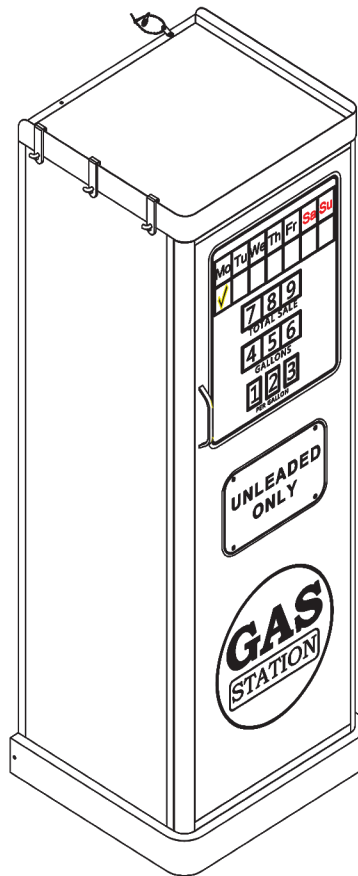


# Assembly Instructions



## ASSEMBLY RATING

The Assembly Rating is a 5-point system that shows the degree of effort needed in assembling a specific product (with 1 being easy and 5 being difficult). For some products, two persons are recommended.

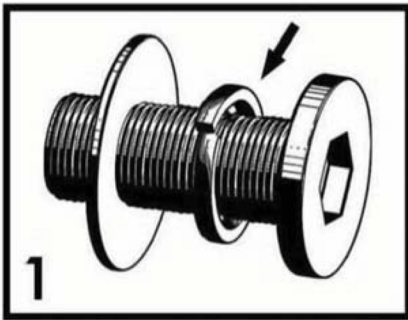

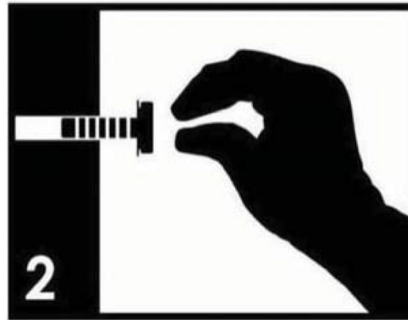

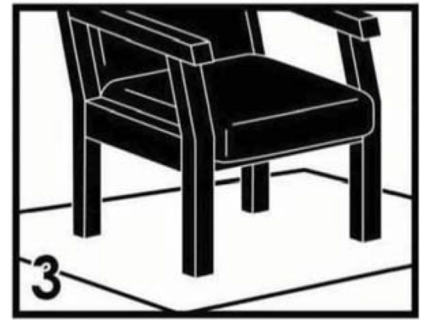
## BASIC ASSEMBLY TECHNIQUES



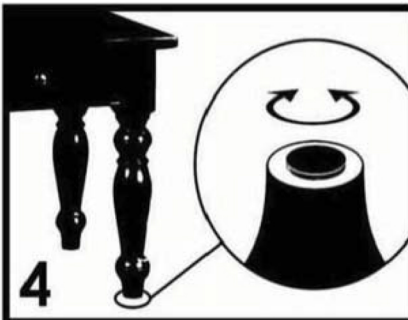
When lock or spring washer is used in an assembly, please make sure the lock or spring washer is placed between the larger flat washer and the head of the screw or bolt.



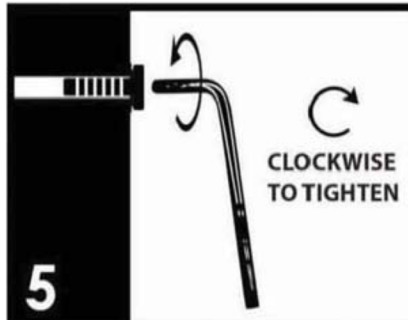
Position each part correctly and insert screws or bolts into their respective holes by hand tighten or using the proper hand tool. Only tighten when step is completed or when instructed to do so.



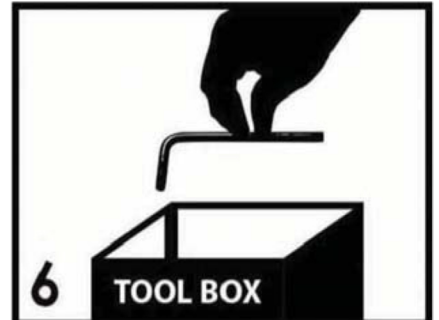
Use cardboard or carpet area when assembling furniture to prevent scratches. Make sure the furniture rests on a flat and level surface with each leg evenly touching the floor.



