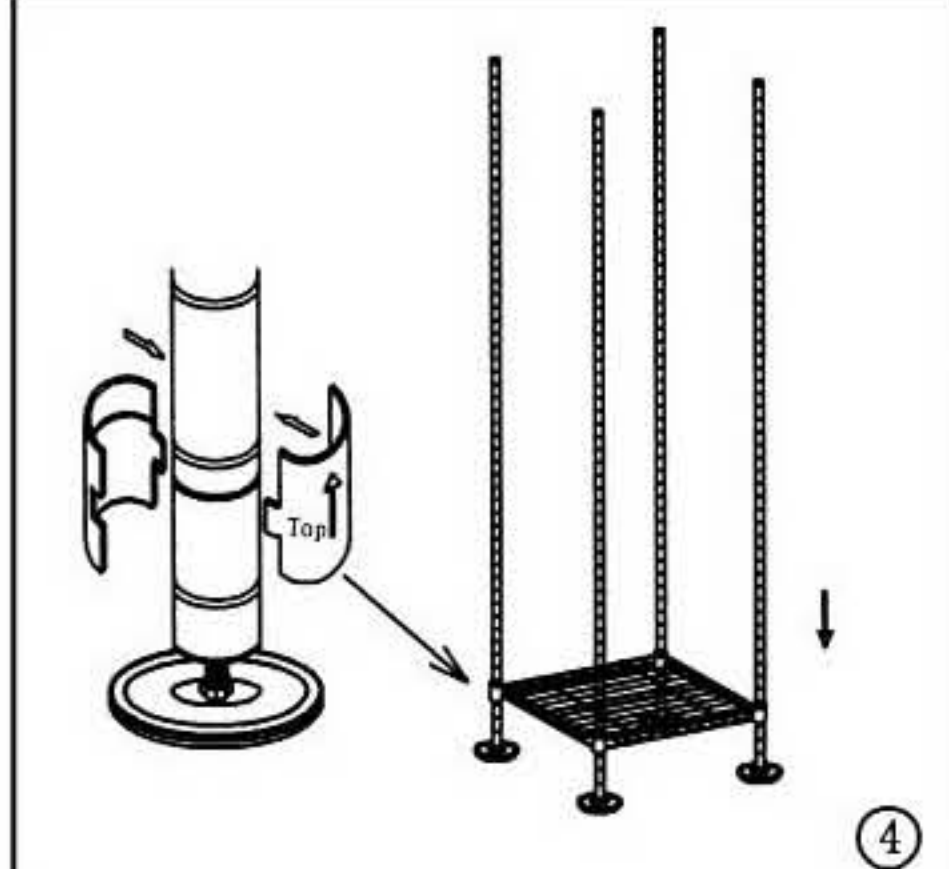
Fasten Slip Sleeves (B) around the bottom double groove of each pole. If necessary, move the sleeves slightly up or down until it snaps into position.

Helpful Hint: The shelves can be fully adjusted at 1" increments. For your convenience, the suggested shelf height and bracket location are indicated with double grooves on the poles.



