


# Assembly Instructions

### Parts List



## Assembly Preparation


Before Beginning Assembly:



- Read instructions, cover to cover-
- Have 2 adults on hand for assembly-
- Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-
- Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-
- Save all packaging until finished-

## Assembly Steps

### Overview




This Ottoman has multiple parts and may require up to 30 minutes to assemble. To give you an overview of the Ottoman parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective. Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

### Step 1



Unpack and place all parts on a clean, non-marring surface.

## Step 2




Position the Ottoman(A) on its back, as shown in above picture.  
Install Wooden Leg(B) to Ottoman(A) by putting a Gasket(①) onto the threaded stem.

Insert the threaded stem of Wooden Leg(B) into the mounting position of Ottoman(A) then tighten by turning the Leg clockwise until the Leg is completely secure.

Repeat this process with the remaining three Wooden Legs.

## Step 3



Position Ottoman right side up and test for stability on a Level Surface.  
If you find the Ottoman is uneven, identify the corresponding Leg and "add or remove" a Gasket to achieve evenness.

**Note: The use of Gaskets are OPTIONAL and are especially useful to help alleviate slight wobbles. Some Legs may need more than one whilst some Legs may not need any.**

Your Ottoman is ready for use.

**This Ottoman can only be used on a flat, level surface.**

## Care & Maintenance



- Furniture may scratch floors. We recommend using furniture pads to protect your floors.



- Do not put hot items directly on furniture surface.



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.



- Do not place furniture under direct sunlight.



- Do not place furniture near heating or cooling vents.



- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.



- Do not place furniture outside . For indoor use only.



- Not for commercial use. For residential use only.



- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.



- Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.



- Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth.
