- 4. Place the straight "T" foot (part 3) into the previously assembled "C" and bolt together with the supplied hardware,
- 5. Bolt the bowed back leg bracket (part 4) to the previously assembled "C" using the hole in the bottom part of the "C".
- 6. Make sure your frame is upright. Using a socket wrench or similar tool, bolt down the three nuts and bolts securely. Thumb press on the plastic bolt and nut caps.

Hammaka recommends using a rust inhibitor available at your local hardware store to prolong the life of the hardware when leaving it outdoors. Clean with mild soap and warm water, scrubbing when necessary.