Some furniture comes with height adjustment knobs underneath each leg. To lower or to raise each leg, you need to turn clockwise or counterclockwise, respectively.



Make sure all parts are properly aligned, then use the appropriate hand tool to completely tighten the bolts or screws. Do not use power tools and do not overtighten.



Save the instructions and store the Allen wrench or any supplied tool for later maintenance. After two weeks, check and tighten any loose hardware and repeat again every six months thereafter.

IT IS THE USER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO MAINTAIN THE FURNITURE. THE HARDWARE MAY LOOSEN OVER TIME AND MAY CAUSE THE FURNITURE TO BE WOBBLY AND UNABLE TO SUPPORT ITS INTENDED WEIGHT CAPACITY. THIS MAY LEAD TO COLLAPSE AND MAY CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY.

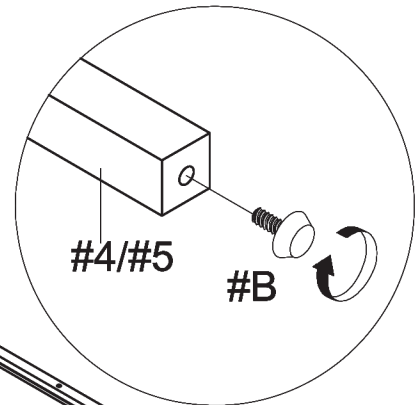
SCREWDRIVER

1. Align the bottom of the side panels (#3) to the pre-drilled holes located on the inner part of the base (#2).

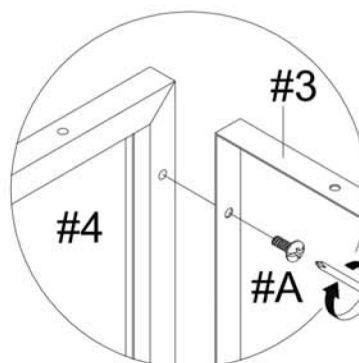
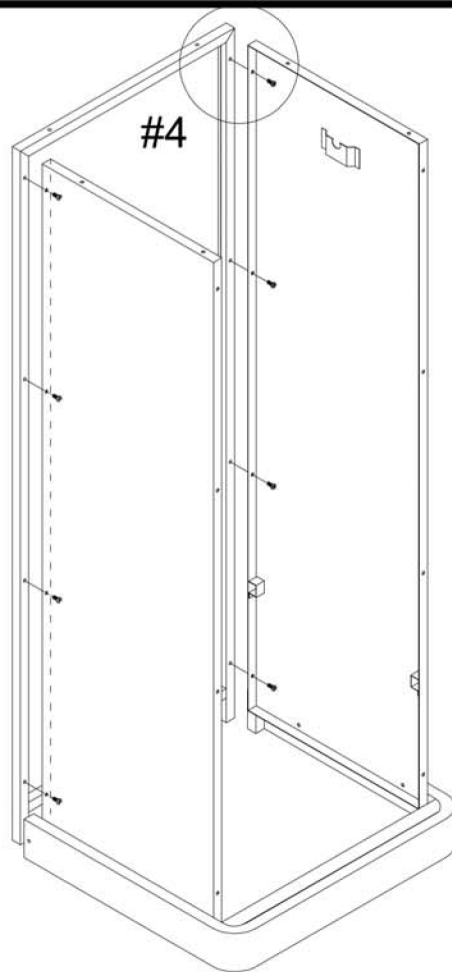
2. Insert a total of 4 bolts (#A) into the inner pre-drilled holes and secure using a Phillips screwdriver.