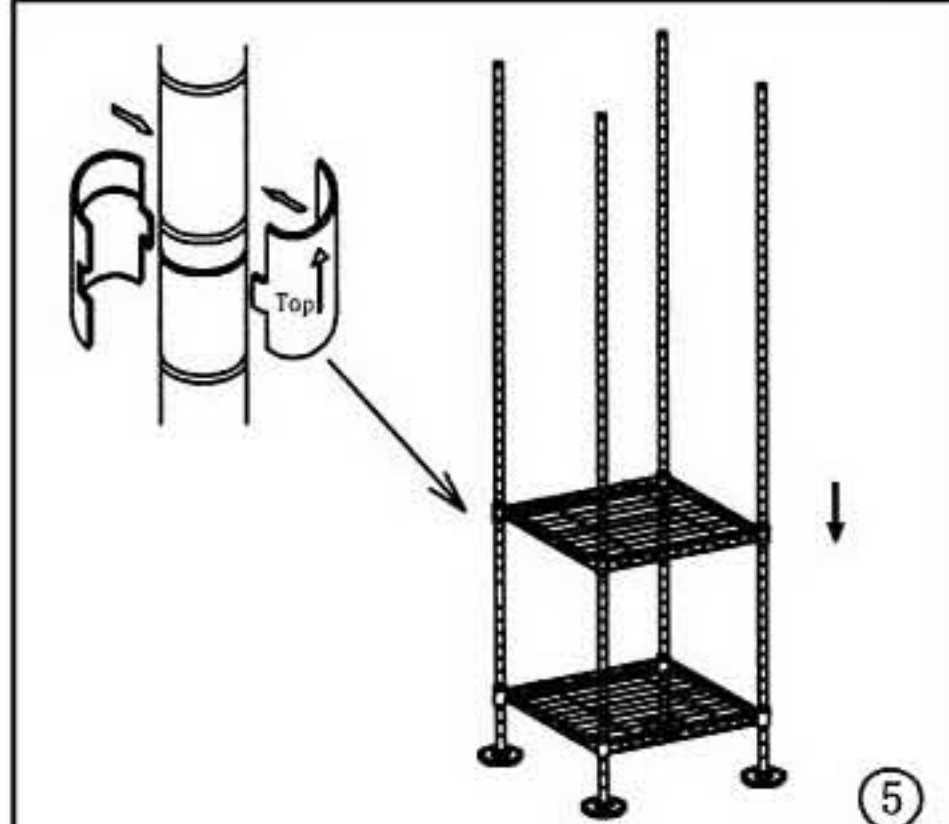
Step 4

Slide Shelf (D) over the top of the poles and secure tightly over the slip sleeves.



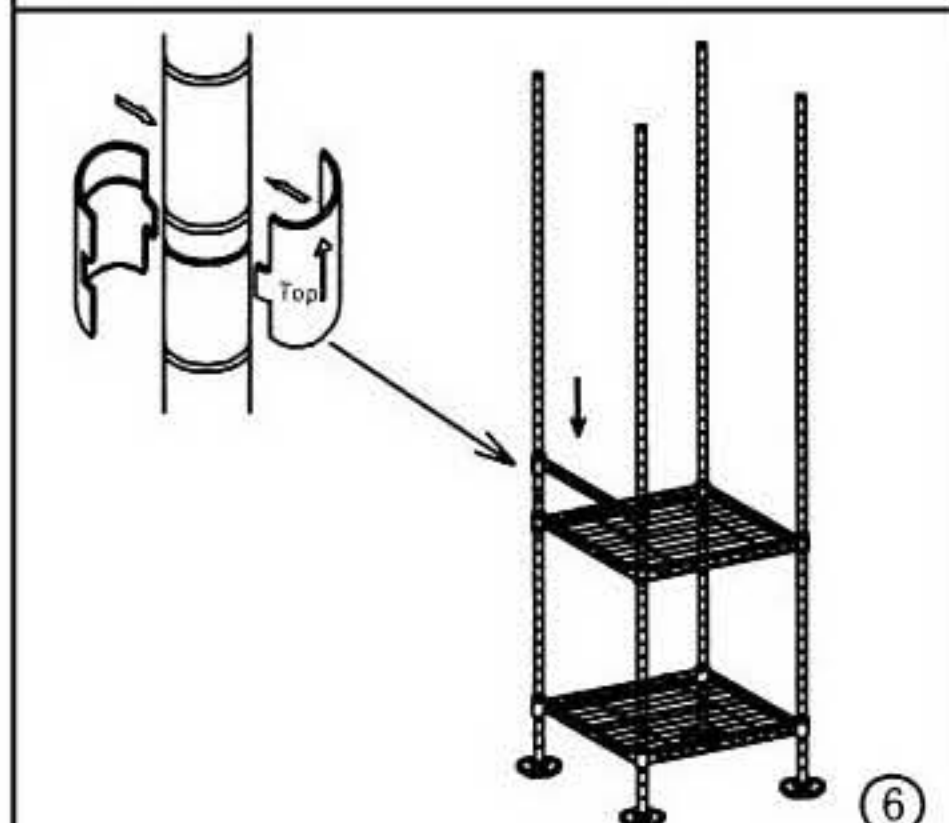
Step 5

Fasten Slip Sleeves (B) at the 2nd set of double grooves on each pole. Slide the Shelf over the poles and secure tightly.



