**STEP 1**

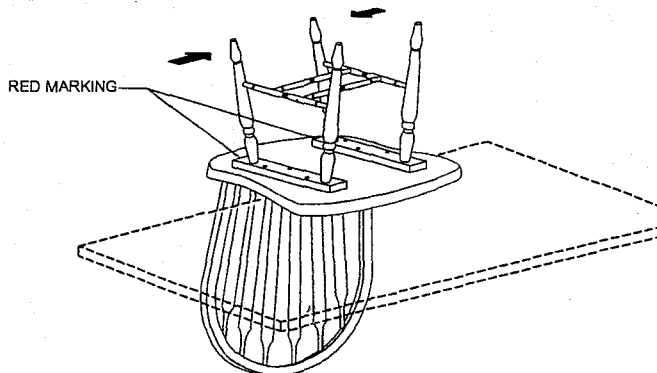
Assemble Front Stretcher (P3) & Back Stretcher (P4) to the Leg Frame (P2). Fix it by using Barrel Nut (H4) and JCBC Screw (H3) as shown. Then tighten it up with Allen Key (H1).  
 \*Do not fully tighten the screw until final step.

**STEP 2**

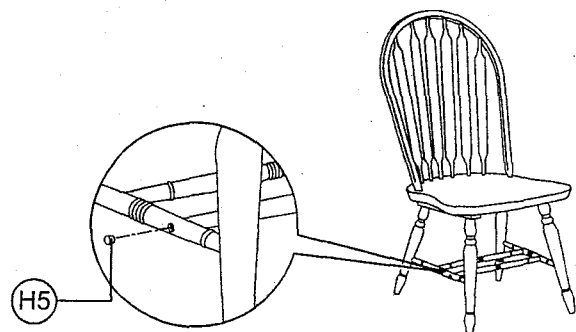
Assemble the Leg Frame to the Chair Seat (P1) with JCBC-W (H2). Then tighten it up with Allen Key (H1). **RED MARKING** on the Leg Frame should facing **BACK**

**STEP 3**

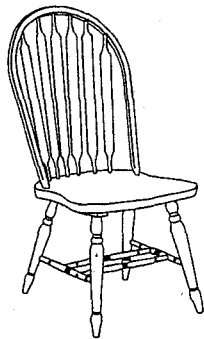
Pull the back legs inwards to ensure full connection between Leg Frame (P2) and Front Stretcher (P3).










Make sure all legs are level. Once level, tighten up all the screws. Cover the screw holes with Wood Button (H5).

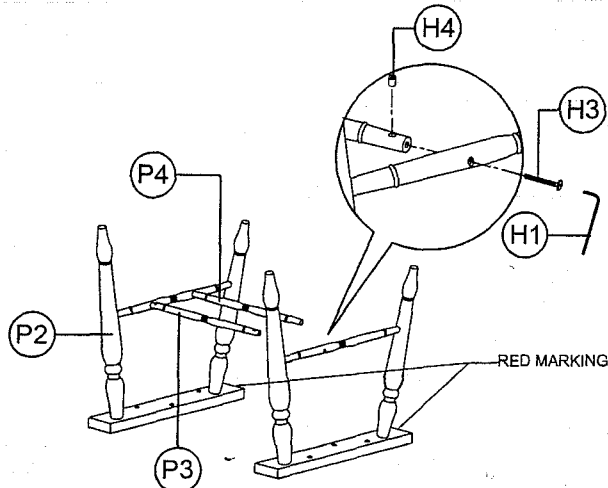

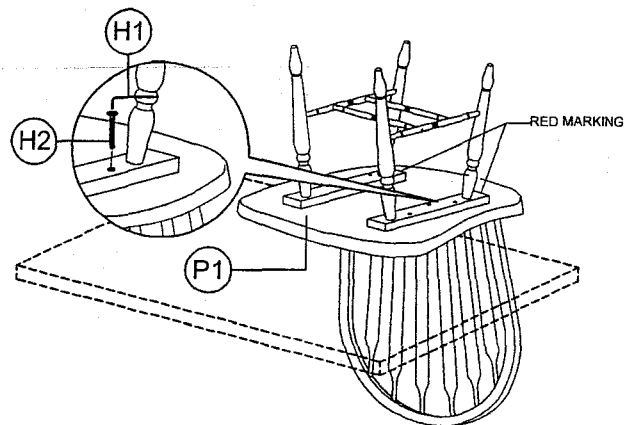
## STEP 1

\*Do not fully tighten the screw until final step.



