- The installation of some models may require drilling down into the threshold. Contact the manufacturer of the base, tub, or threshold material with any questions regarding the drilling of holes into their product.
- All drawings in this installation manual are for illustrative purposes only and are not drawn to scale.

TEMPERED GLASS WARNING

- Your Shower Door Glass Could Shatter Without Warning if Improperly Installed or Mishandled
- Do Not install or operate a shower door if the glass has chipped corners, slivered edges or is otherwise damaged and/or has been dropped or banged into a hard surface such as tile, marble or glass.
- The main causes of tempered glass breakage are:**
 - Improper handling, storage or installation
 - Misuse/abuse
 - Lack of maintenance
 - Failure to replace damaged glass
 - Improper handling during storage, unpacking and installation:**
 - Corners and edges are the most susceptible area to damage on a lite of tempered glass and should be protected and handled with care during storage, unpacking, installation and operation. A concentrated point of pressure or impact with a surface harder than itself may cause the tempered glass to shatter. The tempered glass may release immediately, within several hours or even days later.
 - Incorrect installation of door hardware, rollers, hinges, channels, stopper or glass:**
 - Improper installation may include: loose hardware and/or lack of proper gaskets between the hardware and glass. Additionally, improper alignment of guide rails, wall profiles or other hardware during installation or operation may place stress on the glass edges and cause it to break.
 - This product must be installed by a professional and experienced installer familiar with the safe handling of tempered glass.
 - Improper use of this product:**
 - Aggressively opening or closing the door may cause trauma to the glass, which can lead to breakage. This may occur immediately or hours or even days later.
 - The shower door hardware and glass should be inspected periodically:**
 - Instruct the homeowner how to perform a periodic inspection of the shower hardware and glass - some minor adjustments may be necessary based upon the use (or misuse) of the shower door. Ensure that the hardware remains tight and that the door alignment and operation are correct. Any adjustments should be made upon discovery to prevent damage to the product.
 - Additional considerations should be given to the installation of frameless tempered glass products in households with young children or an elderly person due to an increased chance of improper handling. In such cases, alternatives such as shower curtains or grab bars should be considered.

GENERAL PREPARATION

- After opening all boxes and packages, read this introduction carefully. Check that all the items are included in the package by marking off the components on the "Detailed Diagram of Product Components" page. Examine all boxes and packages for shipping damage. If the unit has been damaged, has a finishing defect, or is missing parts; please contact our Customer Support department within 3 business days of the delivery date. **Please note that DreamLine® will not replace any damaged products or missing parts free of charge after 3 business days or if the product has been installed.** Please contact DreamLine® if you have any questions.
- Please note that you should refer to your local building codes with questions on installation compliance standards. Building and plumbing codes may vary by location, and DreamLine® is not responsible for code compliance standards for your project and will not accept any returns.**
- If this unit is going to be installed in a new construction, install all the required plumbing and drainage before installing the shower. **Use a competent and licensed (if required by local code) plumber for all plumbing installation.**
- Make sure that prior to beginning the installation, the surfaces are leveled and solid and will be able to support the total weight of the unit. Also make sure the walls are at right angles. Irregular installation surface level, radius corners or improper angle of side walls will result in serious problems for your installation. Please note that some adjustments and drilling will be necessary during the installation process.
- Protect all primary surfaces of the product during installation. Never set your glass down directly onto a tile floor. Leave corner protectors in place until it is necessary to remove them. Always use a piece of wood or cardboard to protect the bottom edge and corners of the glass prior to and during installation.
- This unit must be installed upon a finished threshold and against finished walls.
- DreamLine® shower doors are not designed to be installed into a fiberglass surround due to the radius corners and lack of a solid surface to mount the hardware.*

WARNING: TO AVOID THE RISK OF DAMAGE OR INJURY:

- Follow all recommendations and requirements as shown in the installation instructions.**
- Perform a thorough inspection of the glass and all parts for any damage prior to installation. Any damage to tempered glass can cause breakage.
Do Not install damaged glass!
- Do Not install or operate a shower or tub door if the glass has chipped corners, slivered edges or is otherwise damaged. Do Not install or operate a shower or tub door that has been dropped or banged into a hard surface such as tile, marble or glass.
- CAUTION:** Contact with any hard surface can damage tempered glass and cause it to shatter.
- This product uses tempered glass. Glass cannot be cut after it has been tempered.
Do Not attempt to cut tempered glass.
- DreamLine® Glass Shower doors, Tub doors, Inline panels, and Return panels can shatter due to improper handling or lack of maintenance. Conduct periodic inspections of glass and all parts for possible damage, missing or loose parts.
- Always wear proper safety equipment such as: safety goggles, work gloves and appropriate footwear during the installation process.
- WARNING. Risk of leakage and/or damage.** Follow all instructions regarding the application of silicone sealant or caulk. Allow 24 hours for the sealant to cure before the initial use of the shower or tub product. Follow the silicone manufacturer's recommendations regarding the use of their product.
- Thoroughly read these instructions before installing or using this product.**
- Leave this manual for the end-user of the product.**