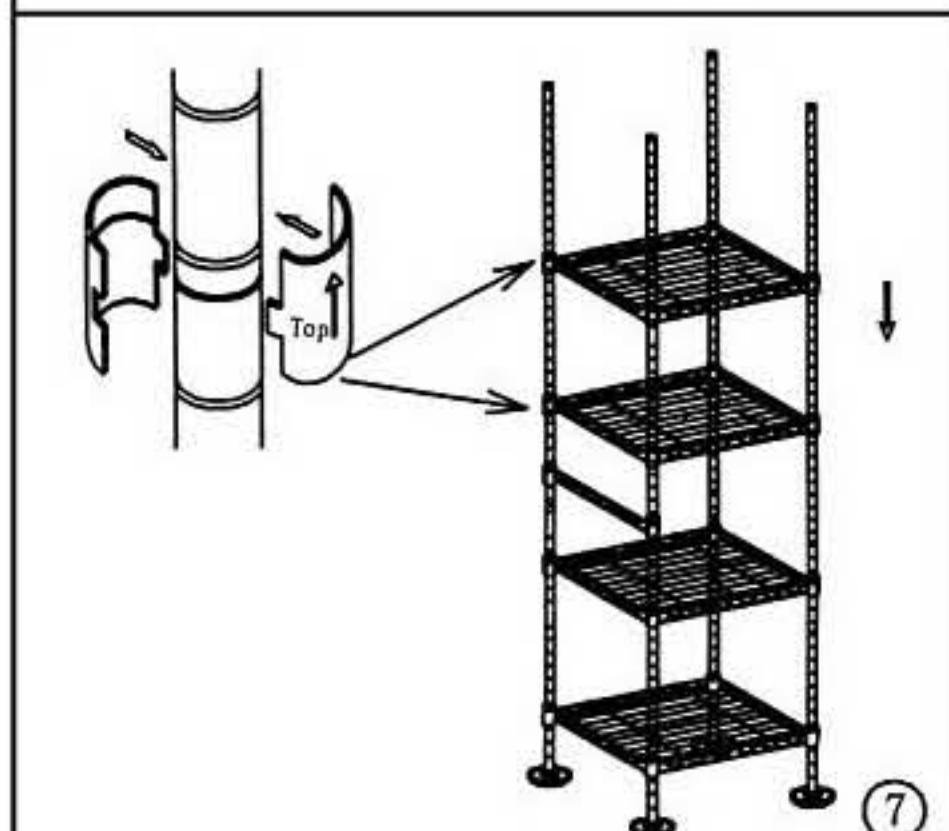

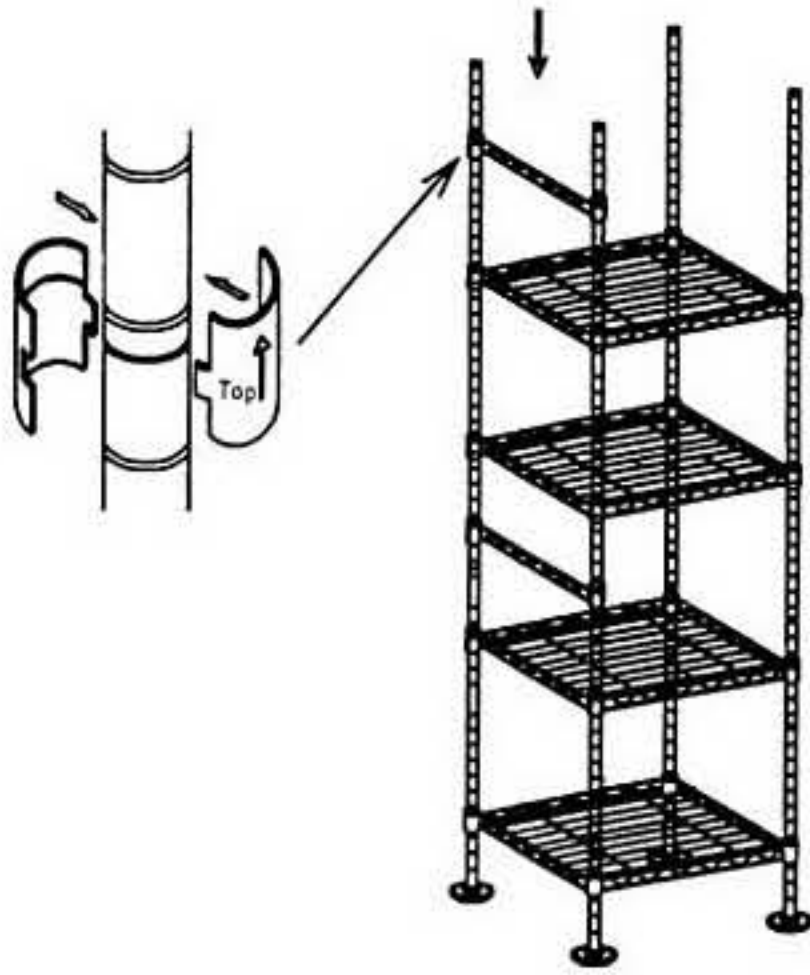
Fasten Slip Sleeves (B) at the 3rd set of double grooves on the inner poles. Slide the Hanging Rod Bracket (E) over the poles and secure tightly.

Fasten Slip Sleeves (B) at the 4th set of double grooves of each