Insert threaded ends of levelers (#B) into the pre-drilled holes on the bottom of the front door (#5) and rear panel (#4), turn right to tighten according to ground level

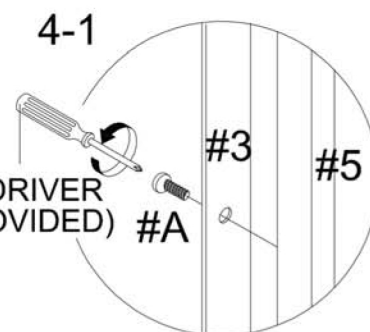
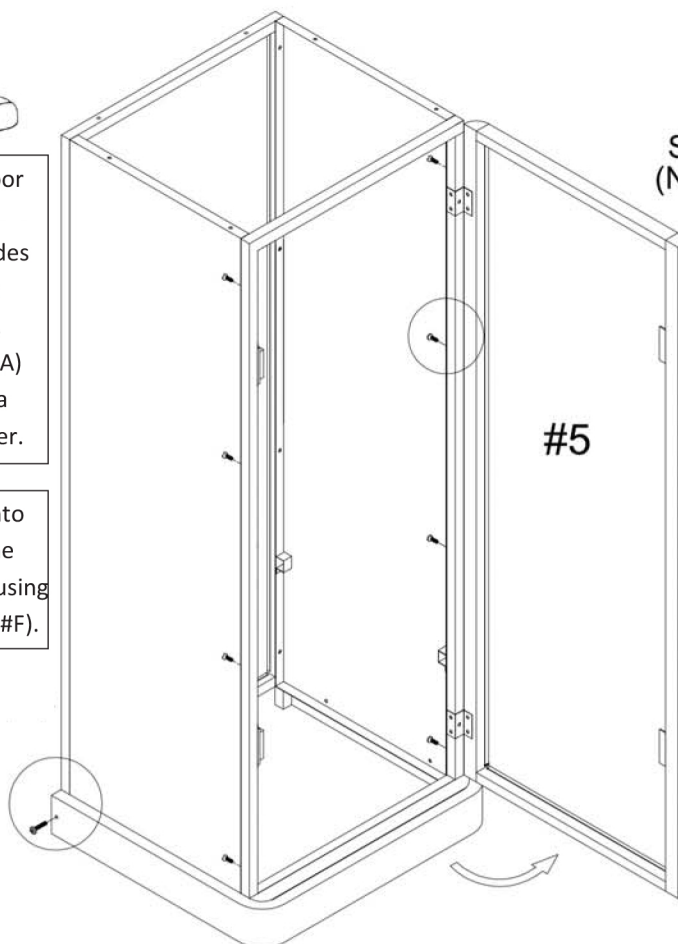
SCREWDRIVER  
(NOT PROVIDED)

Align the rear panel (#4) to the pre-drilled holes located along the back sides of the side panels (#3). From within, insert bolts (#A). Secure using a Phillips screwdriver.

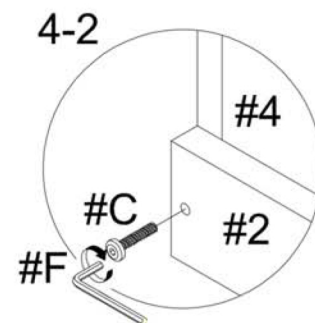


1. Align the front door (#5) to the holes along the front sides of the side panels (#3). From within, insert the bolts (#A) and secure using a Phillips screwdriver.

