

Instruction Sheet

GENERAL

1. This lamp is controlled by either a pull chain switch, push switch, rotary switch, or a through cord switch.
2. Check the contents of the box. You should receive:
Unassembled fixture - base, shade, threaded pipe and finial.

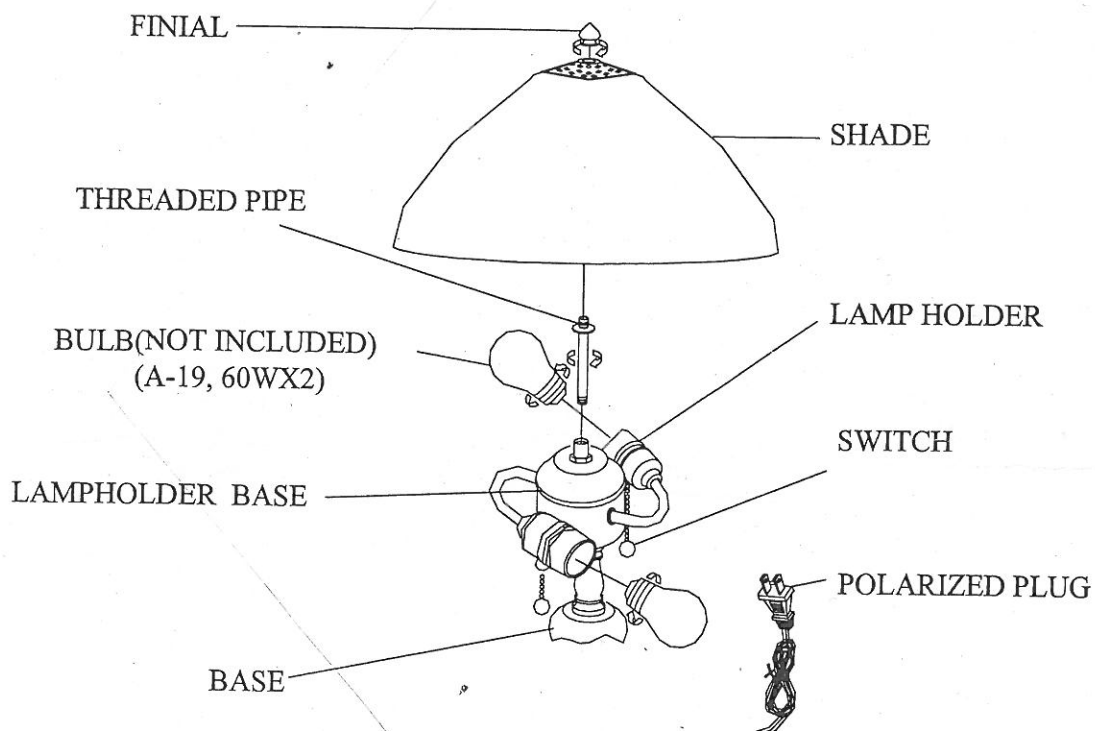
ASSEMBLE THE FIXTURE

1. Carefully layout all parts in a line on a smooth surface.
2. Screw the threaded pipe onto the top of lampholder base.
3. Attach the shade to the threaded pipe then secure with finial.
4. Install bulb (not included).

CAUTION - Refer to the relamping label located near the lampholder for recommended maximum wattage- do not exceed recommended wattage.

WARNING - Do not attempt to replace the bulb while the lamp is plugged into a wall receptacle.

5. Insert plug into wall receptacle.

2. This stained glass product has been protected with mineral oil as part of the finishing process. Please use a soft dry cloth to remove any excess oil.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

This portable lamp has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other) as a safety feature to reduce the risk of electric shock. This plug will fit in a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully in the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Never use with an extension cord unless plug can be fully inserted. Do not alter the plug.