pole. Slide Shelf over the poles and secure tightly. Repeat step for the next set (5th) of double grooves.

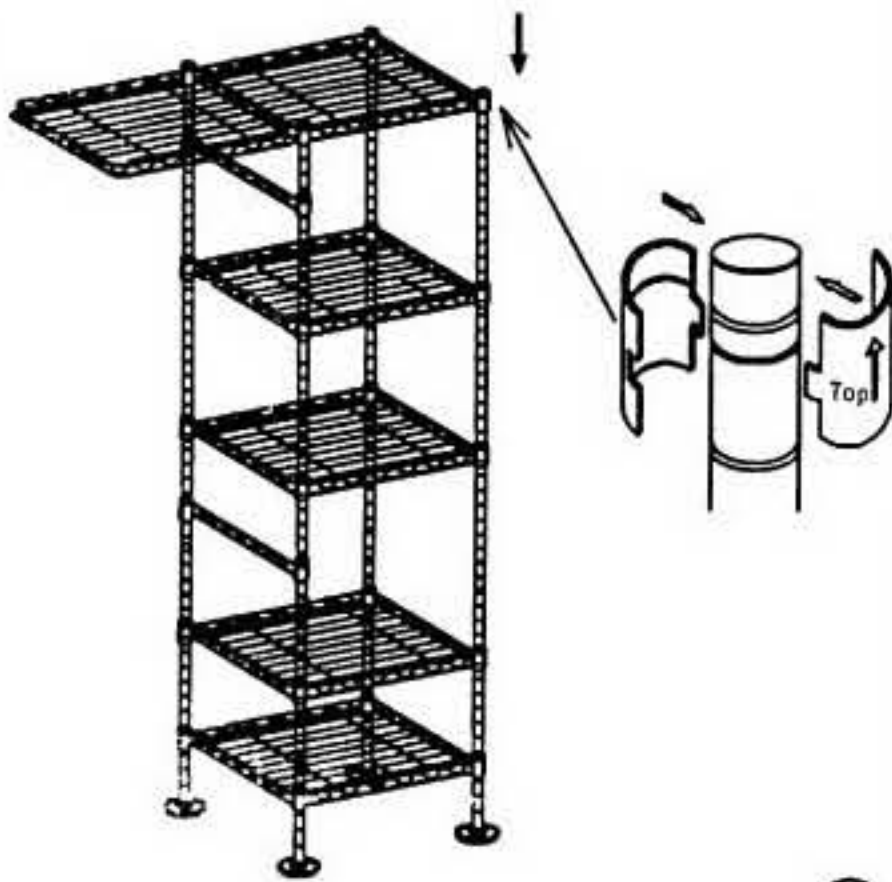

Fasten Slip Sleeves (B) at the 6th set of double grooves on the inner poles. Slide the Hanging Rod Bracket (E) over the poles and secure tightly.