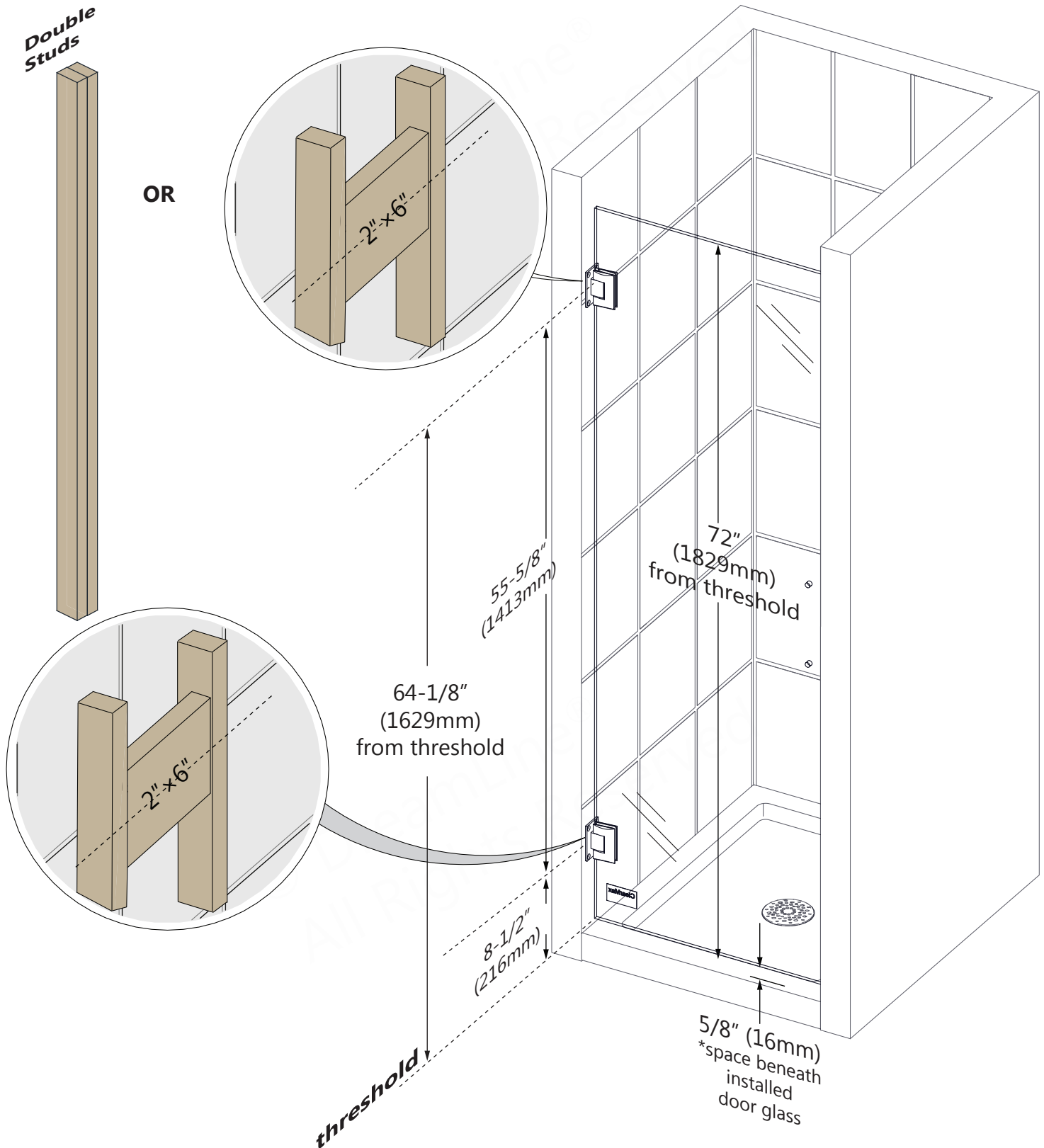

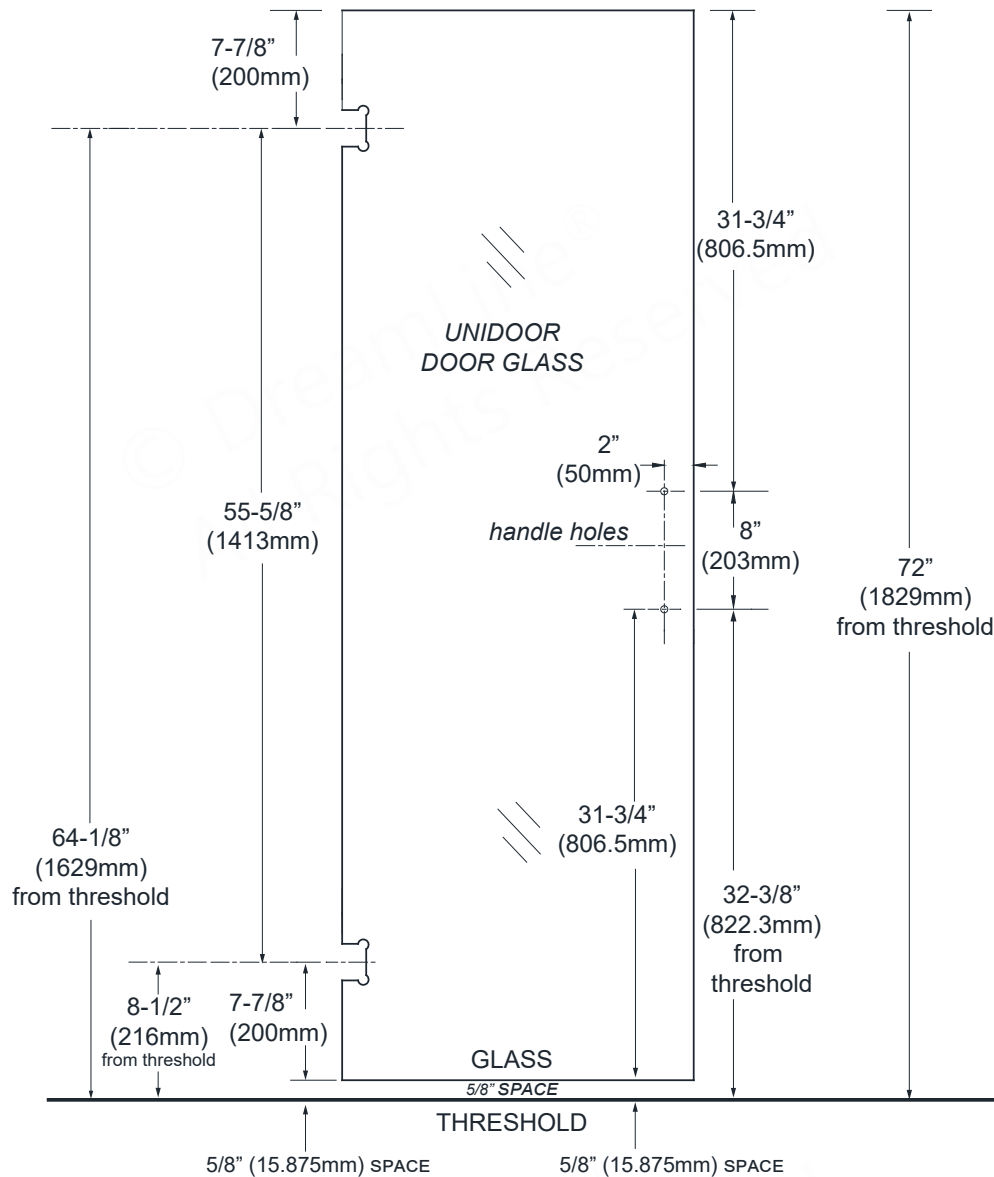

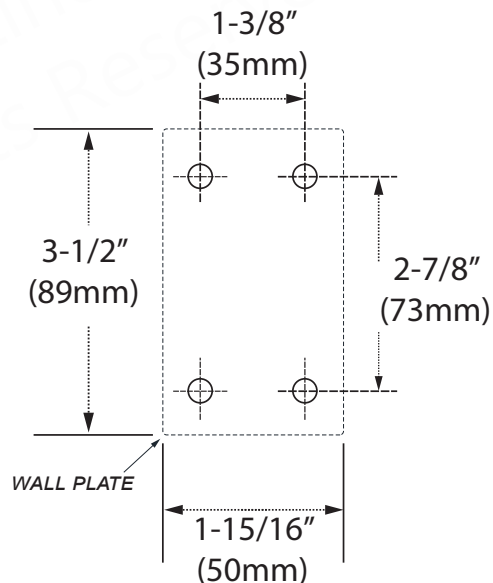
Install **DOUBLE STUDS OR** install **2" × 6" WOOD BLOCKING** between the studs where the hinge assemblies will attach to the wall.

Hinge Assembly Wall Plate Hole Layout

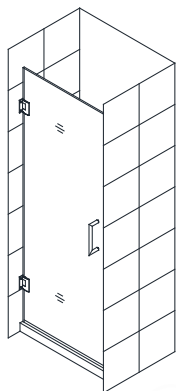

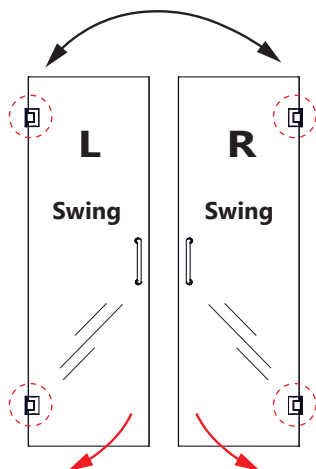
The PVC Hinge Spacers (#31) can be used to compensate for a minor out-of-plumb condition on the hinge-side wall up to 1/4" (6mm) and should only be used behind ONE Hinge Assembly (#05). Confirm the finished wall conditions with a level before drilling any holes. Unnecessary use of these spacers can compromise the fit of the door. (see Page 13 for more information)



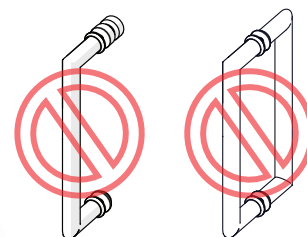

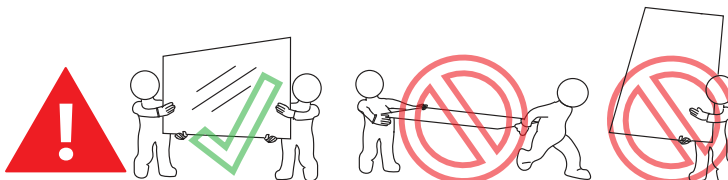

The UNIDOOR Series doors and enclosures are reversible for right or left-swing installation. The left-swing installation is shown as an example throughout this manual. For the right-swing installation, simply begin on the opposite wall and reverse the orientation of the steps shown.



DO NOT attach the Handle to the Door Glass until instructed.
DO NOT use the handle to lift the glass during installation. This may result in damage to the glass and/or serious personal injury. Always use an assistant and/or a professional-grade glass suction cup when handling heavy glass panels.

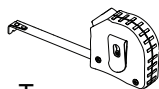

TIP

Verify that the correct model size has been ordered: measure the finished opening **before** proceeding with the installation.

Confirm that the finished walls are plumb and the threshold is level and pitched into the shower area.

Cover the shower/tub drain with tape prior to installation to prevent the loss of screws or small parts.

To prevent stripping the screw heads, set power drill to a low setting when installing screws.

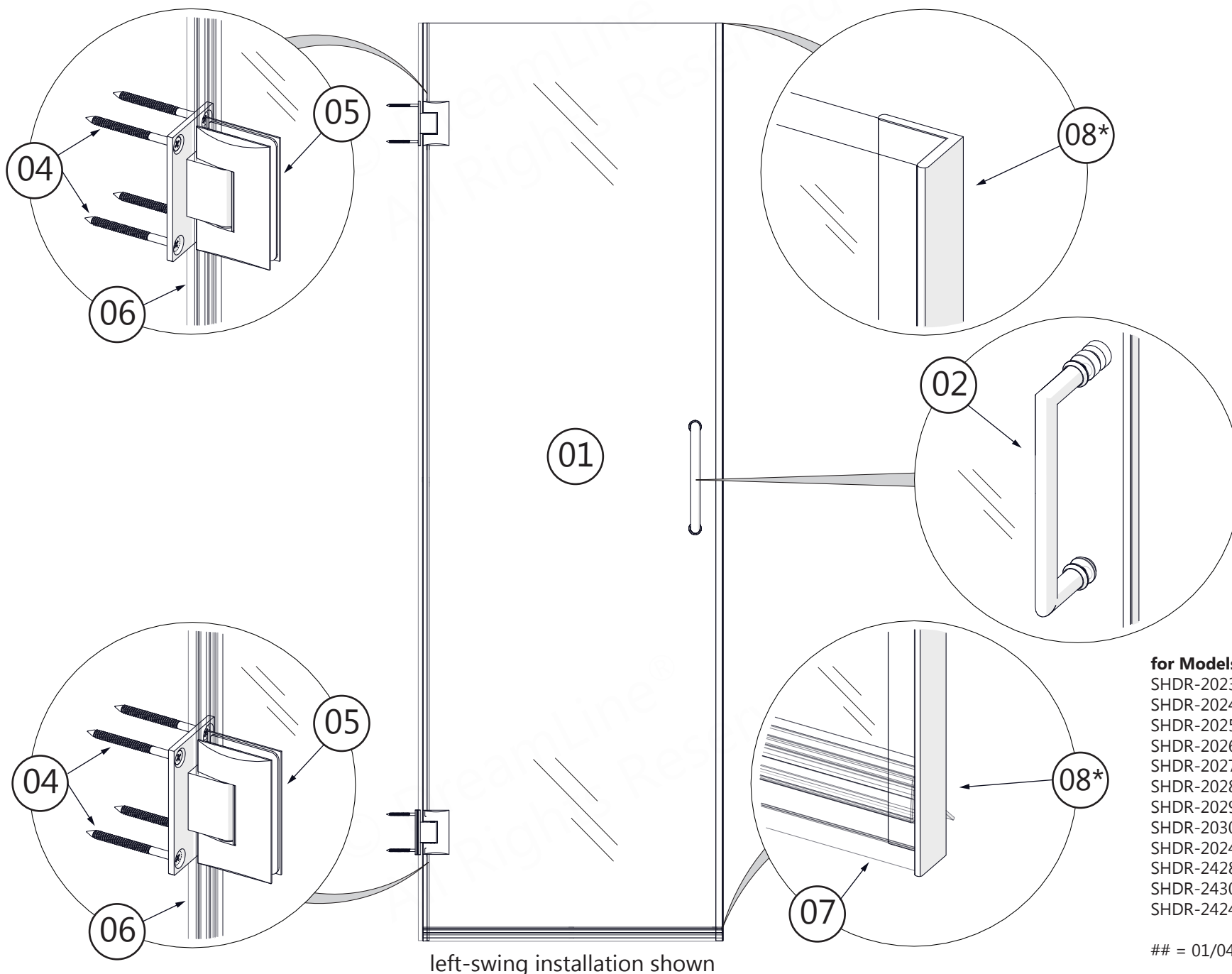
NOTE

Unpack your unit carefully and inspect it. Lay it out and identify all parts using the **Detailed Diagram** on **page 9** and the included packing list in this manual as a reference. Before discarding the carton, check for small hardware bags that may have fallen to the bottom of the box. If any parts are damaged or missing, please contact DreamLine® for replacement. The shipping boxes may contain extra parts not used in your model configuration.

NOTE

The following shower door installation instructions should be used as a general guide and prerequisite to the installation of the UNIDOOR, UNIDOOR PLUS, UNIDOOR-LS, UNIDOOR EDGE, UNIDOOR TOULON models. (for Unidoor-X models, use the manual packaged with the hinge panel glass in place of this manual). Before you begin the installation, check your finished opening size. Specific model size information can be found in the Tech Drawings on DreamLine.com

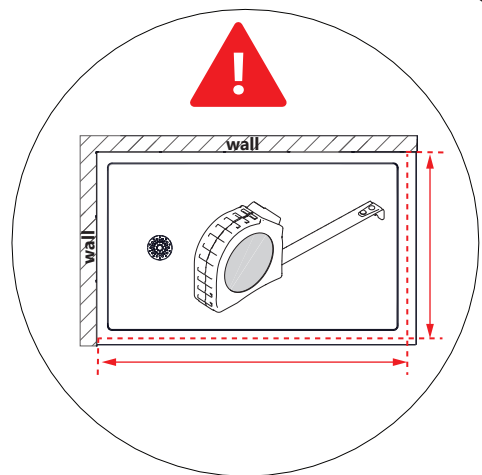

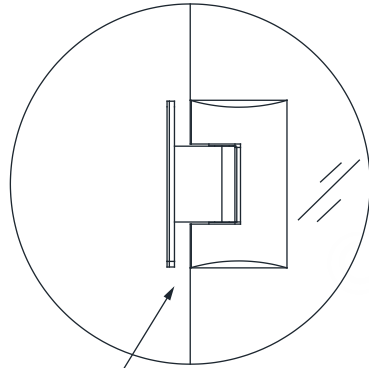
For Enclosure Models that include Return Panel Glass:

FIRST, before starting the door installation, it is important to review the Shower Enclosure Plan and Overview in the manual that is packaged with the Return Panel Glass to verify the model dimensions for proper placement of the Door Glass (#01) for accurate alignment with the Enclosure Panel Glass.