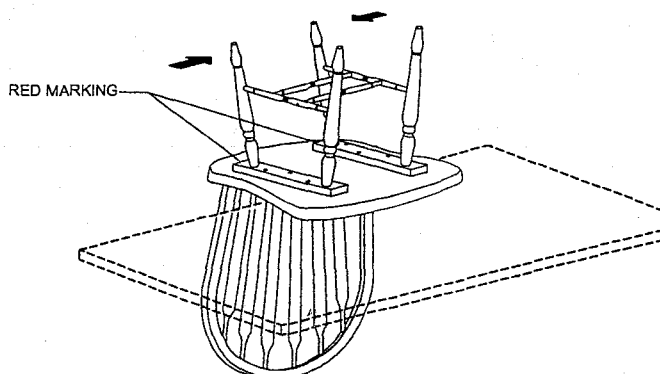
## STEP 2

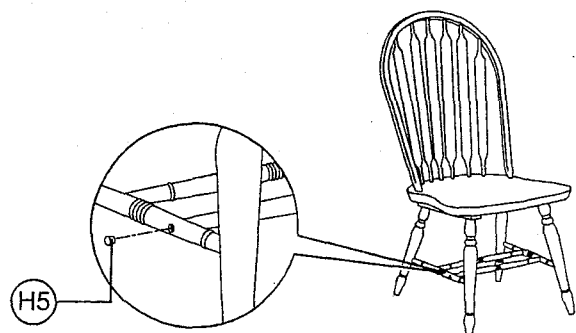
## STEP 3

Pull the back legs inwards to ensure full connection between Leg Frame (P2) and Front Stretcher (P3).

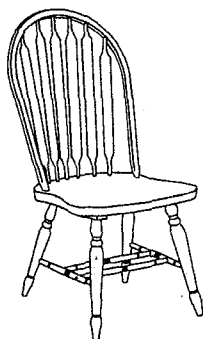

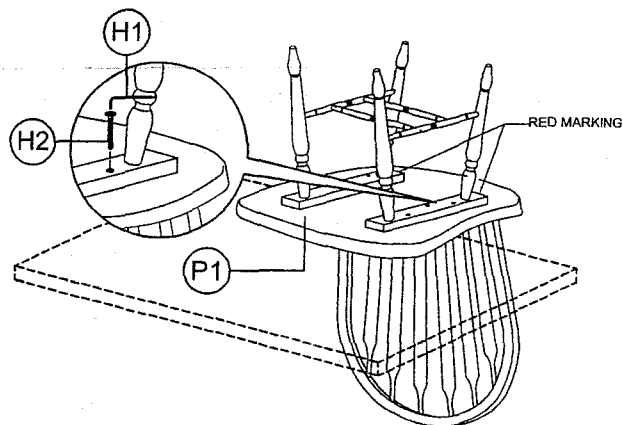
## STEP 1

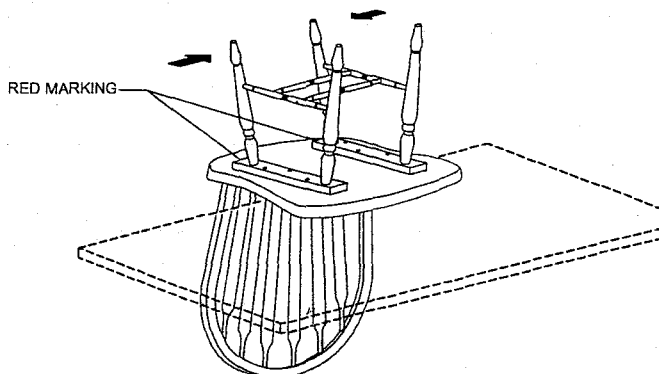
## STEP 2