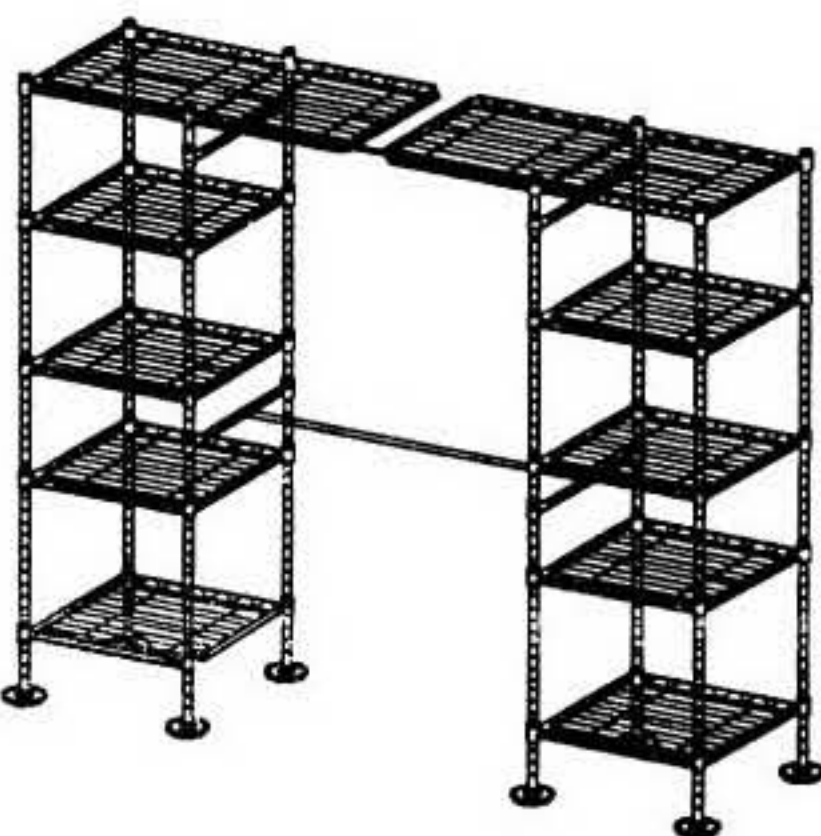
Fasten Slip Sleeves (B) around the top set of double grooves of each pole. Slide the Top Shelf (H) over the poles and secure tightly.

