

Assembly Preparation

Before Beginning Assembly:





Read instructions, cover to cover-

Do not assemble on flooring or carpet-




Assemble on a clean non-marring surface (packing foam)-

Assembly Steps



This table has multiple parts and may require up to some 30 minutes to assemble.

To give you an overview of the table parts, the above picture is to help you put the various parts into perspective.


Please read through the instructions below to familiarise yourself with the parts and steps before assembly.

Step 1




Unpack and place all parts on a clean soft surface.

Step 2



Lay the Table Top(D), Top being floor facing, onto a flat soft clean surface .

Fix the Studs(②) to the Table Top(D) with the Screwdriver(⑤). Then attach the Table Legs(E) to the the Table Top(D) using Washers, Spring Washers, and Nuts(①) with the Spanner(⑥). **DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN, yet.**




Attach the Leg Ring Support Ring(F)to Table Legs(E) using Bolts(4), Washers, Spring Washers, and Nuts (3).

Use one Screwdriver (⑤) to hold the bolt, and with the other Spanner (⑥), turn in the Nut(③).

DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN, yet.

Repeat the same process for all 3 Legs.




Turn the table rightside.

Upon completion of full assembly, tighten and bolt up-all screws. Adjust the Legs pre-installed Levellers until the table is level with the ground.

Your table is now ready for use.

Care & Maintenance



- Do not clean furniture with harsh cleansers or polish.
 - To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor prodcts, minimizing exposure to direct sunlight is recommended.
 - Children should not climb or jump on the furniture.
- Do not write on furniture without a padded barrier to protect the surface.
- To obtain the longest lifespan of your outdoor products, avoid extended and lengthy exposure to rain, snow, and direct sunshine. Whenever possible cover the product and /or place under patio or awnings.
- Not for commercial use. For residential use only .
- Stains may be removed with mild soap solution and damp cloth.
 - Dust and pick-up spills using a clean, non-colored, lint-free cloth
