How to remove a misplaced assembly bolt (H-36).

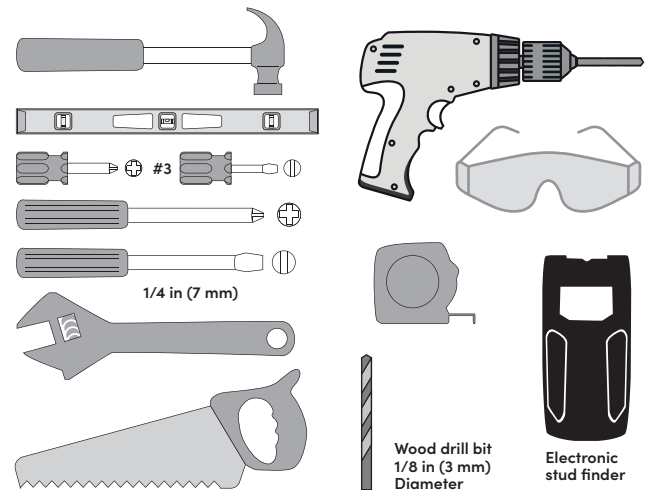


Main hardware system. Assembly steps.



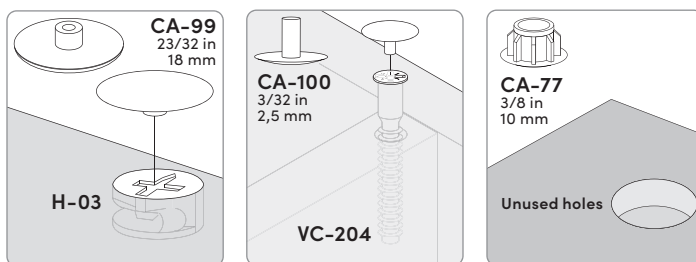

Put the **CONCRETE SCREWS 3/16 in (5 mm) diameter X APPROPRIATE LENGTH** into the holes of part #87 and screw the bed onto the masonry wall until tight against the wall. Screw must be at least 1 1/4 in (32 mm) deep into masonry.