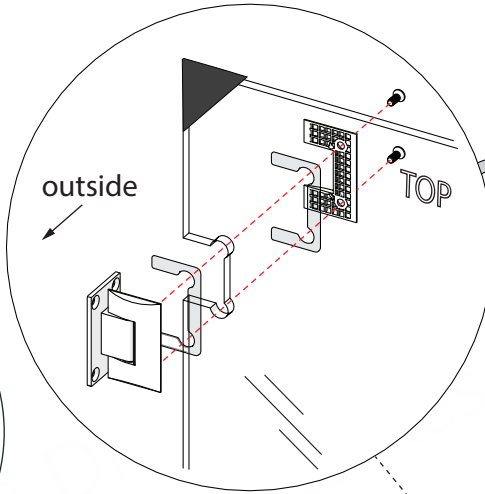

Installation Steps

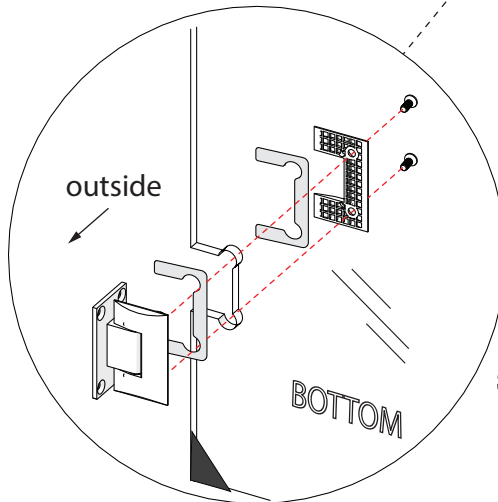


Install the hinges centered in the cutout and flush with the edge of the Door Glass

The door glass can be flipped for left or right swing installation. However, the ClearMax label must be on the inside.



Fully and evenly tighten the hinge bolts by hand. It is normal to hear the gaskets compress onto the glass.



Leave corner protectors on the glass until it is necessary to remove them!

The Adjustable Hinge Assemblies are factory pre-set to overclose to 85° to create a tight seal with the Strike Vinyl. See Page 21 for Hinge Adjustment details after installation.

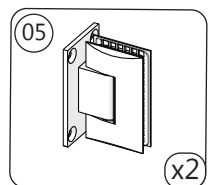
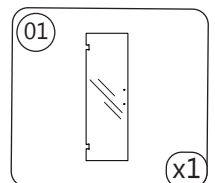


Clean the **Hinge gaskets** and the glass around the hinge notch with an alcohol swab or glass cleaner prior to attaching the **Hinge Assemblies (#05)** to the **Door Glass (#01)**.



Never set glass down directly onto a tile or concrete floor surface. Always use a piece of wood or cardboard and leave the corner protectors and shims on the glass until it becomes necessary to remove them. Always protect the bottom edge and corners of the glass from damage which could lead to breakage and/or serious personal injury.

The included **PVC Hinge Spacers (#31)** are provided to compensate for up to $1/4"$ (6mm) of minor out-of-plumb conditions on the hinge-side wall. Unnecessary use of the PVC Hinge Spacers could reduce the required opening size for the door glass.

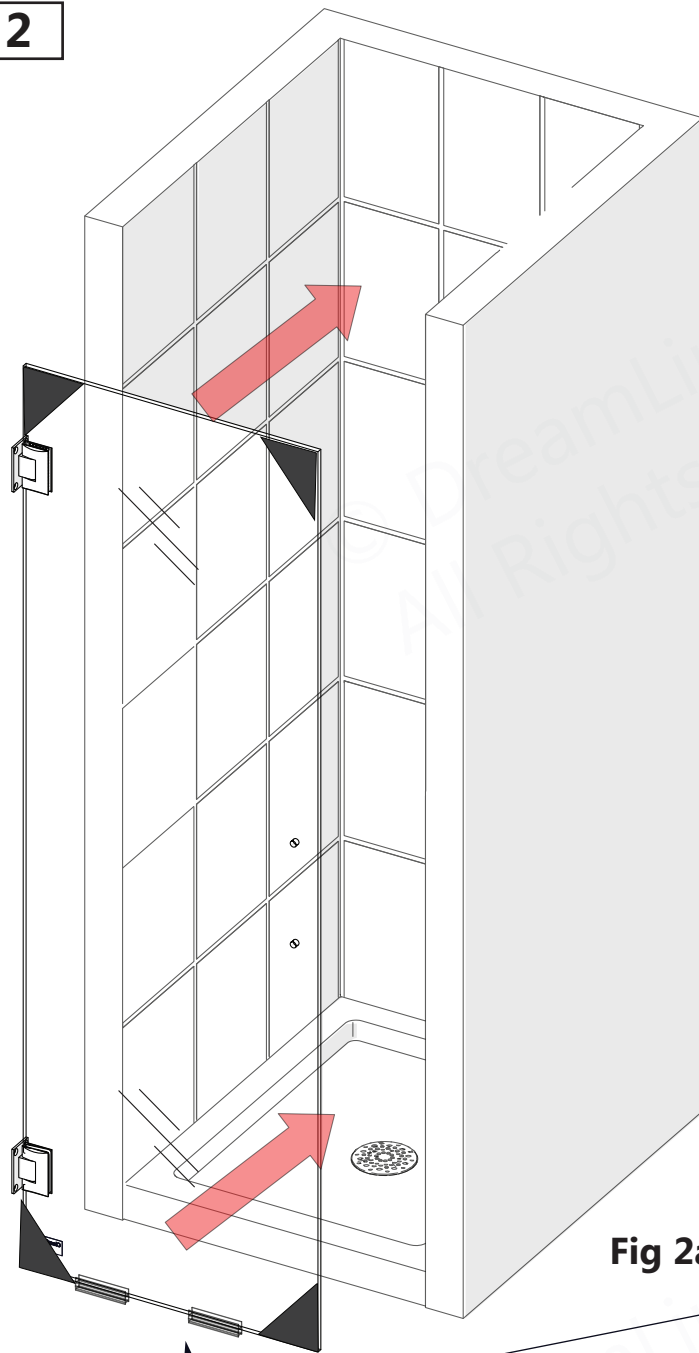

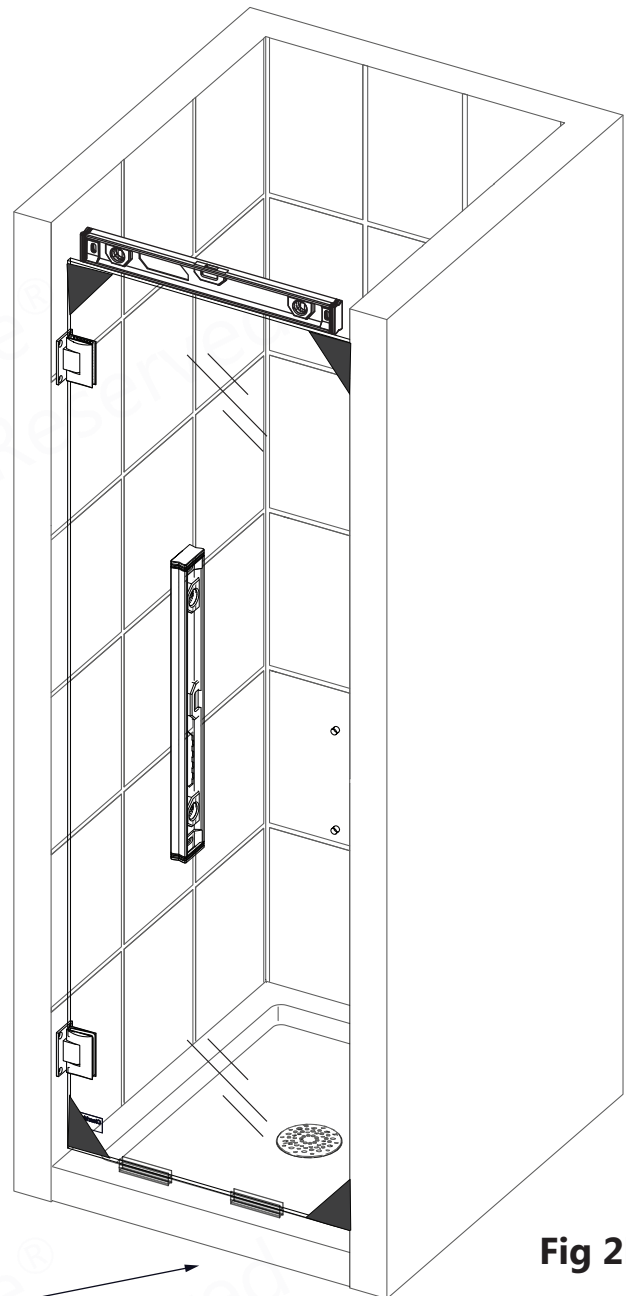
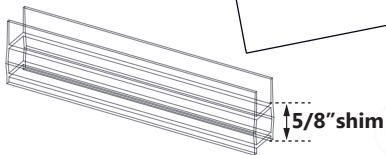

NOTE

Use the provided $\frac{5}{8}$ " (16mm) spacer shims when positioning the **Door Glass (#01)** to maintain the proper spacing between the bottom of the Door Glass and the threshold. Secure the spacers to the glass with tape if necessary. ($\frac{5}{8}$ " (15.9 mm) wood or plastic shims may also be used on the threshold)

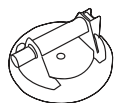


Check the **Door Glass (#01)** with a level to verify it is plumb BEFORE marking the **Hinge Assembly (#05)** positions on the wall.



Use the 72" (1829 mm) **L-Strike Vinyl (#08)** or **180° Inline Strike Vinyl (#19)** as a height reference to be sure that the installed Door Glass height will be 72" (1829 mm). This is especially important when installing the door along with panel glass.

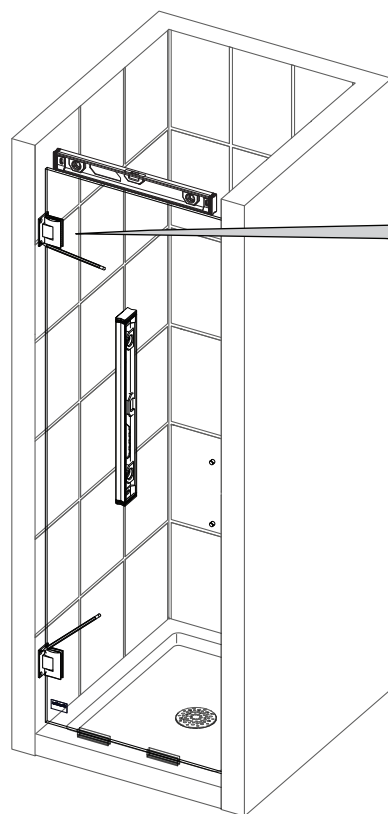
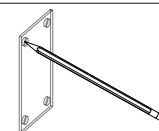
Door Glass Installation **OPTION A:** (Install Door Glass with the hinges attached)

TIP

Use caution while installing the hinge to the wall to avoid scratching the finished surface of the **Hinge Assembly (#05)** face plates. The manufacturer recommends using an extension driver bit to install these long screws. Painter's Tape can also be used on the face plates to protect the hinge finish.

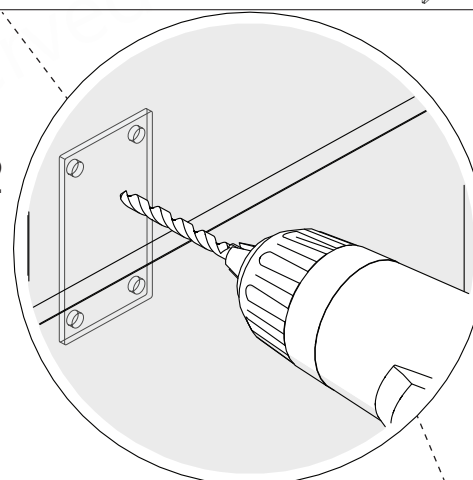

The **PVC Hinge Spacers (#31)** can be used as a template when marking the hinge mounting holes

NOTE

Use a diamond-tipped bit and low torque when drilling into porcelain or other hard tile surface. Follow the drill bit manufacturer's guidelines for proper use.

To prevent stripping the screw heads, use low torque and steady pressure when installing the screws. Make sure to drill Ø1/8" (3mm) pilot holes into the studs.