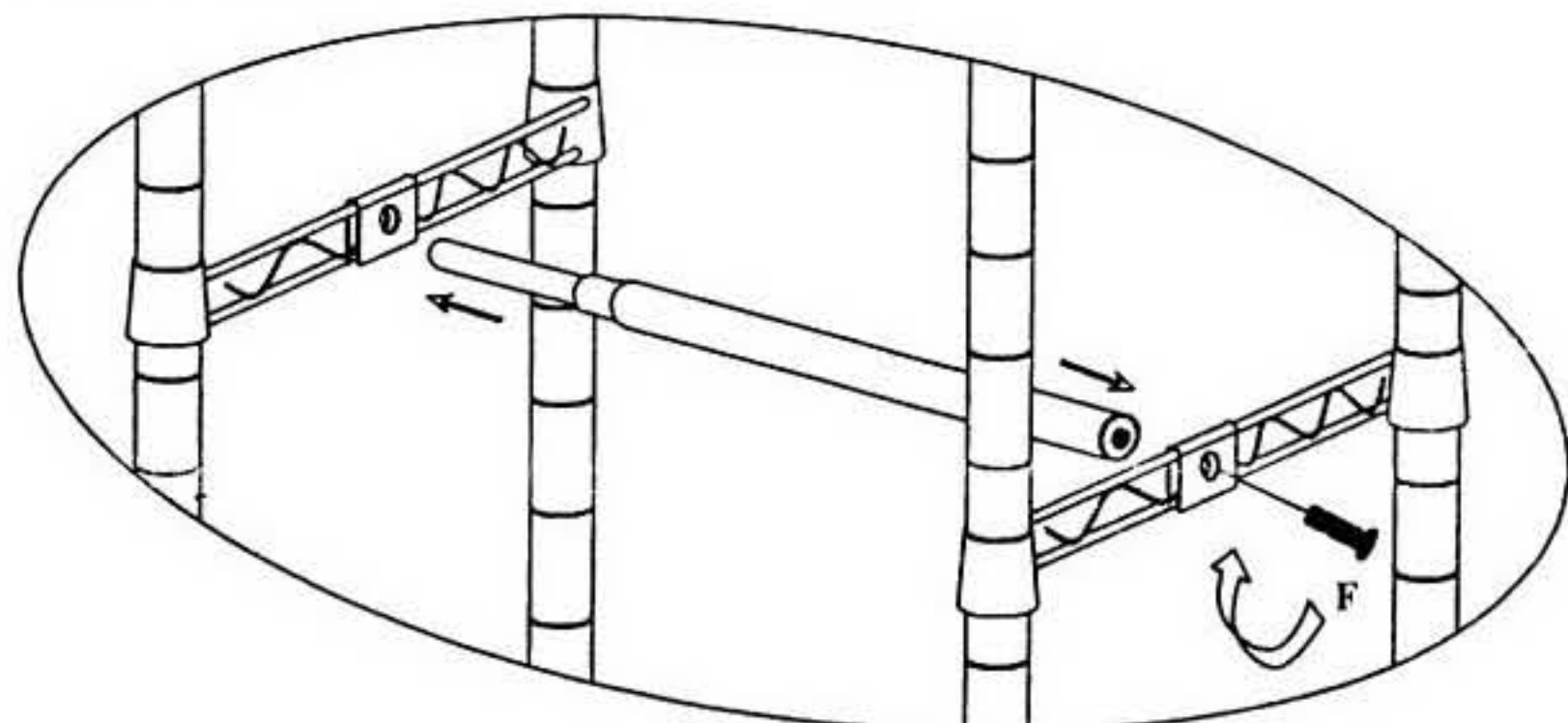
Repeat step 1-9 to assemble the second tower.

