

Wooden Table & Chairs Set INSTRUCTION MANUAL



⚠ WARNING:

Contains small parts and sharp points - ASSEMBLY MUST BE CONDUCTED BY AN ADULT ONLY. Prior to and during assembly of this product, keep unassembled screws, small parts and plastic bags out of children's reach. Small parts pose a choke hazard to children under 3 years.

- Phillips/cross-head screwdriver required (not included) for installation.
- · Adult supervision advised when item is in use.
- Maximum weight limit on each chair: 23 kg (50 lbs). Limit one (1) child per chair.
- DO NOT use the table and chairs in any manner other than intended. Sitting and/or climbing on the table, and/or standing on the chair may cause a potential fall or tip in result of serious or fatal injury.





TO ASSEMBLE CHAIR



Place the chair seat (H) on a flat ground surface with the bottom facing **UP**. Align the chair supports (I & J), and the chair front (G) to the respective holes. Make sure the chair support end with 1 hole is matching the hole at the chair front. Join the panels by fasten (x3) 1-15/16" round-head screws (S4) and tighten with a Phillips / cross-head screwdriver.





Attach the chair assembles from step 1 to the chair back (F). Match the holes on the chair front and the chair back, then fasten (x2) 1-1/2" Truss-head screws (S2) through holes at the chair front; and (x4) same screws from the chair back. Fully tighten to secure. Now, insert (x2) M6 nuts to the slot of each chair foot (K) as shown in the inset. Tighten the chair foot with (x2) 1" bolts (S5) to lock the M6 nuts through holes to the chair back. Repeat this for the other chair.

TO ASSEMBLE TABLE


Assembly Tips for Step 3 - 5

Make sure the Phillips screw head ("crosshead") of the plastic screw nut at the table leg is facing **OUT**, and the **LONGEST** side of the "cross" is pointing to the open end and through hole. It helps much easier to complete Step 7 to lock the S2 screws.







Align the table legs (B) and crossbeam (C) on the floor as shown. Ensure the notch is facing **DOWN**, and one leg on the top and one underneath as shown in diagram. Affix (x4) 11/16" bolts (S1) and (x4) 15/32" nuts (N1) to secure both legs with a cross-head screwdriver (do not over tighten).




Lock the notches on the table legs together and make sure edges are flushed.




leg assembly should be facing **UP**, and the leg position is opposite to Step 3 (do not over tighten).




Attach the shelf (D) to the leg assembly as shown. Some adjustments to the table legs (B) may be necessary to fit the shelf correctly. Insert (x2) 1-3/16" round-head screws (S3) through each side of the table legs (B). Tighten screws. Repeat the same for the other shelf.




Align the holes of the table top (A) to the corresponding holes of the table legs (B). Make sure the finger access on the table top and the shelf (D) are facing to the same direction. Fasten with (x4) 1-1/2" Truss-head screws (S2) to secure the table top in its position.



Unfold and place the fabric storages (M) on the shelves and tie securely in place.



Place (x4) fabric pockets (L) and the reversible drawing board (E) on the table top.



Picture shows the final assembled product.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- · Before use, please check that all parts are assembled securely. Failure to do so could result in serious or fatal injury.
- This table was made for INDOOR use. DO NOT attempt to use or expose the unit outdoors. The chalkboard surface is weather sensitive, any wetness or excessive dampness will ruin the board.
- Treat the boards' surfaces with care. DO NOT use sharp pointed objects on the writing surface. Scratching the surface will cause permanent
- Chalkboard must be treated prior to use. To season: hold Crayola[®] Anti-Dust[®] or school chalk on the flat side (not the point side) and using board flat strokes, coat the board both horizontally then vertically making sure to cover the entire board surface. Wipe off the chalk with a slightly damp sponge (or paper towel). Let it dry overnight.
- Crayola® Anti-Dust® or school chalk (Calcium Carbonate Based) is recommended for use on the chalkboard surface. DO NOT use Crayola Sidewalk Chalk or other "street chalk" as it contains abrasives that will damage the board.
- · Washable markers are not compatible with the dry erase surface. For best results, use only Crayola® Low Odor, Non Toxic Dry-Erase Markers.
- If there is some hard-to-erase ink left on the boards surface, use a slightly damp sponge (or paper towel) and wipe the board clean. Any excessive water may damage the board.
- · DO NOT locate this product in close proximity to an open fire, radiator or heater.