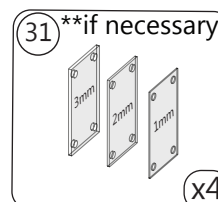
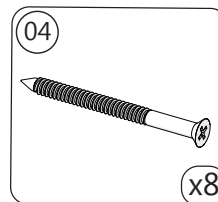
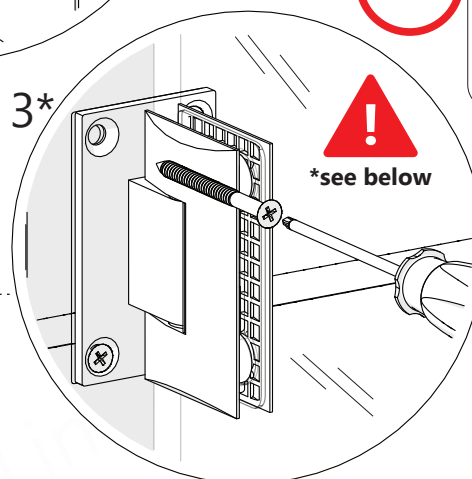

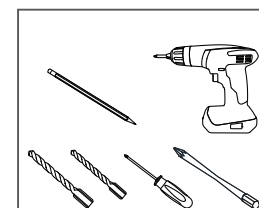
For installation into a **stud** or other **wood reinforcement** behind the finished wall (**Required**):

- drill a Ø1/4" (6mm) hole up to the stud, drill an Ø1/8" (3mm) pilot hole into the stud and use the **ST5.5 x 70mm Countersunk Screws (#04)**.



***If Minor Out-of-Plumb Conditions were found in Step 1a:**

Use the appropriate **PVC Hinge Spacer(s) (#31)** behind the **Hinge Assembly (#05)** before securing them to the wall with the **ST5.5 x 70mm Countersunk Screws (#04)** (see pg 11)

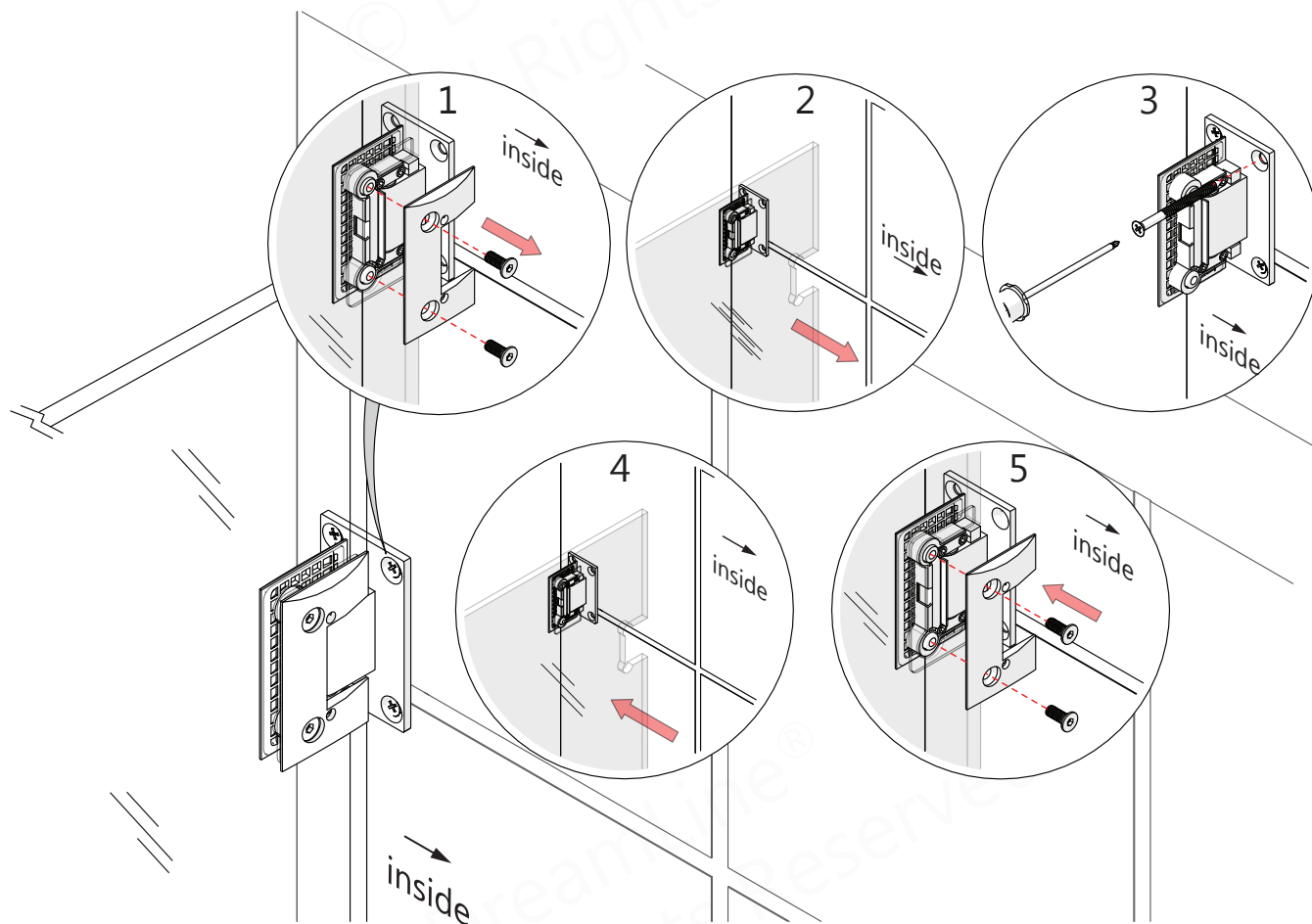


4 Door Glass Installation OPTION B: (Install the Hinges to the wall First):

Mark holes for drilling. Remove the hinges from the door glass. Drill the holes and attach the hinges to the wall. Set the **Door Glass (#01)** onto the 5/8" shims and use an assistant to install the door glass onto the hinges.



Use caution when installing the hinges to the wall to avoid scratching the finished surface of the **Hinge Assembly (#05)** face plates. The manufacturer recommends using an extension driver bit to install these long screws. Painter's Tape can also be used to protect the hinge plates.

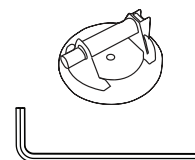

Hinge Side Vinyl Seal Installation

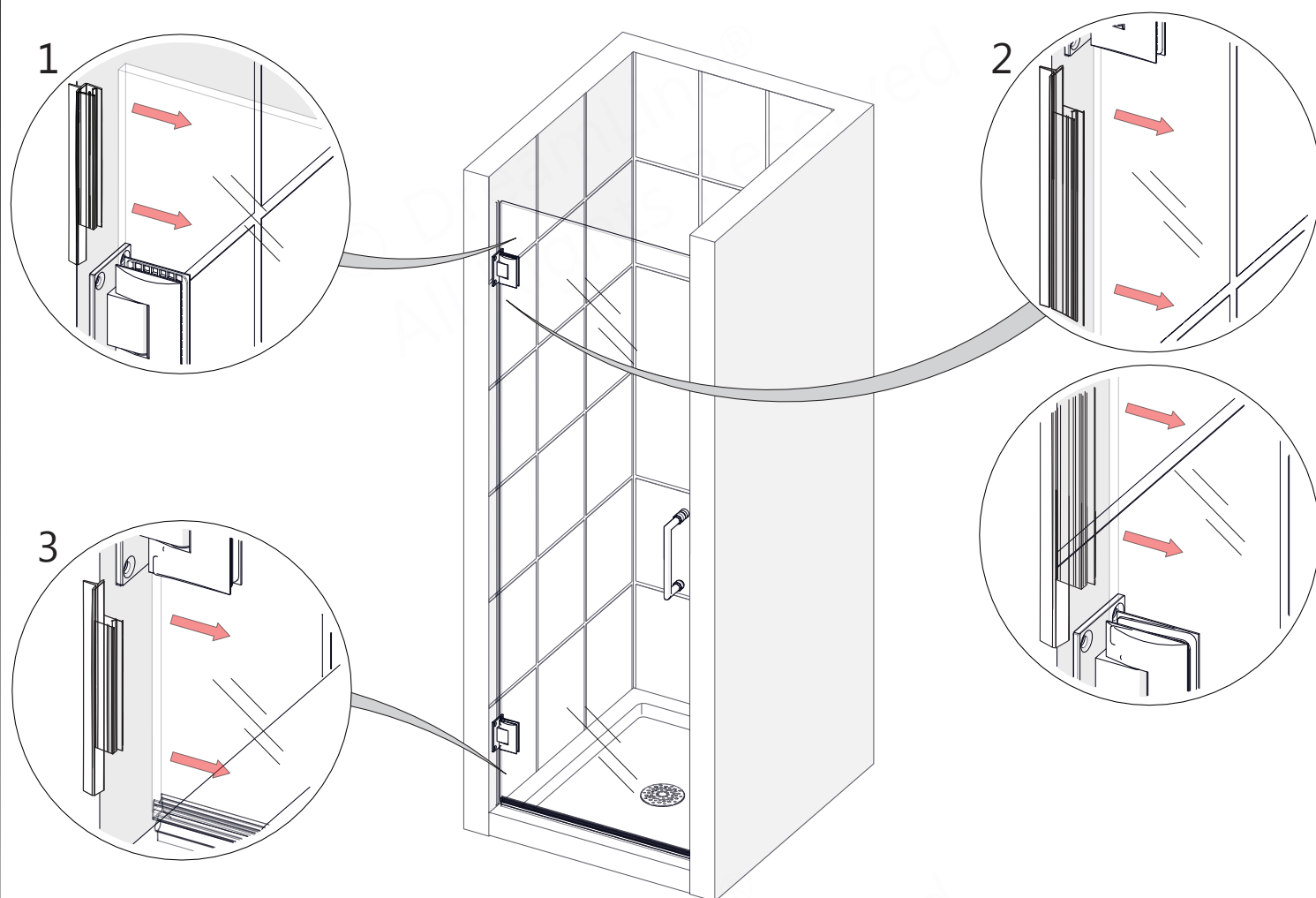

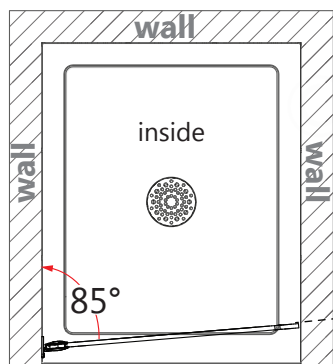
Hinge Assembly Adjustment

NOTE

The hinge assemblies are preset to overclose to 85° for a tight seal against the strike vinyl. The adjustment feature on the hinge assemblies is used to change the closing angle of the door only.

For single door models, make any adjustments to the hinges before installing the L-Strike vinyl w/VHB tape in **Step #8**.

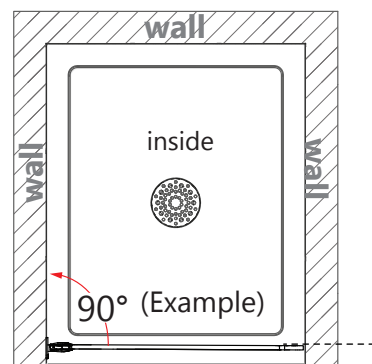
Both the top and bottom Hinge Assemblies must be adjusted at the same time and to the same angle during adjustment.