2. Insert bolts (#C) into the two ends of the base (#2). Secure using the Allen wrench (#F).

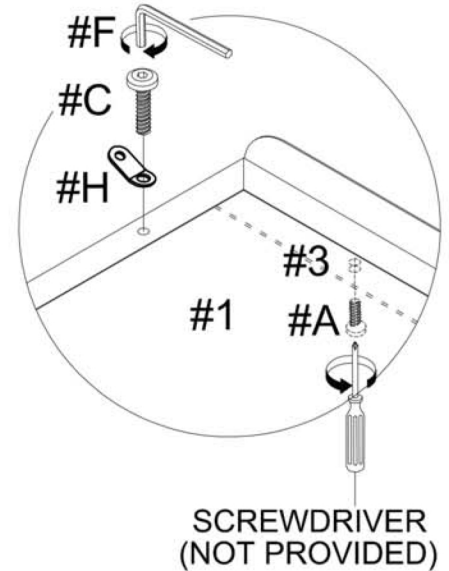
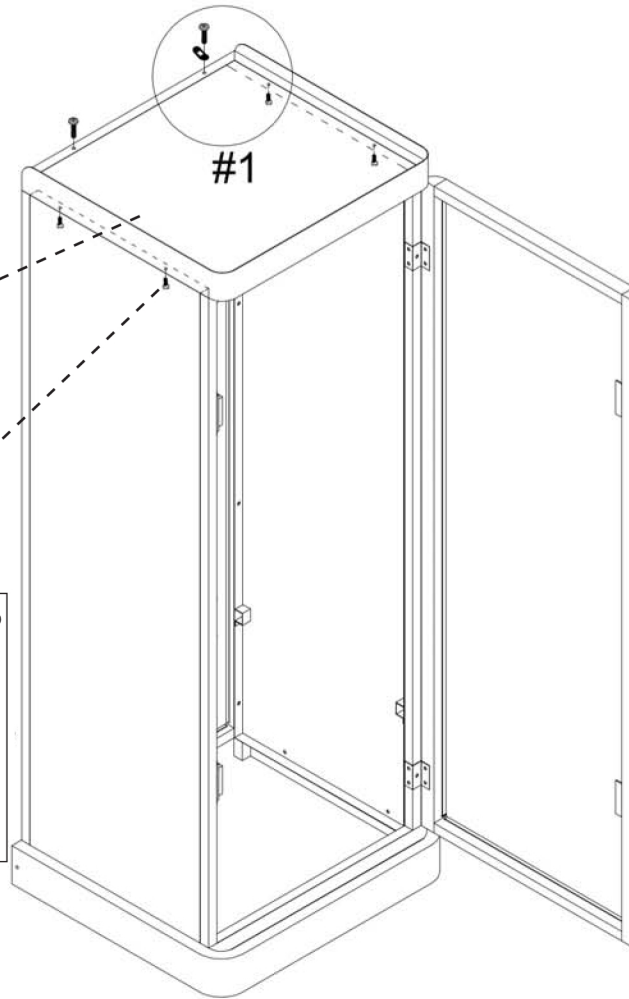

1. Place the top panel (#1) on top.

2. Insert a total of 4 bolts (#A) from beneath into the holes along each side of the top panel. Secure using a screwdriver.

3. Insert 2 bolts (#C) into the top holes on the rear panel. Insert a bracket (#H) onto one of those bolts and secure both with the Allen wrench (#F).



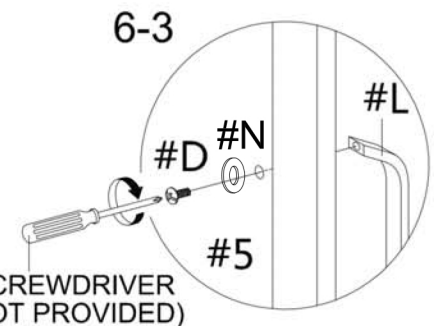
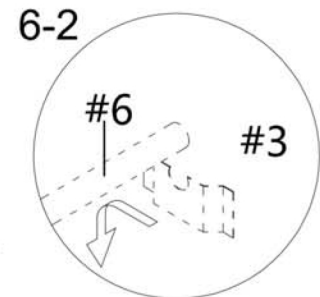
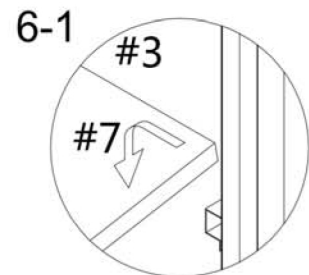
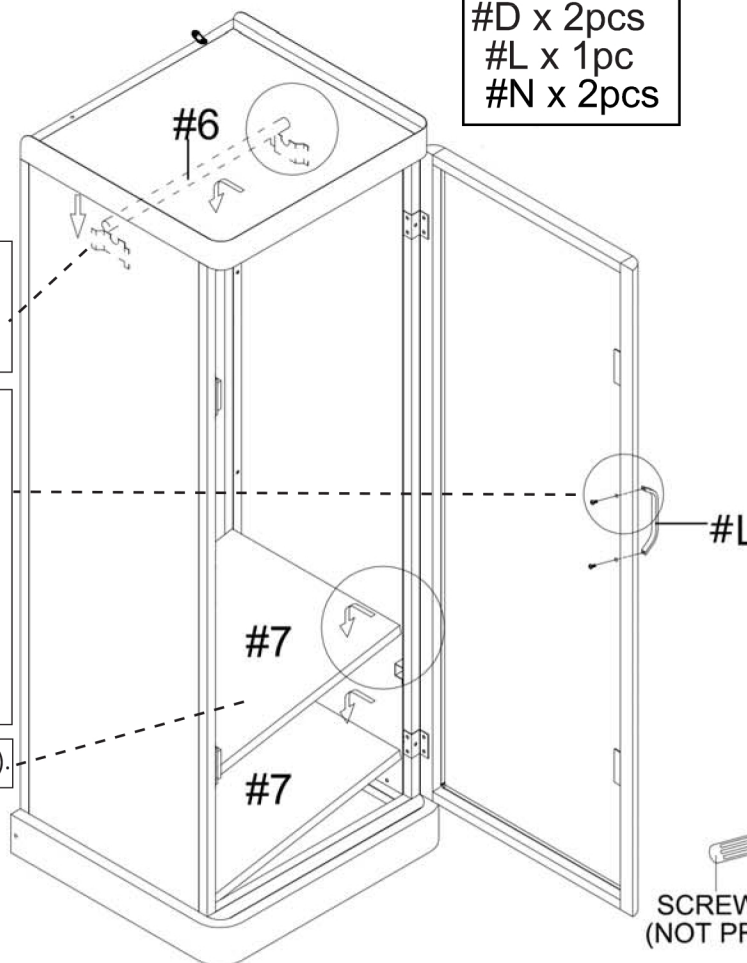