2. Position the bearing support in such a way as to lock. (Image 1)
3. Firmly tighten the bearing support screws.

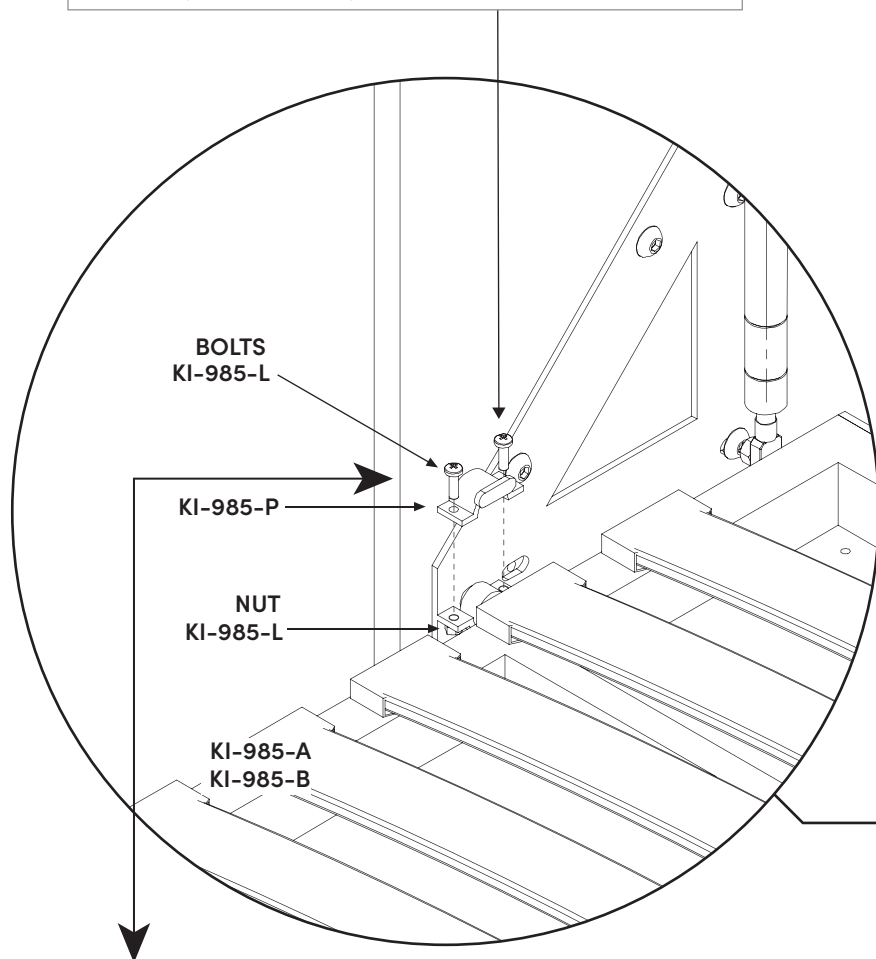
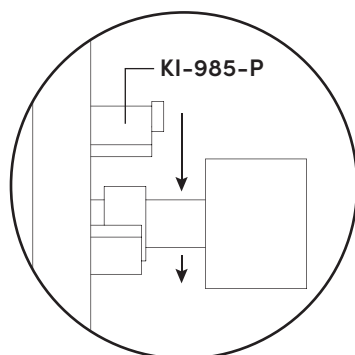
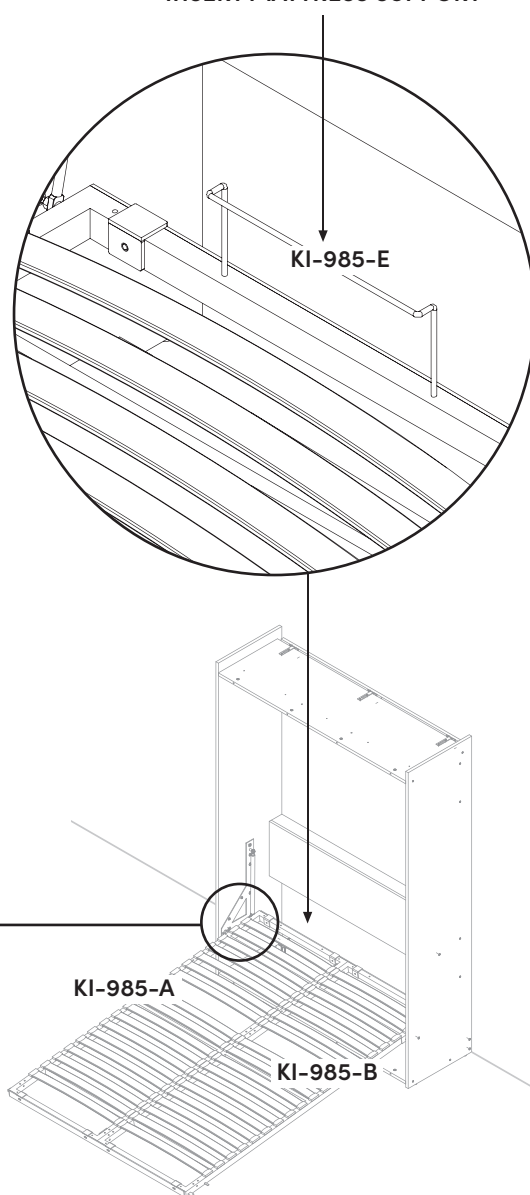

- After you have finished assembling your wall bed, close it. If the gap around the bed is uneven, push or gently kick the base of the CABINET on the side with the NARROWEST gap until desired gap is obtained.
- After you have finished assembling your wall bed, please keep the assembly book by placing it under the mattress, in the frame of the mobile part of the bed.

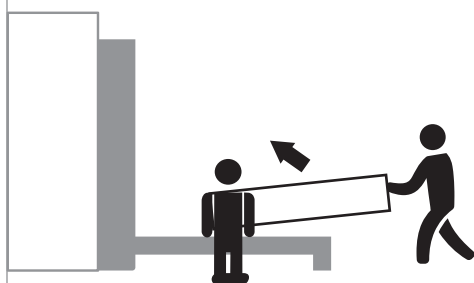

Skills and tools include electronic stud finder, drill motor and bits, screwdriver, and ability to correctly use these tools.
