bar Chair is NOT a TOY.


Label	Picture	Description	Qty

Assembly Preparation:

Before Beginning Assembly:



The diagram illustrates the components and hardware needed for assembly preparation. Component A is a rectangular frame with a mesh top. Component B is a square mesh mat. Components C, D, E, and Fx2 are various metal bars and rails. The hardware list includes:

- ① Allen Wrench x1
- ② Screw (M6x80mm) x3
- ③ Screw (M6x70mm) x7
- ④ Bolt (M6x70mm) x9
- ⑤ Washer (Ø7xØ16x2mm) x9



- Read instructions, cover to cover-



- Have 2 adults on hand for assembly-



- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-



- Save all packaging until finished-


Assembly Steps:

OVERVIEW




This Bar Chair has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Bar Chair, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions here below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1




Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.




With assistance from your adult partner, place Seat Panel (B) facing down then attach Left Leg (C) to Seat Panel (B) by using Bolts (④) and Washers (⑤) with Allen Wrench (①) as shown above.

Do not fully tighten the Bolts.



With assistance from your adult partner, attach Front Support Bar (E) to Left Leg (C) of the assembled part in Step 2 by using Screw (③) with Allen Wrench (①).

Do not fully tighten the Screw.




With assistance from your adult partner, attach Right Leg (D) to the assembled part in Step 3 as shown above. Then:

Step 4.1, secure Right Leg (D) to Seat Panel (B) by using Bolts (④) and Washers (⑤) with Allen Wrench (①).

Step 4.2, secure Right Leg (D) to Front Support Bar (E) by using Screw (③) with Allen Wrench (①).

Do not fully tighten the Screw and the Bolts.




With assistance from your adult partner, attach Side Support Bars (F) to the assembled part in Step 4 as shown above.

Then secure Side Support Bars (F) to both Left Leg (C) and Right Leg (D) by using Screws (③) with Allen Wrench (①).

Do not fully tighten the Screws.

Step 6



With assistance from your adult partner, attach Backrest Panel (A) to the assembled part in Step 5 as shown above. Then:


Step 6.1, secure Backrest Panel (A) to Seat Panel (B) by using Bolts (4) and Washers (5) with Allen Wrench (1).

Step 6.2, secure Backrest Panel (A) to Side Support Bars (F) by using Screws (3) with Allen Wrench (1).

Step 6.3, secure Backrest Panel (A) to Seat Panel (B) by using Screws (2) with Allen Wrench (1).

Do not fully tighten the Screws and the Bolts.

Step 7



Inspect it and make sure all parts are adequately connected.

Stand the Bar Chair right side up.

Then proceed to tighten the Bolts and Screws in a sequential manner.

When tightening the Bolts and Screws, tighten sequentially.

DO NOT tighten any Bolts, Screws fully and then move on towards the next one.

If there are still wobbles, loosen the Bolts, Screws and execute this same process.

Adjust Pre-installed Levelers height for balance.

Your Bar Chair is ready to use.

This Bar Chair can only be used on a flat, level surface.