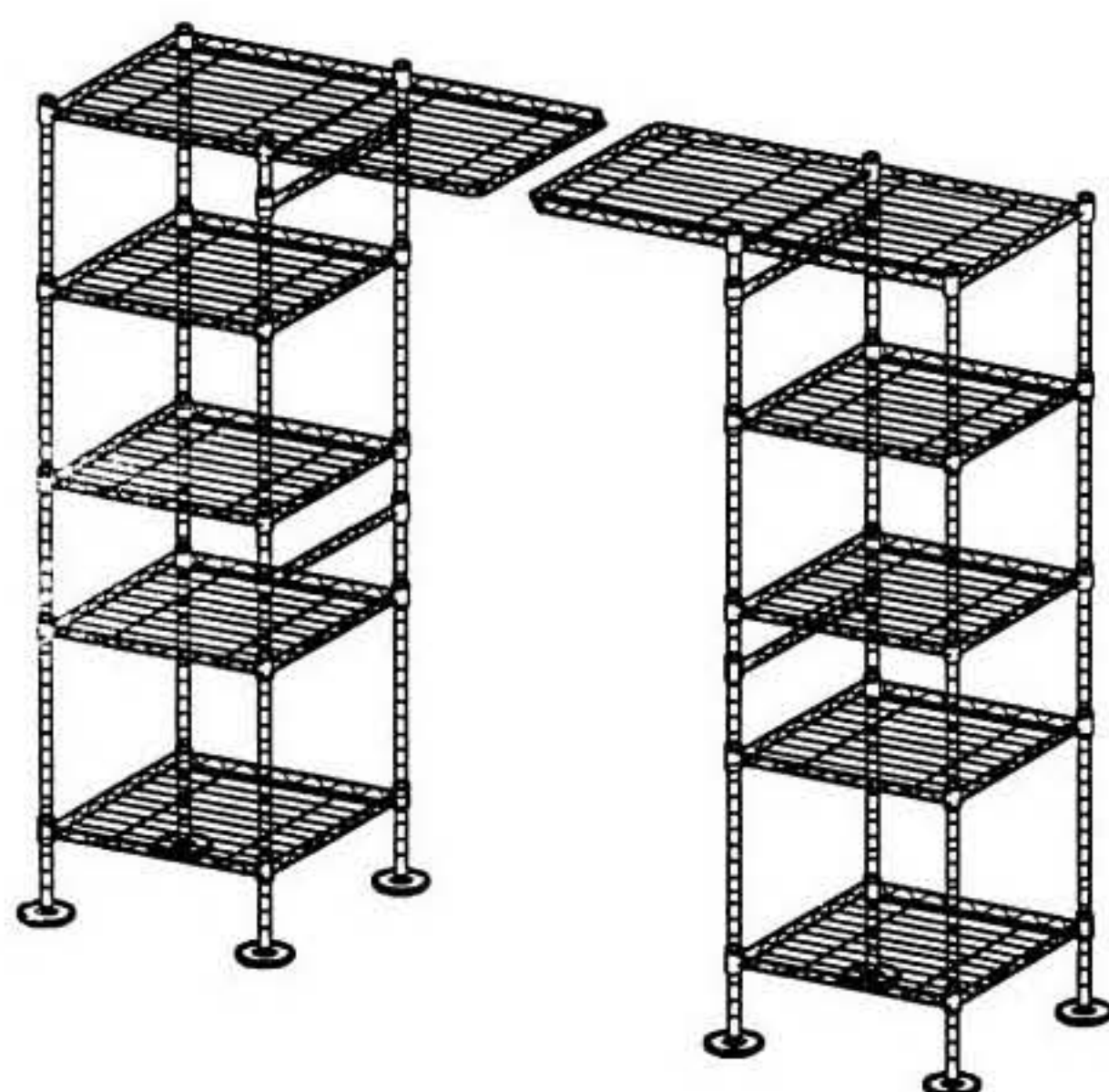
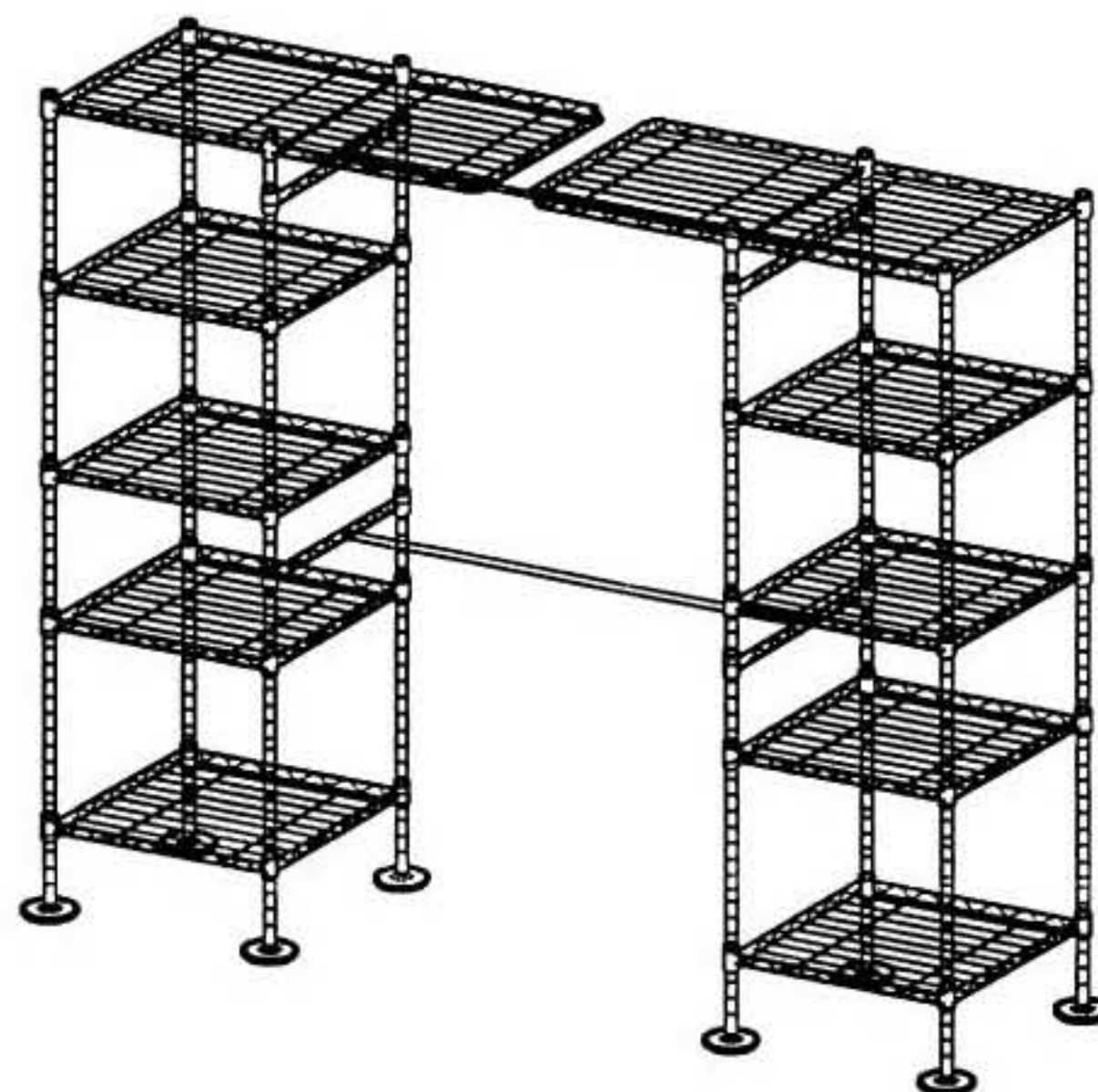