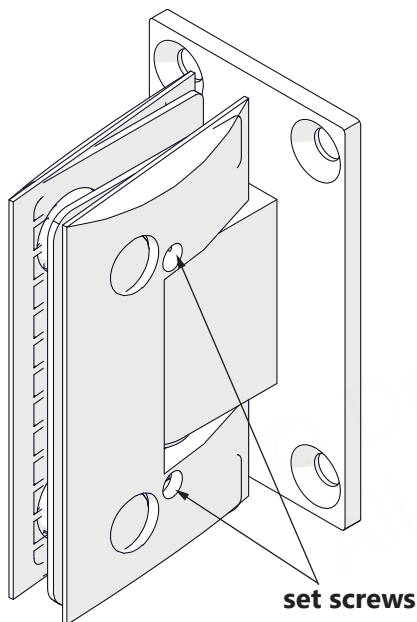
The Adjustable Hinge Assemblies are factory pre-set to overclose to 85° to create a tight seal with the Strike Vinyl. If strike vinyl is not used, the hinges can be adjusted to close to a different angle (90° for example).

How to Adjust the Hinge Assemblies



Once the **Door Glass (#01)** is installed:

- Hold the door in the closed position and loosen the adjustment set screws on **both** hinges with the supplied Allen Key
- Move the door to the new desired closed position
- While holding the door in the new closed position, retighten the set screws on **both** hinges
- The Door Glass will now close to the new closed position

NOTE

Do not adjust the hinges separately or before installation. This could lead to problems with the hinges operating together correctly.



To prevent water leakage, adjust the **Hinge Assemblies (#05)** to overclose so the Door Glass creates a tight seal with the **L-Strike Vinyl Seal (#08)** (for single shower door models) or the **Strike Vinyl Seal** included with the Inline Panel or Return Panel Glass.

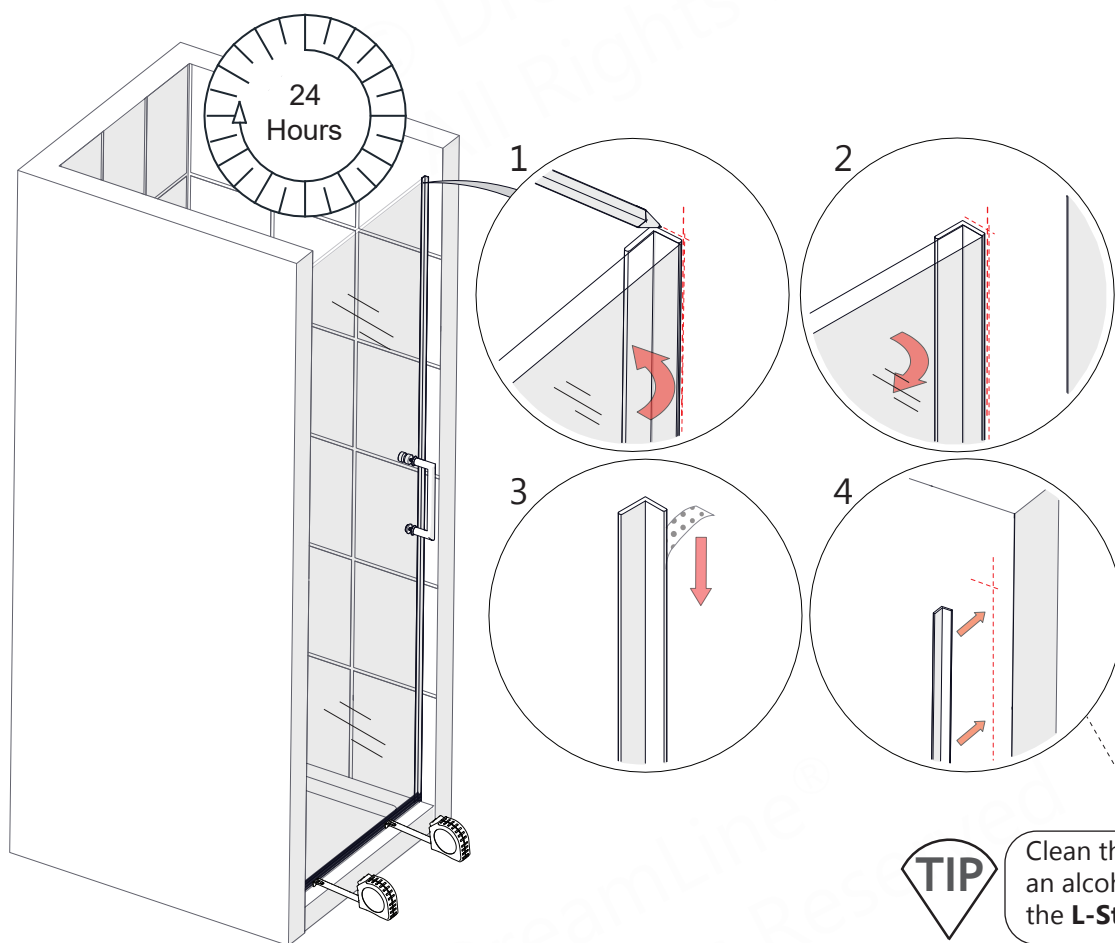

The surfaces need to be clean and free of debris before installing the L-Strike Vinyl Seal (#08)



Before attaching the **L-Strike Vinyl Seal (#08)** to the wall, make sure the **hinges** are set to overclose when in the closed position. Refer to **page 21** for more information on the adjustable **Hinge Assemblies (#05)**.

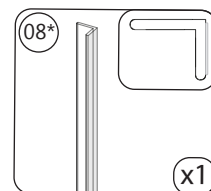


TIP Clean the intended surface area with an alcohol swab prior to attaching the **L-Strike Vinyl (#08)** to the wall.

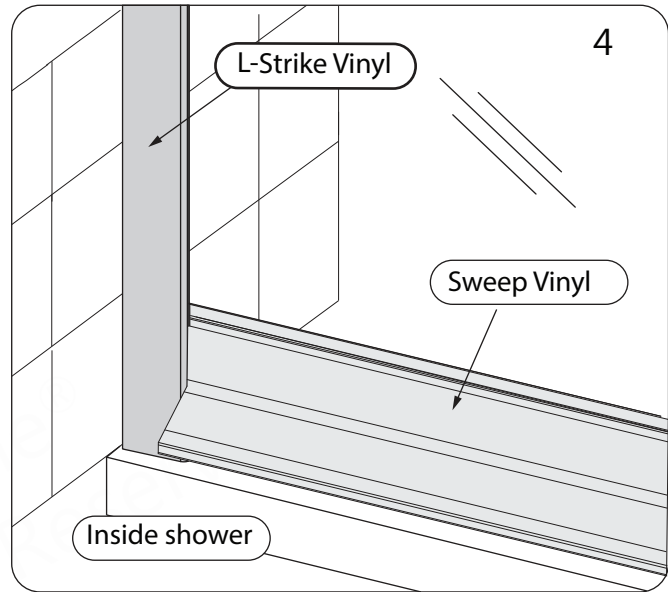
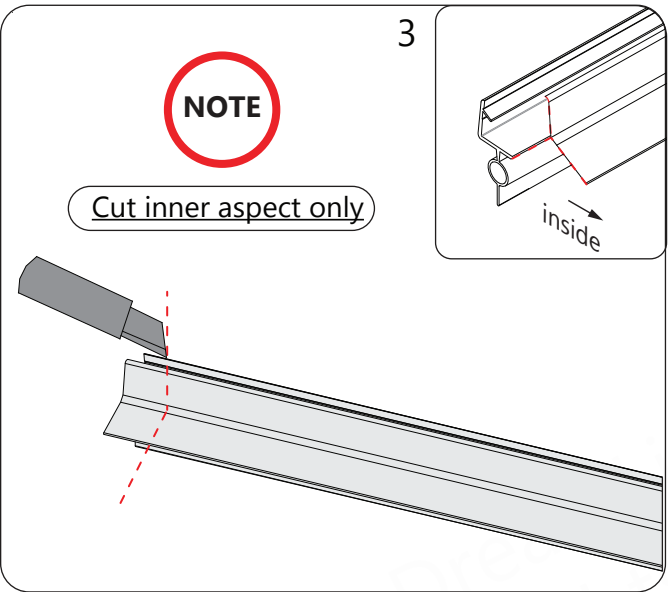
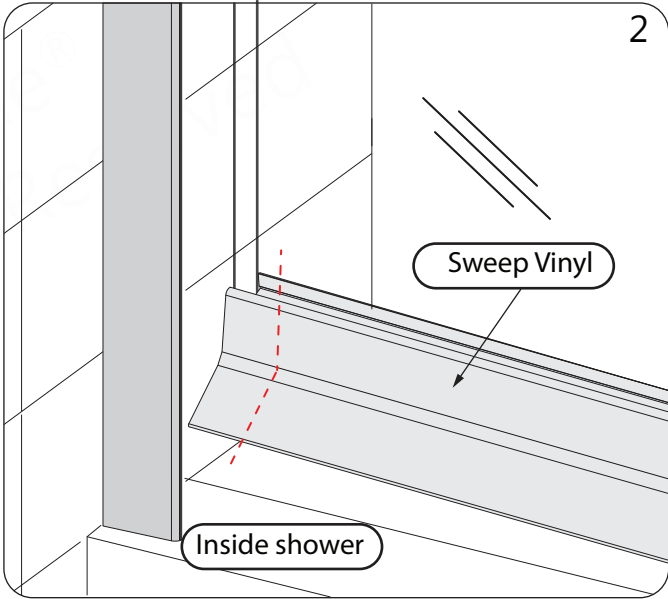
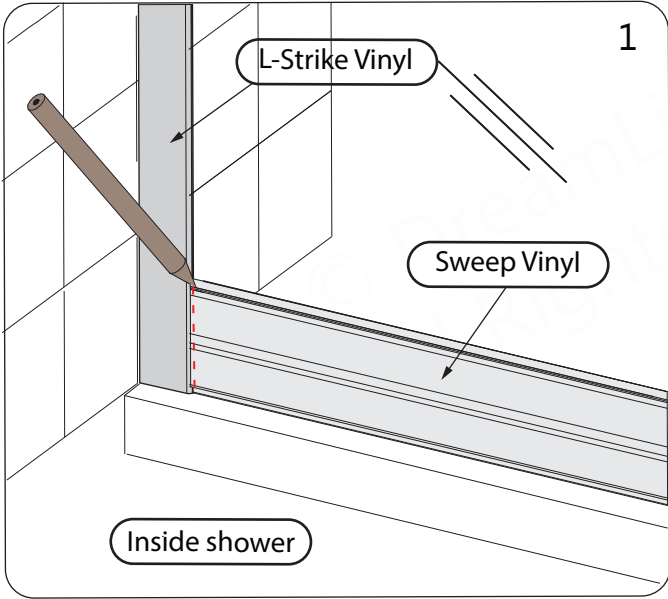
NOTE

Hold the door in the closed position, parallel with the threshold, to mark the location of the **L-Strike Vinyl Seal (#08)**. The adhesive will work best if you **Allow 24 hours for the adhesive to fully set before use!**

TIP Notch the **Bottom Sweep Vinyl (#07)** on the inside where it overlaps the Strike Vinyl.



Product Maintenance

BASES and BACKWALLS: To ensure long lasting life for your acrylic back walls: wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. To clean the acrylic back walls use non-abrasive sprays or cream based cleaners. Avoid the use of aerosol spray cleaners. Never use abrasive cleansers, metal brushes or scrapers that could permanently scratch or dull the surface.

GLASS: To ensure long lasting life for your glass shower products: wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. Rinse and wipe off the glass using either a soft cloth or a squeegee to prevent soap buildup and water spots (Hard water can etch the surface of the glass over time if left to dry). To prevent scratching the surface: never use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products that contain scouring agents. Never use bristle brushes or abrasive sponges that may scratch the surface of the glass.