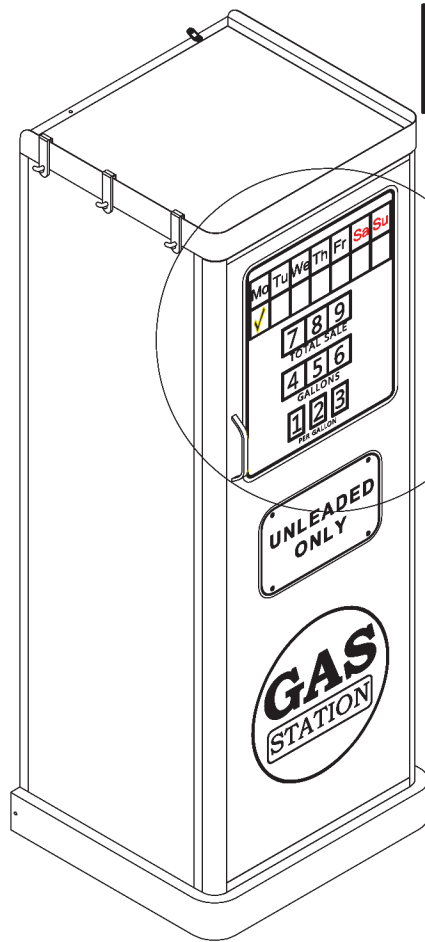


1. Place the clothes rail (#6) into the slots located inside.

2. Prepare 2 bolts by inserting a small flat washer (#N) onto the bolts (#D), then align the handle (#L) to the door. Insert a bolt assembly into each hole and secure using a screwdriver.

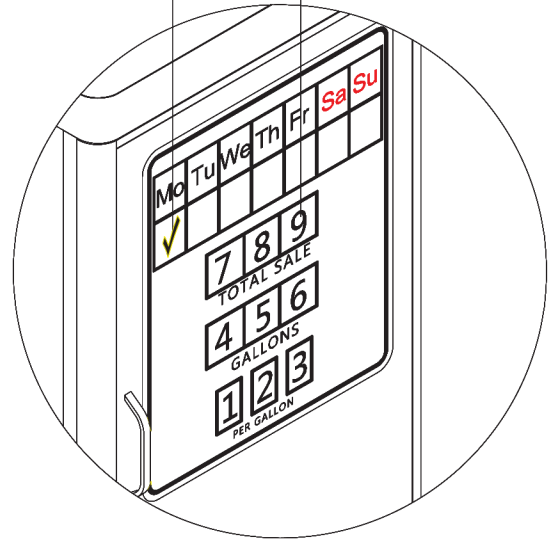
3. Apply the shelves (#7).

1. Determine exactly where you want to drill a hole and mark the spot(s). Be sure that you hold the drill perpendicular to the wall so that the anchor will sit parallel. You should drill a hole that is approximately the same size as the anchor bolt (#I) itself. Insert anchor.

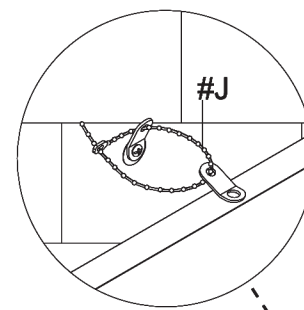


2. Insert one end of the bracket (#H) onto the screw (#K) then insert screw into the anchor. Secure using a Phillips screwdriver.