Place U-sleeve (G) in the center of each Hanging Rod Bracket (E). Insert Screw (F) through the U-Sleeve (G) and tighten the Hanging Rod (I) on both sides with a screwdriver.



Wall Strap Instructions

Notice: To prevent possible tipping, it is suggested wall straps be installed. For safe mounting, secure wall straps to wood studs whenever possible.

QTY	PARTS LIST:
2 pcs	 A-Nylon wall Strap
4 pcs	 B-Dry-wall screw
4 pcs	 C-Wall anchor
4 pcs	 D-Wood-wall screw

Mounting Instructions:

1. Place the Closet Organizer to the desired location to install wall strap. Fasten the wall strap (A) tightly around the rail of the top shelf as shown in the diagram. Next, extend the strap to the wall and mark your insertion point. *Please see below installation options depending on your wall type.*

A. *Dry Wall:* At the marked point on the wall, drill a hole and insert the wall anchor (C). Next, insert dry wall screw (B) through the wall strap eyelet and screw into wall anchor (C). Use an additional screw for added stability as shown below. Repeat steps for the other wall strap. Adjust leveling feet if necessary.

B. *Wall/Wall Stud:* At the marked Point on the wall, drill a pilot hole. Insert the wood screw (D) through the wall strap eyelet and screw into the wall. Use an additional screw for added stability. Repeat steps for the other wall strap. Adjust leveling feet if necessary.

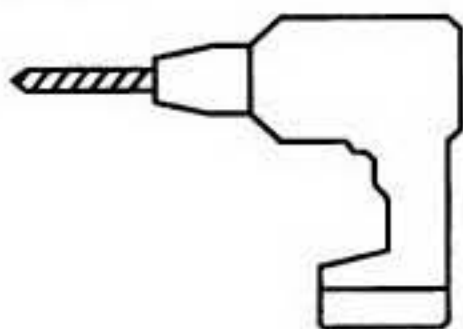