HARDWARE: To ensure a long lasting finish: wipe off all metal parts after each use with a soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products containing ammonia, bleach or acid. If accidentally used, rinse the surface as soon as possible to prevent damage to the finish (peeling or corrosion). After cleaning the polished finishes, rinse thoroughly and wipe dry with a soft clean-cloth. Clean stainless steel surfaces at least once a week. When applying stainless steel cleaner or polish to stainless steel hardware, work with the grain (not across the grain). Never use an abrasive sponge or cloth, steel wool or wired brush as these may permanently scratch the surfaces.

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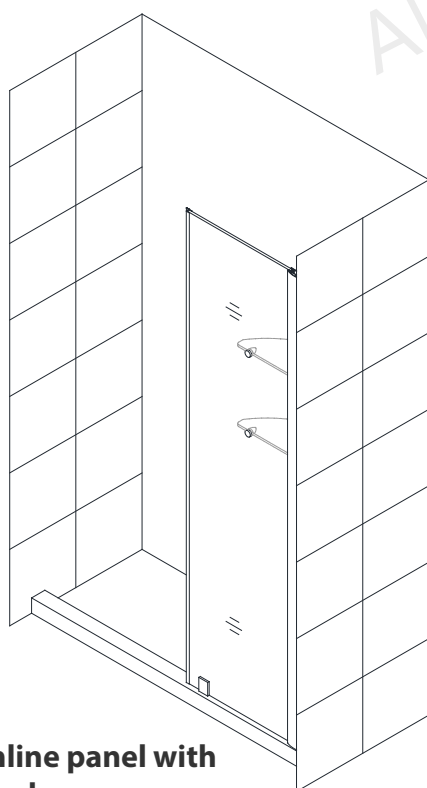

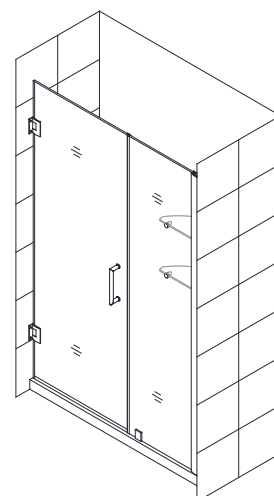

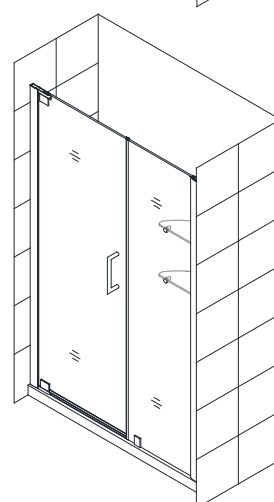

Preparation

1. Prior to installation, examine all boxes and packages for shipping damage and compare the piece count with the packing slip. After opening all boxes and packages read this introduction carefully. Check that all of the necessary parts are included in the package by checking off the components on the "Detailed Diagram of Shower Panel Components". If the unit has been damaged, has a finishing defect, or has missing parts, please contact our customer support department within **3 business days** of the delivery date. **Please note that DreamLine® will not replace any damaged products or missing parts free of charge after 3 business days or if the product has been installed.** Contact DreamLine® if you have any questions, and please provide an order number, job name or other proof of purchase to help identify the original order.

2. **Please note that you should consult your local building codes with questions on installation compliance standards. Building and plumbing codes may vary by location, and DreamLine® is not responsible for code compliance standards for your project and will not accept any returns.**

3. If this unit is going to be installed in a new construction, please install all of the required plumbing and drainage before installing the shower. Use a competent and licensed (if required by local code) plumber for all plumbing installation

4. Make sure that prior to beginning the installation, the surfaces are leveled and solid and will be able to support the total weight of the unit. Also make sure the walls are at right angles. Irregular installation surface level, radius corners or improper angle of side walls will result in serious problems for your installation. Note that some adjustments and drilling will be necessary during the installation process.

5. Protect all primary surfaces of the product during installation. Never set the glass down directly onto a tile floor. Leave corner protectors in place until necessary to remove them. Always use a piece of wood or cardboard to protect the bottom edge and corners of the glass prior to and during installation.

6. **This unit must be installed upon a finished threshold and against finished walls.**

7. **This model requires that you drill into the threshold for proper installation. Contact the manufacturer of the base or threshold material with any questions regarding the drilling of holes into their product.**

8. This model requires a minimum of **1-1/2"** of flat level threshold space for installation.

9. **Professional installation recommended.**



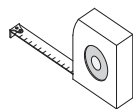
NOTE: DO NOT attach the handle to the door glass or the towel bar to the panel glass until instructed.

DO NOT use the handle or towel bar to lift the glass during installation. This may result in damage to the glass and/or serious injury. Always use an assistant or a professional grade glass suction cup when handling heavy glass.

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Adjustable Wall Profile System



The Glass Profiles can be adjusted within the Wall Profiles for overall width or to correct for out-of-plumb conditions within the model size. Screw them together after making final adjustments.



Installation steps



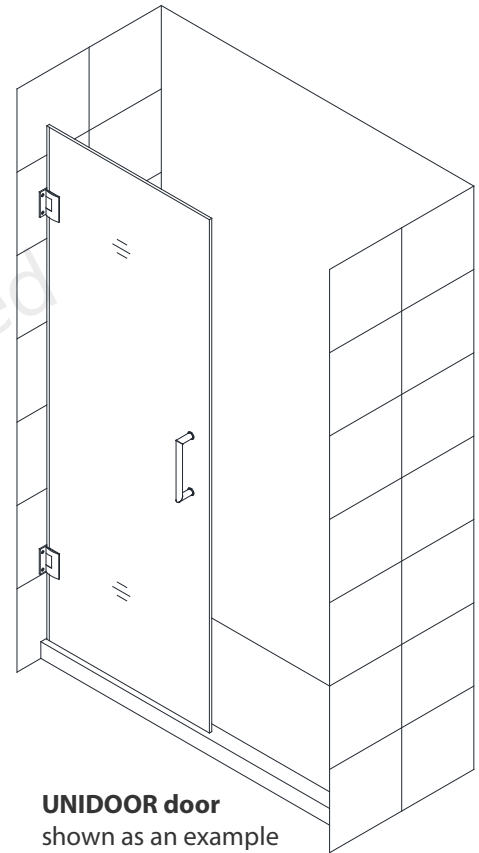
NOTE: The UNIDOOR or ELEGANCE shower door needs to be installed prior to proceeding with the following Inline Panel Glass installation. Please see the Single Shower Door installation manual included in the door packaging for complete shower door installation instructions. Before beginning the installation, recheck the finished opening size. Specific model size information can be found on DreamLine.com.



NOTE: The left-swing Unidoor door installation is shown as an example throughout this manual. Use the same method for aligning the door and panel for the Elegance door and inline panel installation.



NOTE: The Unidoor and Elegance hinges are factory set to overclose 8°. The following procedure is recommended to ensure proper alignment of the panel glass and door glass.



1. Align the **Door** so that it is perpendicular to the wall and parallel with the outside of the threshold. Mark a line on the threshold for reference. Open the door to allow space for the panel installation. (Fig 1)

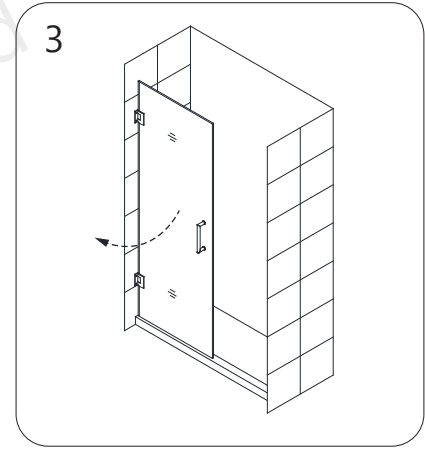
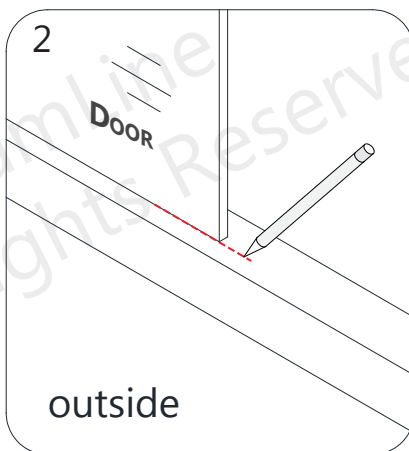
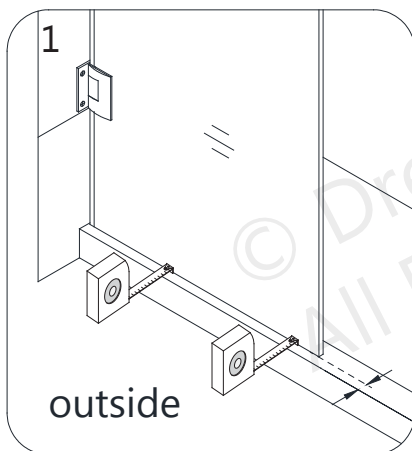

2. Apply clear silicone into the entire length of the channel in the **Glass Profile (#10)** and attach it to the edge of the **Panel Glass (#11)**. Make sure the **Glass Profile (#10)** is flush with the top and bottom of the **Panel Glass (#11)**.

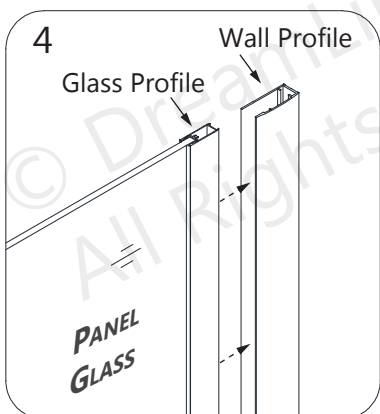
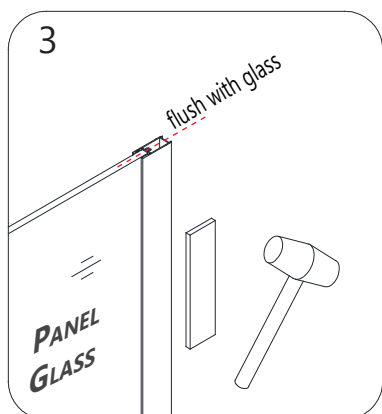
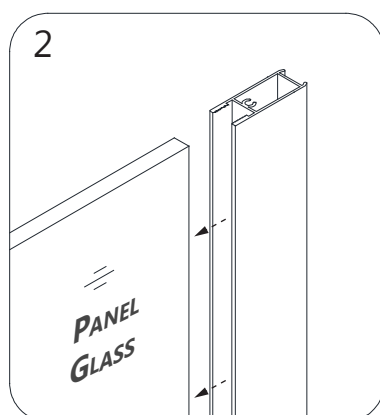
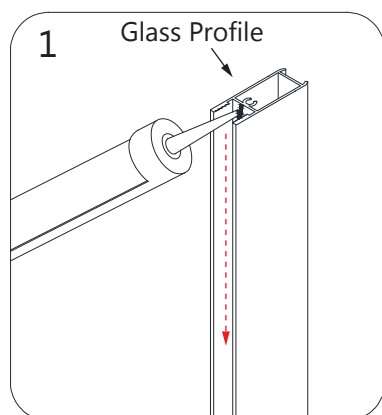
Insert the **Panel Glass (#11)** with the attached **Glass Profile (#10)** into the **Wall Profile (#09)**. (Fig 2)



ATTENTION: Please note that the bottom hole in the corner of the Panel Glass must be opposite from the Glass Profile.



NOTE: If the Glass Profile fit is too tight over the Panel Glass, use a rubber mallet and a piece of wood to gently tap on the glass profile. Never use a metal hammer or hit the profile without a wood bumper.



If necessary, use a rubber mallet to tap on the glass profile

If possible, allow the silicone to cure before handling the assembled panel.

3. Press the **Anti-Water Strip (inline) (#19)** onto the vertical edge of the **Panel Glass (#11)**. (This will protect the edge of the panel glass and allow for proper spacing with the door glass).
Attach the **Bottom Bracket (#18)** through the bottom hole of the **Panel Glass (#11)**. (**Fig 3**)

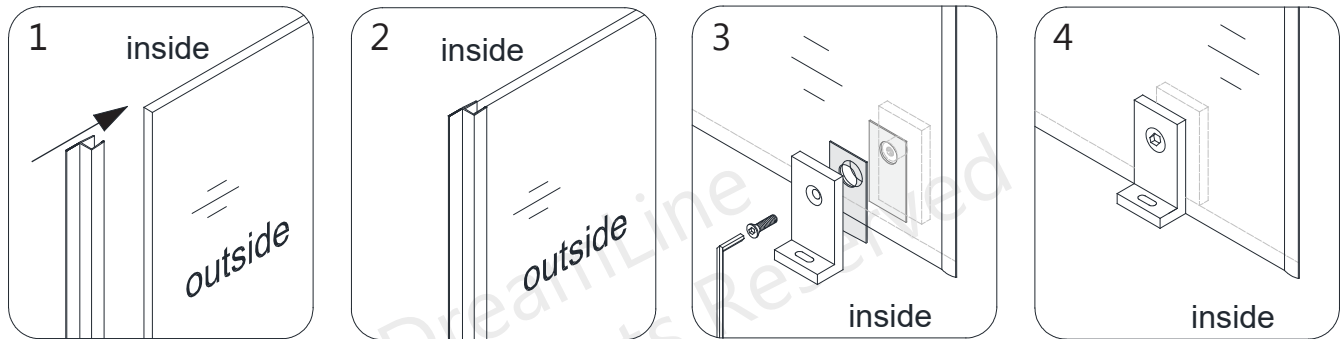

4. Carefully position the **assembled panel** onto the threshold and against the wall. Push the **Wall Profile (#09)** tight to the wall while holding the panel tight to the threshold. (**Fig 4**)



Use Caution not to bang the glass onto the threshold.

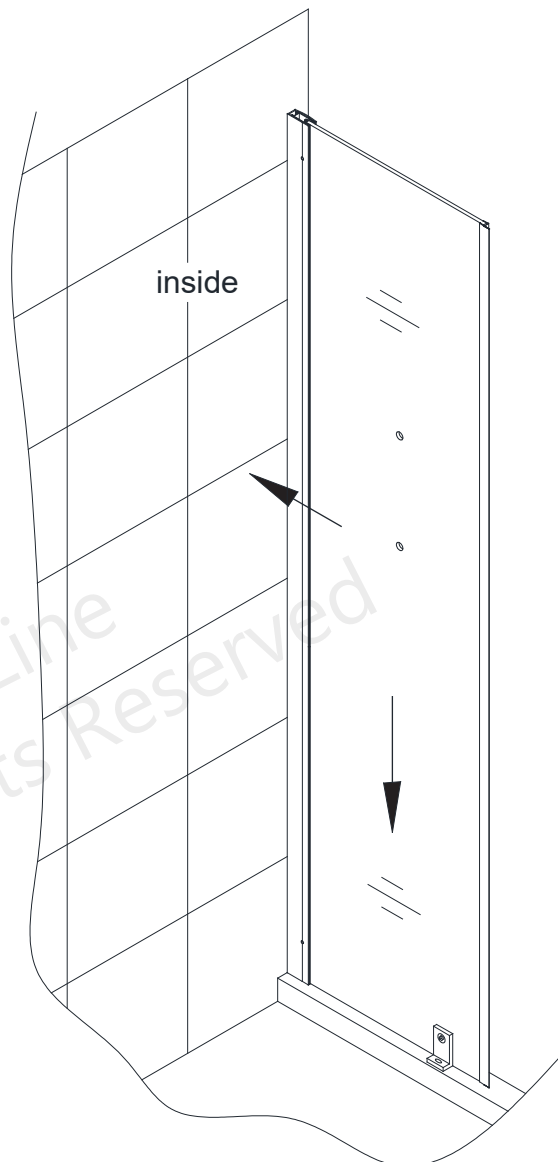

5. Close the **Door** and align the **Panel Glass (#11)** with the **Door Glass**. Use the reference mark on the threshold (from **Step #1**) to confirm that the **Door** is perpendicular to the wall. If needed, adjust the position of the **Panel Glass (#11)** so that the **Anti-Water Strip (inline) (#19)** makes contact with the **Door Glass** from top to bottom and creates a seal.

- Mark the wall along the inner edge of the **Wall Profile (#09)**.

- Mark the drilling hole onto the threshold through the hole in the **Bottom Bracket (#18)**. (**Fig. 5**)



The two-piece wall profile system (consisting of the glass profiles and wall profiles) will allow for overall width and/or out-of-plumb adjustment within the model size. See page 6 for details.

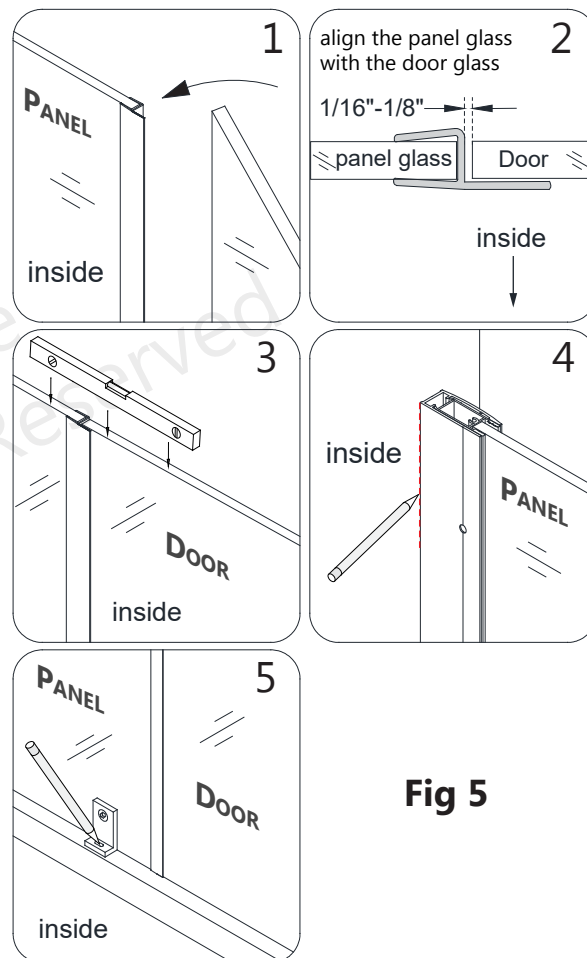

6. Remove the **Wall Profile (#09)** from the **Glass Profile (#10)/Panel Glass (#11)** assembly. Place the **Wall Profile (#09)** back onto the outlined position on the wall and mark the holes for drilling through the predrilled holes in the **Wall Profile (#09)**.

Drill the holes in the wall using a $\text{Ø}5/16''$ drill bit and insert the **Wall Anchors (#13)**.

Apply silicone along the back of the **Wall Profile (#09)** and around the holes on the wall.

Fasten the **Wall Profile (#09)** to the wall with the **Truss Head Screw ST4.2×40 (#15)**. (**Fig 6**)



Use Caution not to pull the Glass Profile (#10) off of the Panel Glass (#11).

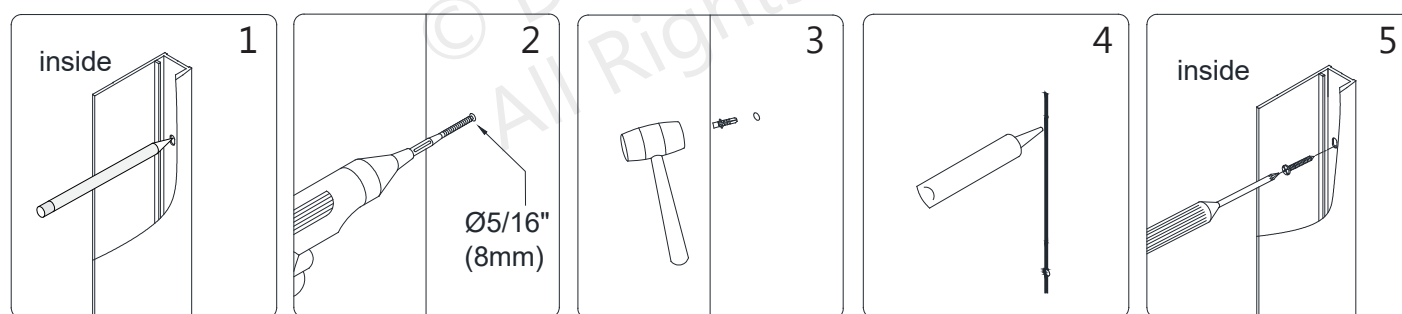

Double check the alignment and spacing of the panel glass with the door glass before drilling into the threshold for the bottom bracket.

7. Drill a hole for the **Bottom Bracket (#18) into the threshold at the mark that was made in **step #5**.**

**** Use an $\text{Ø}1/8''$ drill bit for installation into an acrylic base OR use a $\text{Ø}5/16''$ drill bit and an anchor for installation into a tile threshold. Use the **Pan Head Screw ST4.2x35 (#16)** along with a raised white washer to attach the **Bottom Bracket (#18)** to the threshold and snap on the **Decorative Screw Cover (#17)**. (Fig 7a and Fig 7b)**

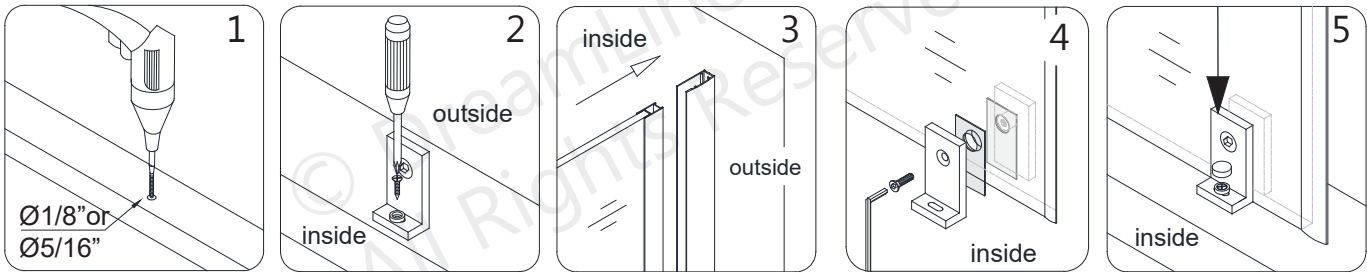
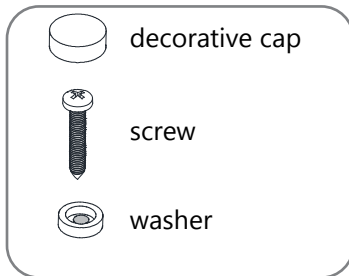

***NOTE:**

▪ For installation into an **Acrylic Threshold**:
drill a $\text{Ø}1/8''$ (3mm) hole and use the **Pan Head Screw ST4.2x35 (#16)**

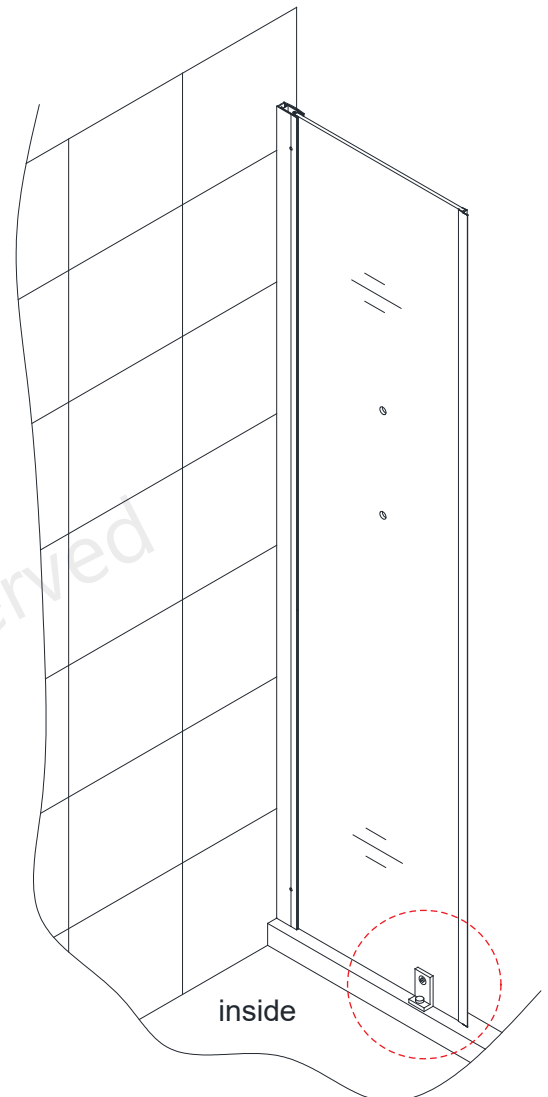

8. Recheck the alignment and spacing of the **Door Glass** and **Panel Glass (#11)** and test the operation of the Door. After final adjustments of the **Panel Glass (#11)** drill holes into the **Glass Profile (#10)** through the predrilled holes in the **Wall Profile (#09)** using an **Ø1/8"** drill bit. Use the **Pan Head Screws ST4.2×10 (#14)** and **Washers (#17)** to attach the **Wall Profile (#09)** to the **Glass Profile (#10)**. Cover the exposed screw heads with **Decorative Screw Cover (#17)**. (Fig 8)



NOTE: Only drill through the first layer of the Glass Profile.

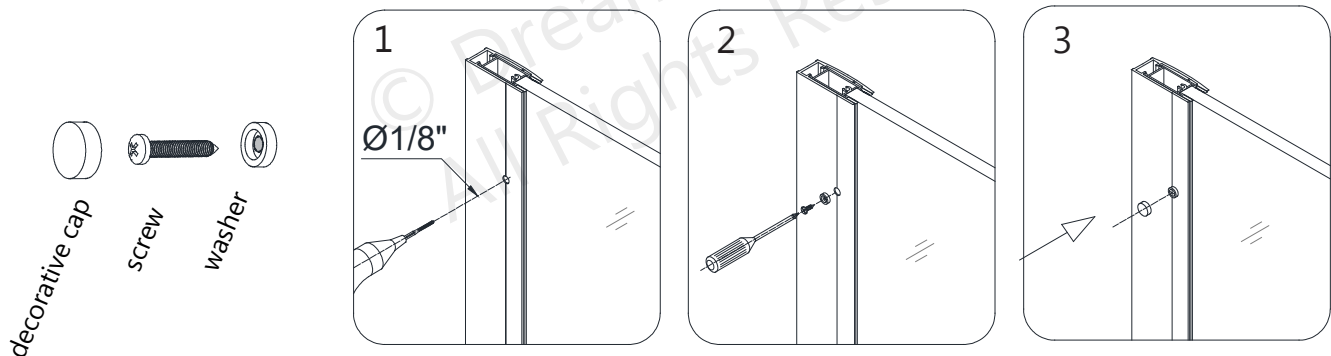

9. Apply a good quality mildew-resistant silicone along the connection of the **Wall Profile** to the wall and the **Panel Glass** to the threshold. (Fig 9)



NOTE: The installation is not complete until the required glass support shelves are installed. Proceed to the next step.

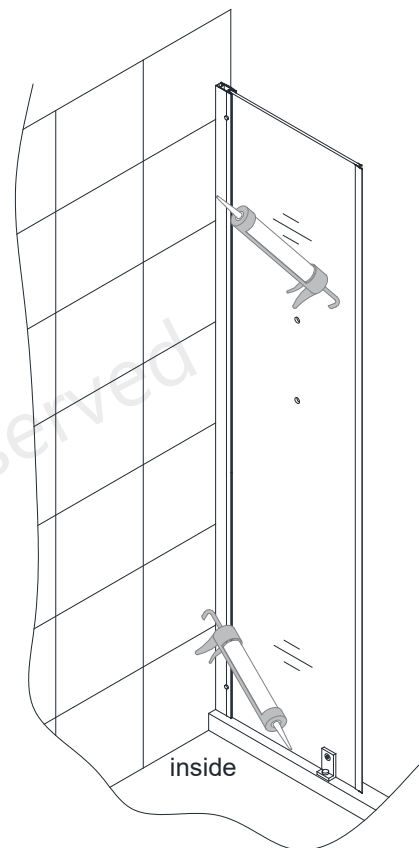
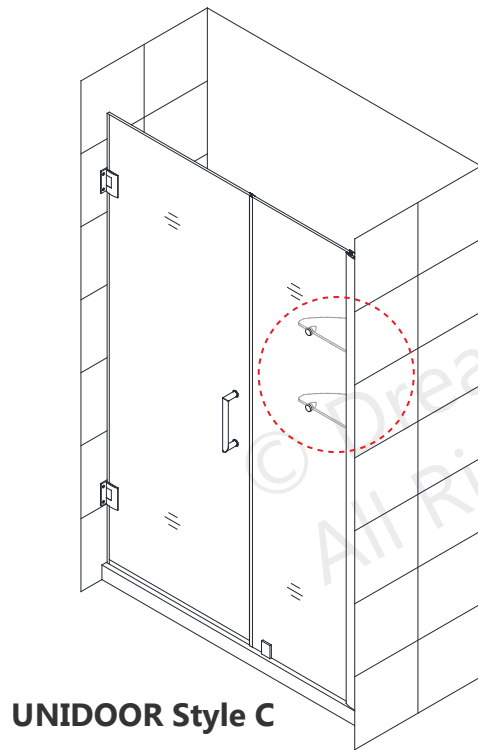
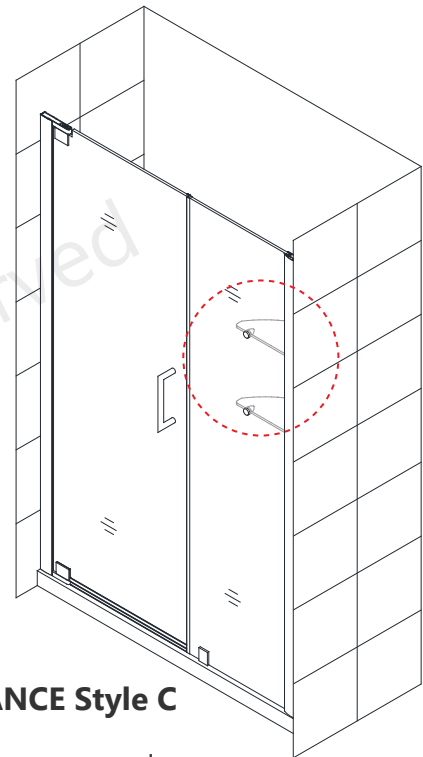

10. Mark the **Glass Shelf (#12)** position on the wall. According to the measurements in **Fig. 10a1**, mark the drilling holes for the **Shelf Brackets (without nut) (#22)**.

Drill the holes using a **Ø5/16"** drill bit and insert the **Wall Anchors (#13)**. Attach the **Shelf Brackets (without nut) (#22)** to the wall using the **Countersunk Screw ST4.2×40 (#23)** and attach the **Shelf Brackets (with nut) (#21)** to the **Panel Glass (#11)**.

Insert the **Glass Shelves (#12)** into the **Shelf Brackets (#21 & #22)** and tighten the set screw at the bottom of each bracket. (**Fig 10a and Fig 10b**)

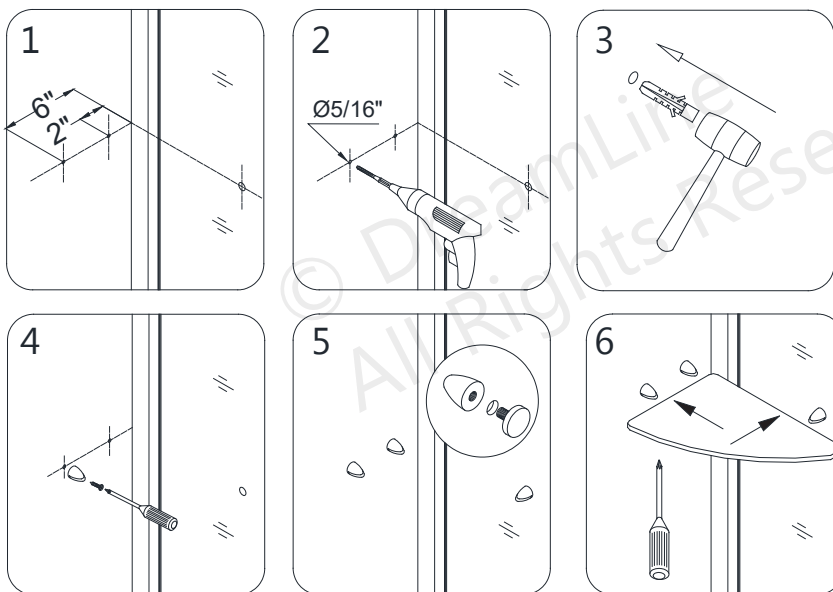

Product Maintenance

BASES and BACKWALLS: To ensure long-lasting life for your acrylic back walls, wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. To clean the acrylic back walls use non-abrasive sprays or cream based cleaners. Avoid the use of aerosol spray cleaners. Never use abrasive cleansers, metal brushes or scrapers that could scratch or dull the surface.

GLASS: To ensure long-lasting life for your glass shower products, wipe them off after each use with a soft cloth. Rinse and wipe off the glass using either a soft cloth or a squeegee to prevent soap buildup and water spots (Hard water can etch the surface of the glass over time if left to dry). To prevent scratching the surface: never use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products that contain scouring agents. Never use bristle brushes or abrasive sponges that may scratch the surface.

HARDWARE: To ensure a long-lasting finish, wipe off the metal parts after each use with a soft cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or cleaning products containing ammonia, bleach or acid. If accidentally used, rinse the surface as soon as possible to prevent damage to the finish (peeling or corrosion). After cleaning the polished finishes, rinse thoroughly and wipe dry with a soft cloth.

Clean stainless steel surfaces at least once a week. When applying stainless steel cleaner or polish to stainless steel hardware, work with (not across) the grain. Never use an abrasive sponge or cloth, steel wool or wired brush as these may permanently scratch the surfaces.

NOTE: To maximize the life of your door, it is important to regularly inspect the glass and all hardware for misalignment, proper attachment, and/or damage. Contact DreamLine® with any questions or concerns.
